TODD MILLER AND JEFF RYAN--FIFTH RECIPIENTS OF THE VINCE MEYER AWARD: The fifth recipients of the Vince Meyer Award were Todd Miller, Wahlert and Jeff Ryan of Davenport West. This award is given in honor of long-time baseball coach at Bancroft St. John's, and is given to a player selected from the list of players who were nominated for the academic all-state team. This award is announced at the Recognition Banquet to the player who exhibits the high academic and athletic standards which Coach Meyer exemplified during his career as a coach and teacher.

Todd Miller had an ACT score of 28; he ranked 10/321 in his graduating class. With a GPA of 3.875. He was All-Conference in 1988, All-District 1987 and 88. Todd was involved in Football, Basketball, Baseball and the Student Council at Wahlert High School. He hit .389 his Senior year. with 6 HR and 45 RBI's.

Jeff Ryan had an ACT score of 27, he ranked 5/497 with a GPA of 3.969. Jeff was All-Conference his Junior and Senior Years and all district in the same years. He was fourth team all-state his Junior Year. He was also a first team All-State Football player in 1987. Jeff was involved with Student Government as well as a Football, Basketball, Track and Baseball player. Jeff hit .430 his senior year with 40 hits, 20 doubles and 4 home runs with 26 RBI's.



SITUATION #19 Single to Right Field between 1st and 2nd baseman








