### RYAN MCGUIRE--RECIPIENT OF THE VINCE MEYER

**AWARD:** The recipient of the Vince Meyer Award was Ryan McGuire of Davenport Assumption. This award is given in memory of long-time baseball coach at Bancroft St. John's, and is given to a player selected from the list of players who were nominated for the academic all-state team. This award is announced at the Recognition Brunch and presented to the player who exhibits the high academic and athletic standards which Coach Meyer exemplified during his career as a coach and teacher.

Ryan McGuire had an ACT score of 32; he ranked 6th in his graduating class of 125. He participated in Football and the Fellowship of Christian Athletes. He was a Junior Rotarian, Honorable Mention Mizumo All-American and Tandy Technology Scholarship recipient. He was a member of the National Honor Society, with a 3.86 grade point. His baseball stats are Hitting .428 for season with 60 hits for 140 at bats. 37 RBI's with 20 walks and striking out only 12 times. He was 1st team All-Mississippi Athletic Conference, All-District and 1st team All-State 3A.

## 1994 NATIONAL FEDERATION BASEBALL MAJOR RULE CHANGES:

1-1-5A manufacturer's logo, trademark or advertising shall not exceed 1 1/2" x 1/1/2" square.

1-4-3 Coverage of illegal glove/mitt touching batted or thrown ball has been expanded.

3-1-1 An unreported, eligible substitute automatically becomes legal upon entering the game and a pitch has been delivered. An ineligible substitute is out and ejected.

3-1-6 Adopted rule concerning bleeding.

3--3-1i Team personnel must be in dugout or designated bench area instead of "vicinity".

4-4-1f Team allowed to finish game with eight players, regardless of reason it could not finish with nine.

8-4-2k Diving over a defensive player is prohibited. However, jumping over or hurdling a player who is lying on the ground is legal.

8-4-1d Batter is out when he drops the bat (or uses it) to intentionally contact the ball a second time in fair or foul territory.
