ALL STAR GAMES SCHEDULE: The players, coaches, umpires and staff will be staying at the Five Seasons Hotel in Cedar Rapids. The Honors Brunch will take place at the Five Seasons Hotel, Saturday morning at 10:30 a.m.

- 1/ Players will come in Thursday, August 6th. Individual pictures for inclusion in the program will be taken after check in.
- 2/ Small Schools East will report by 11:30 a.m. Large Schools East will report at 11:45 a.m.
- 3/ Players from Large Schools West will report at 12:00 noon and players from Small Schools West will report at 12:15 p.m.

4/ Practice for all teams will start at 1:30 p.m.
Practice sites: Large East--Linn Mar High Diamond; Large West--Jefferson High Diamond; Small School East--Kennedy High Diamond and Small School West--Washington High Diamond.

5/ First 7-inning games will be at 6:00 p.m., Thursday, Cedar Rapids Red's Memorial Diamond- Small Schools East vs. Large schools East, followed by Large Schools West vs. Small Schools West.

6/ Practice for all squads Friday morning will start at 10:30 a.m.. 7/ Second 7-inning games will be at 6:00 p.m. Friday, Cedar Rapids Red's Memorial diamond-Small Schools East vs. Large schools West, followed by Large Schools East vs. Small Schools West.

9/ Saturday night session will begin at 6:00 p.m.- Small Schools West vs. Small Schools West followed by Large Schools East vs. Large Schools West

WHAT ARE SOME OF THE RULES:

1/ All players chosen must play.2/ The pitchers can pitch a full game.3/ All games will be 7 innings in length unless extra innings necessary

4/ Tie breaker system will be announced in advance for who will play for 1st and 2nd place. Example: Head to Head competition, most runs scored, least runs given up, most hits, least hits given up.

All of the examples can be given points. The two teams with the most points will play for 1st place.

This system will give more boys an opportunity to play and show what they can do. We will not restrict a pitcher on amount of innings he can pitch in one day.

Coaches were picked by the Steering committee! They filled out an application that was found in the last newsletter.

*****Players who do not make the All District Team will still be eligible to play in the All Star Series. ****

If a coach fills out a player profile form that is found in this newsletter and sends it in, this player will have the same opportunity as a player on the All District Team. This system was necessary because of a number of good ball players being left off the All Star Squads because a coach could not get enough votes for his player at the All District Selection meetings.

ALL STAR SQUAD REGULATIONS:


Each squad will consist of 16 players (2 catchers, 5 pitchers, 5 infielders and 4 outfielders).
