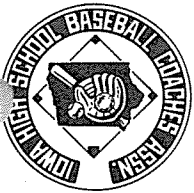

Thanks to the Westfield Inn and their staff for the cooperation they gave the Association. It was a great place to stay!

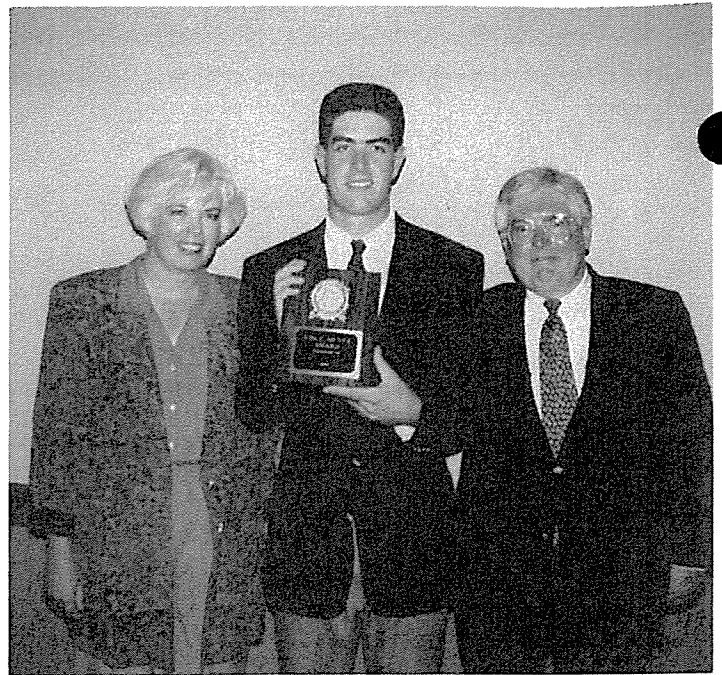
## BRYAN STROH RECIPIENT OF THE VINCE MEYER AWARD:

The recipient of the Vince Meyer Award was Bryan Stroh of Cedar Rapids Washington. This award was given in memory of the long-time baseball coach at Bancroft St. John's, and was given to a player selected from the list of players who were nominated for the academic allstate team. This award is announced at the Recognition Banquet and presented to the player who exhibits the high academic and athletic standards which Coach Meyer exemplified during his career as a coach and teacher.

Bryan Stroh had an ACT score of 32; he ranked 9th in his graduating class of 357. Brian was Senior Class President, Valedictorian, Chamber of Commerce Outstanding Youth Leader Award, Jamie Harder Youth Leader Award, Selected one of the top 10 NATIONAL leaders of the year by the National Council of Youth leadership, Debate Team Captain, Student Senate officer his Senior Year. Coach for the Constitution Team (Washington D.C.), National Honor Society, Captain of the Black History Team, VP of SADD Program, President of the Young Republicans, French Club, McElroy Scholarship and Tylen Scholarship Winner, All-Academic All conference in both Baseball and Basketball. He participated in Basketball, Student Council, Class officer for four years. First Team All-State 4-A. Recipient of the MacEnney scholarship. Brian had a 4.18 grade point. His baseball stats are Hitting .391 for season with 29 hits for 74 at bats. 18 RBI's with 12 walks and striking out only 7 times. He was 1st team All-Mississippi Athletic Conference, Second Team All-District and 1st team All-State 4A. He pitched and led his team to the State Championship, having a 11-3 record with an E.R.A. of 1.89. Brian also played Legion ball for three years, winning the State Championship in 1992 and 1994. His coach was Rick Netolicky. He is going to Princeton University, majoring in Pre-professional studies.

1-1-1 Name and shirt number of eligible substitutes required on line-up card to be submitted to umpire (no penalty if not done).

3-4-3,4 Time frames for determining when charged conferences are concluded were established.

7-3-1 Batter required to keep one foot in batter's box throughout his time at bat (some exceptions) to avoid unnecessary delays.

2-4-3 Spectator interference is not considered if a spectator interferes

7-4c with a fielder who reaches into the stands or other dead ball areas

8-3-3e to make a catch.

10-1-2 Umpire jurisdiction begins when arriving at the field and ends upon leaving the field.

Courtesy A courtesy runner for the pitcher or catcher may be used at any time Runner once the pitcher or catcher reaches base.

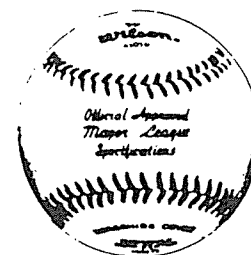
**1994-95 COOPERATIVE PROGRAMS IN BASEBALL:** The following schools will be sharing players in the upcoming season.

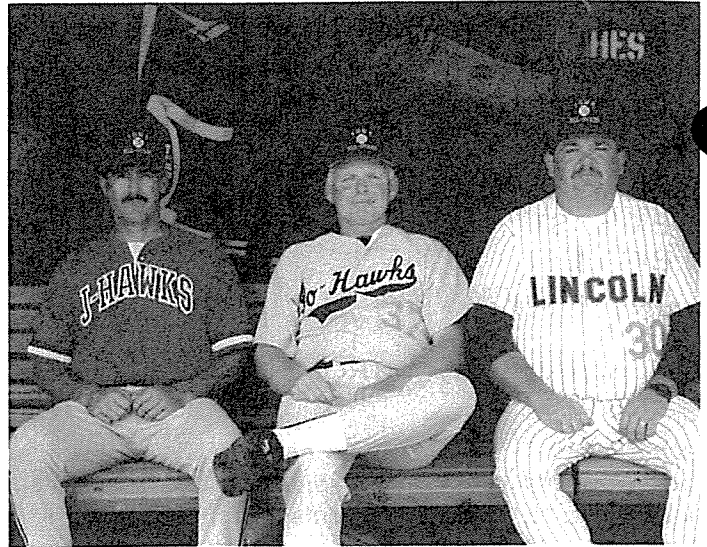
## ACADEMIC ALL-STATE TEAM

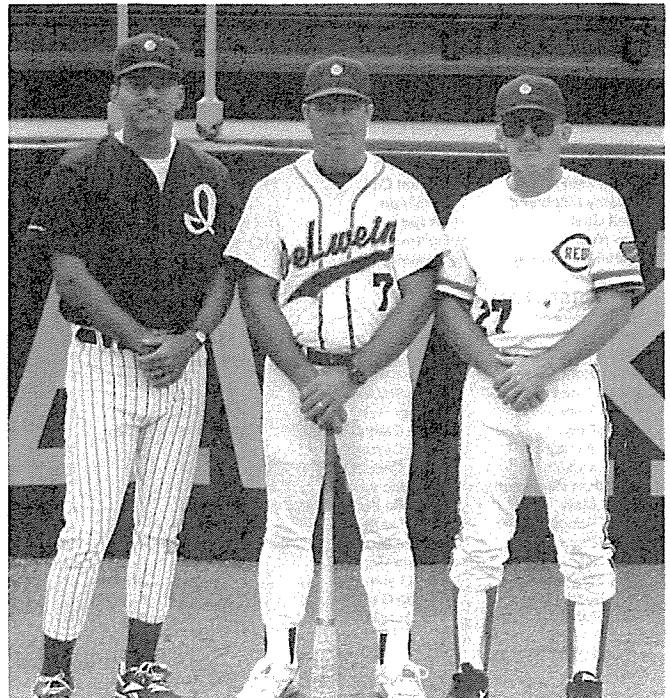

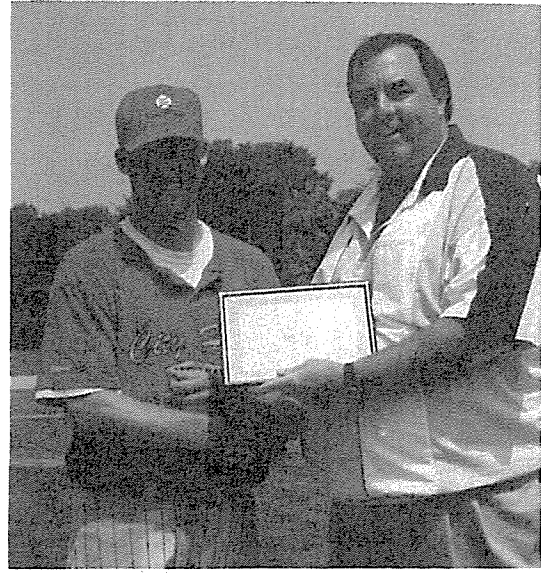

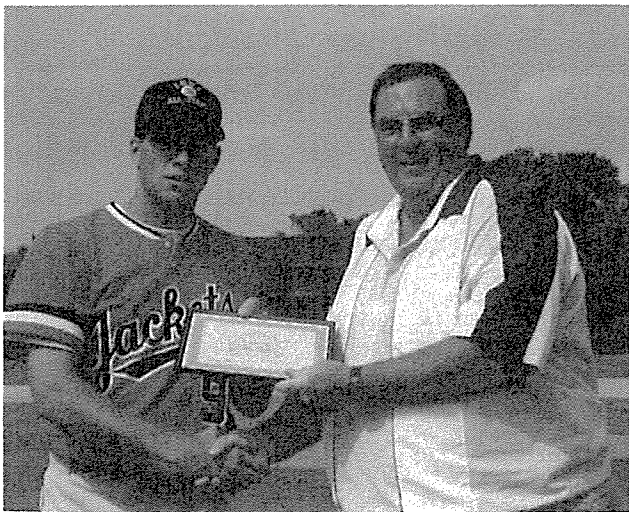

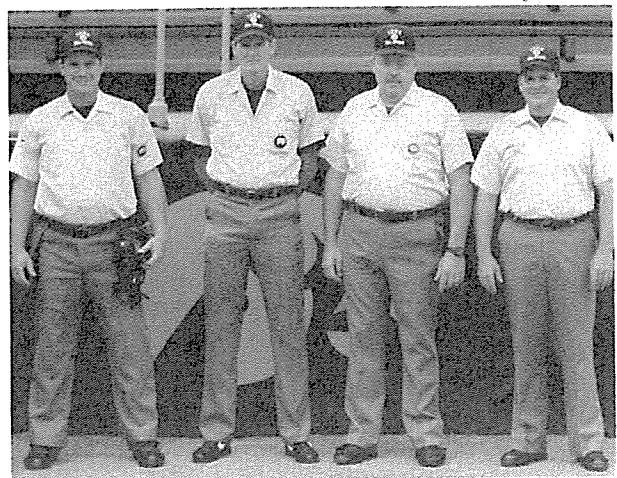
