1990 ALL STAR CHAMPS Large East, coached by Bob Leech of Muscatine and Assistants Phil Katz of Linn Mar and Dick Burch of Fort Madison.

MIKE SEYMOUR--RECIPIENT OF THE VINCE MEYER AWARD: The recipient of the Vince Meyer Award was Mike Seymour of Clinton. This award is given in memory of long-time baseball coach at Bancroft St. John's, and is given to a player selected from the list of players who were nominated for the academic all-state team. This award is announced at the Recognition Banquet and presented to the player who exhibits the high academic and athletic standards which Coach Meyer exemplified during his career as a coach and teacher.

Mike Seymour had an ACT score of 28; he ranked 2nd in his graduating class of 320. With a GPA of 3.9. He participated in Football, Basketball, Track, Student Body President, National Honor Society, Student Government, State of Iowa Scholar, U.S. Army Reserve National Scholar Athlete Award, Gold Key Award, American Citizenship Award, 3.0 club. He also batted .394 for the baseball season.

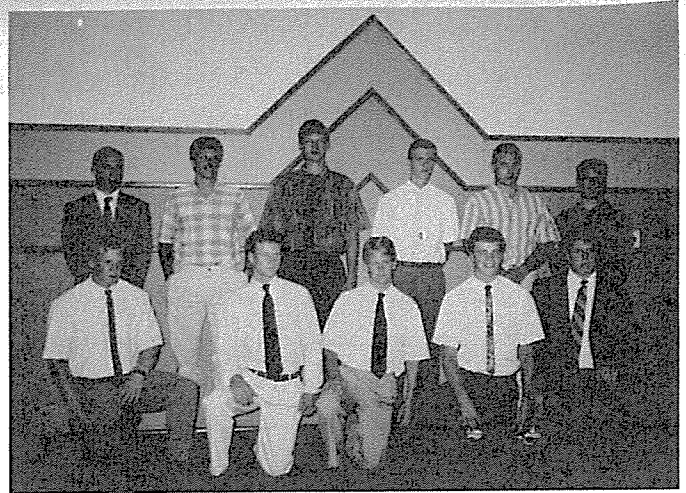

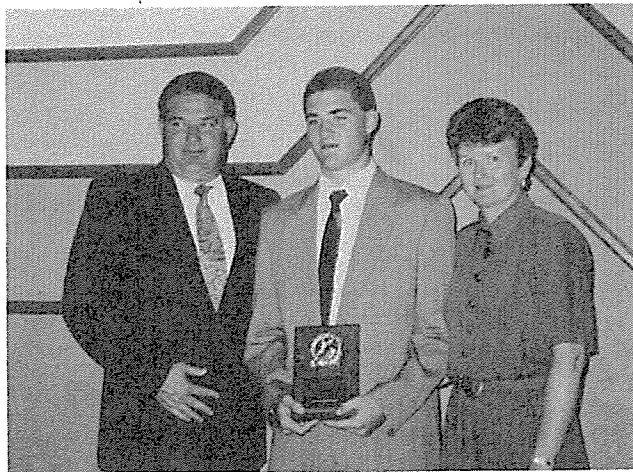


BALK RULE

One of the most misunderstood rules in baseball is the balk rule. A balk is an illegal act by the pitcher with a runner or runners on base, entitling all runners to advance one base.

It is a balk when:

- The pitcher, while touching his plate, makes any motion naturally associated with his pitch and fails to make such delivery.
- The pitcher, while touching his plate, feints a throw to first base and fails to complete the throw.
- The pitcher, while touching his plate, fails to step directly toward a base before throwing to that base.
- The pitcher, while touching his plate, throws, or feints a throw, to an unoccupied base, except for the purpose of making a play.
- The pitcher makes an illegal pitch.
- The pitcher delivers the ball to the batter while he is not facing the batter.
- The pitcher makes any motion naturally associated with his pitch while he is not touching the pitcher's plate.
- The pitcher unnecessarily delays the game.
- The pitcher, without having the ball, stands on or astride the pitcher's plate or while off the plate, he feints a pitch.
- The pitcher, after coming to a legal pitching position, removes one hand from the ball other than in an actual pitch, or in throwing to a base.
- The pitcher, while touching his plate, accidentally or intentionally drops the ball.
- The pitcher, while giving an intentional base on balls, pitches when the catcher is not in the catcher's box.
- The pitcher delivers the pitch from set position without coming to a stop.
- If, with a runner on third base trying to score by means of a squeeze play or a steal, the catcher or any other fielder steps on, or in front of, home base without possession of the ball, or touches the batter or his bat, the pitcher shall be charged with a balk, the batter awarded first base on the interference and the ball is dead.
