TIPS TO OUTFIELDERS: BY DUANE BANKS

QUALIFICATIONS OF A GOOD OUTFIELDER

- 1. Must be a dependable hitter.
- 2. Must have good speed on the base-lines.
- 3. Must have a good throwing arm.
- 4. Must have ability to field all kinds of flies.
- 5. Must be able to field ground balls.

- 1. You play to the batter's strength.... our pitcher pitches to the batter's weakness.
- 2. Shift according to
 - a/ Style of batter--left or right handed. b/ Ball being pitched...slow...fast...curve

 - c/ Batter's strength....may be left field hitter a center or rigth field hitter.
- d/ Wind.... allow enough if a cross wind...if wind at your back, it will hold the balls up
- e/ Play short for a weak hitter...play deep for the hard hitters.
- 3. Play according to your style of pitcher.
- a/ If pitcher has speed, the opposition will be likely to swing late... right handed batters will be hitting to right field... left to left field, etc.
- b/ If pitcher used slow curves, the batters are more likely to pull ball to their own field... right handers hitting to left field and left to right field.
- c/ If pitcher is in the hole, outfielders should play deeper if he is to groove the ball.
- 4. Always plan ahead--know the score-outs-the inning and what you will do with the ball.
 - a/ If ball comes to you.
 - b/ If ball goes to next fielder.
 - c/ If a pitcher is throwing to a base, back up
 - d/ If a pitch-out and throw is to be made.
- 5. Go fast to back up or to relay the ball.
- 6. Call and tell other fielder where to throw.
- 7. When to call out on flies near another man
 - a/ If you call "Mine", take it.
- b/ Call only if you can get it. Call early and call loudly enough.
- c/ Listen for the instructions of your team-mate if men are on the baselines.
- 8. Ground balls.
 - a/ Get in front of the ball if possible.
 - b/ Take the ball at the top of the bounce.
- c/ Block the ball with your body if it is nescessary to keep base-runners from advancing.
- 9. Fly balls.
- a/ With no one on--take position under the ball where it would hit between your eyes.
- b/ With men on bases--try to time your approach to the ball so that you use your forward momentum to throw. Don't run before throwing.
- c/ Sun Field--With or without glasses--It is easier if outfielder follows the ball up to the edge of the sun then shifts his eyes to the upper edge of it until the ball appears.... reverse this method as the ball comes down.
- 10. Special instructions (to cover special condition
 - a/ Notice the direction of the wind.
 - b/ Notice condition of the ground & bounce,
 - c/ Watch for signals from short if he gives them.
