Happy New Year to Everyone!!

IHSBCA offers Virtual Clinic this year: This year the clinic will be different than any other that we have had before. Due to the COVID pandemic, we will not have an in-person clinic or host a Hall of Fame Banquet. Instead, we will host a virtual clinic on January 29-30, 2021. We have partnered with Championship Productions to bring our membership a clinic despite the pandemic. We are very excited with our list of clinic speakers this year. On Friday afternoon, we will have Travis Hergert - Phillies Minor League Assistant Pitching Coordinator, Brian Miles - Indians Mental Performance Coach, John Anderson - University of Minnesota Head Coach, Robin Lund - University of Iowa Pitching Coach, along with our high school mini-sessions. On Saturday, we will have our annual FCA meeting with former Cardinals pitcher and current Cardinals broadcaster Rick Horton. Our virtual clinic will continue with Drew Saylor - Kansas City Royals Hitting Coordinator, Luke Carlin - Indians Catching Coordinator, Joel Mangrum - Cleveland Indians Pitching Coordinator, Kai Correa - Infield Bench Coach with the SF Giants, Darren Fenster - Boston Red Sox Base Running Coordinator, JT Maquire - Indians Outfield Coordinator, Shaun Larkin - LA Dodgers Field and Practice Coordinator, Joe Eisenmann - PHD at Michigan State University, and we will end the day with a hitting Q and A session. Hoping many of you can attend and view on line. We have included our vendors and have given them an opportunity to be included with the virtual clinic. Please check out their websites.

We will not host an Awards Banquet this year. We have moved the following awards to next years clinic - Hall of Fame, Primrose Award, President's and Contributor's Awards. With the clinic fast approaching, please check to make sure your membership has been paid for the 2020-2021 season. The new membership calendar year started on September 1, 2020 and runs through August 31, 2021. If you have questions, please send Lee Toole a text or email message. We encourage you to take advantage of the membership discount for schools with multiple baseball coaches. Here is how the membership costs works. The IHSBCA Virtual Clinic is fast approaching, don't miss out!

It's not too late to get registered for the 2021 IHSBCA Virtual Clinic! We will take registrations right through the clinic. Get registered now and send your payment when you can. We will need each coach's email address ASAP so we can get you registered with Championship Productions, and in return they will send you login information. Contact Lee Toole if you have questions. This year's clinic will be on Friday, January 29th and Saturday, January 30th. The times will be as follows: Friday 1/29 - speakers are scheduled at 4:00 pm, 5:00 pm, 6:00 pm, 7:00 pm, 8:00 pm and 9:00 pm. The 8 pm and 9 pm sessions will include our high school coaches mini-sessions. On Saturday 1/30 - we will begin with an FCA round table session at 7:45 am, then have a speaker every hour starting at 9:00 am until our last session at 5:00 pm. Our final 5:00 pm session will be a Q and A session with a panel of MLB hitting coaches. We have added a schedule with speaker times below.

There will not be a IHSAA rules meeting during the virtual clinic this year. There are no new rules added this year by the NFHS. The IHSAA will put together a rules review presentation for coaches that will come out in April. Along with that, there will also not be an umpire clinic this year. Mike Botts and the IHSAA will have a presentation for all umpires later this spring.

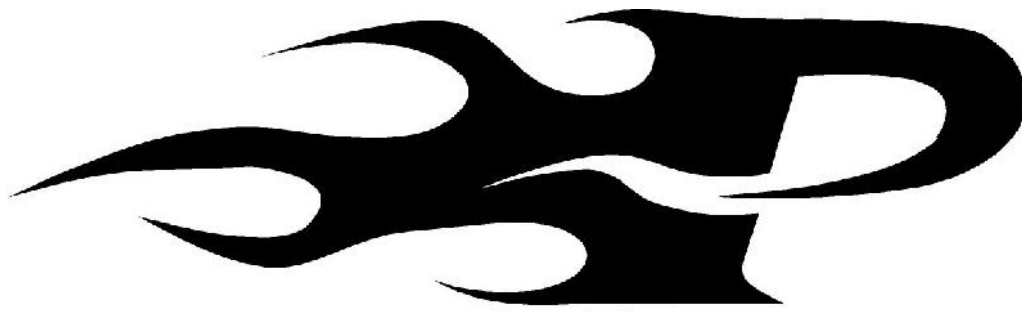
