Upper Iowa: Chris Hoover, former Independence prep hit .453 in the Conference, was chosen 2nd team All-Conference. He is a senior. He hit .393 in all games.

Grand View: Ended up 2nd in Conference.

Simpson College: Won the Conference Regular Season Championship and the Conference Tournament. Runner up in Central Regional.

St. Ambrose: Won the Midwest Classic Conference Title, Won District 15 title, Won Midwest Regional Title, Finished 3rd in the N.A.I.A. World Series in Des Moines.

Morningside College: Chris Schiltz, former Estherville 93' grad, all conference, broke school's single season hit record. Stacy Sauerbrei, form Acvkley-Geneva 90' grad--named All-conference; Ryan Meier, former C.B. Abe Lincoln 91' grad, all Academic team.

CHANGING DISTRICTS AND CLASS: At the recent Board of Directors meeting the following guideline was approved
1/ A school may move up a class, but not down a class. 2/ In order to move into another district or up a class, the member school must apply in writing by January 15th. 3/ The school must stay in that district or classification for five years. The only exceptions would be if the school's classification changes (by the State) or their conference is realigned. 4/ Apply in writing to the President or Executive Secretary. 5/ A school could move down with approval if all schools in conference are of a lower class.
