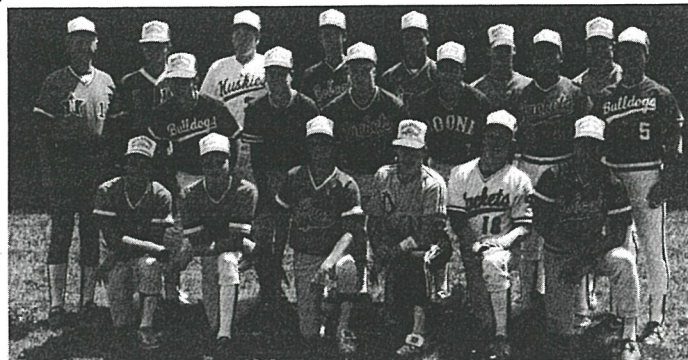

MIKE BRANDMEYER--THIRD-RECIPIENT-OF-THE-VINCE MEYER AWARD: The third recipient of the Vince Meyer Award was Mike Brandmeyer, United Community of Boone. This award is given in honor of long-time baseball coach at Bancroft St. John's, and is given to a player selected from the list of players who were nominated for the academic all-state team. This award is announced at the Recognition Banquet to the player who exhibits the high academic and athletic standards which Coach Meyer exemplified during his career as a coach and teacher.

A little bit about Mike: He had an ACT score of 28; he ranked second in his graduating class. He was All-Conference in 1984, 85 and 86, All-District 1985 and 86 and All-State in 1986. Other honors for Mike were: Morris Samuelson Award, Top Senior Athlete Award--Captain in four sports, football, basketball, Track and baseball. Mike was on Senior High St. Council for 4 years (Pres and V.P.), Speech Contest (State Level), National Honor Society for 3 years, Bausch and Lomb Science Award, Chorus, Swing Choir, Jazz Band, Concert Band. In baseball he hit .439 his Junior year and .340 his Senior year. He pitched in 37 games in three years and completed 24, with an E.R.A. of 0.38 his senior year. Won 27 games in three years and losing only 4.

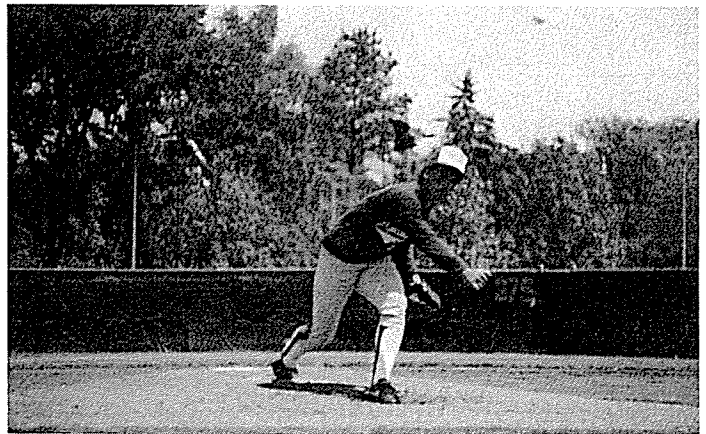

PARTICIPATION SURVEY 1986: Enclosed you will find a copy of the 1986 participation survey, sent out to the Principals, Athletic Directors and you baseball coaches. So far, 3 out of 4 coaches feel that there should be some changes in the summer baseball program. Over 52% of the Principals feel the same way and 50% of the A.D. feel a change should be made. FALL BASEBALL COACHES: The Department of Public Instruction has ruled that sharing of programs between football and fall baseball playing schools, that football playing schools involved in a cooperative program with a fall baseball school may now send any of their interested students to the fall baseball school for purposes of playing baseball, if they so desire.

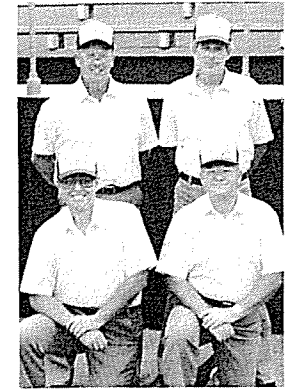

NOMINATION BALLOT FOR BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Section 2. Board of Directors. (A) The representatives to the Board of Directors shall be elected by the members within their district. By October 15 of each year, the association members will receive an official blank nomination ballot. Upon voting, the nomination ballot to be returned (within ten days from mailing) to the executive secretary. In the presence of two other association members, there shall be a canvass of the ballots. The 3 receiving the highest number of votes shall be considered the nominees. In case of a tie of more than 3, all those in the ties shall be considered nominees. In case the number of nomination ballots for any one of the nominees is a majority of the number of members in the respective district, he shall be declared elected. The executive secretary shall prepare and mail official election ballots to the members of the district. Upon voting, the election ballot to be returned (within ten days from mailing) to the executive secretary. The procedure in canvassing shall be the same as in canvassing nomination ballots and the person receiving the highest number of votes shall be declared elected. In case of a tie, the election shall be decided by lot by the candidates in the presence of the canvassing committee. The third highest vote getter shall be considered the alternate and in event of inability of elected Director to serve alternate will be appointed to the Board of Directors.

Please nominate two coaches from your district who are members of the Iowa High School Baseball Coaches Association to be members of the Board of Directors to represent your district.
