1996 NATIONAL FEDERATION BASEBALL MAJOR RULE CHANGES:

1-1-5 Any player warming up the pitcher must wear a head protector.

3-1-1 Penalty for illegal substitution shall supersede the penalty for batting out of order.

3-3-1f Prohibits team personnel from wearing bandanas..

3-3-1g Prohibits team personnel from wearing body paint or objectionable body markings

3-3-1h Emphasis and clarification has been given to taunting and baiting rule to expand coverage.

3-3-1q Team personnel shall not use tobacco or tobacco-like products within confines of the field.

4-2 State associations may adopt game-ending procedures.

7-3-1h Batter may leave box if catcher does not catch the pitched ball.

8-4-1a Batter-runner is out when he intentionally interferes with the catcher's attempt to field the ball after a third strike.

10-1-8 Umpire shall not use tobacco or tobacco-like products on or in the vicinity of playing field.

10-2-31 Rectify any situation in which an umpire's decision that was reversed has placed either team at a disadvantage.
