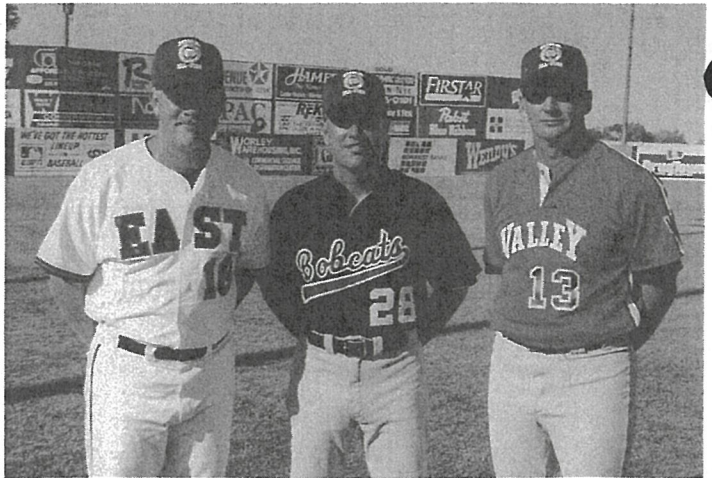
## SPECIAL THANKS TO COACHES WHO COLLECTED EXTRA FEES FOR THEIR PLAYERS:

Umpires should also nominate candidates from their district.

**COMMITTEE CHAIRMEN:** Now is the time for the committee chairmen to start collecting information for their meeting at the clinic. Start things rolling, contact your committees and come in with some good reports. Committee chairmen should keep their committee posted about ideas and meeting times.

**1997 NATIONAL FEDERATION BASEBALL MAJOR RULE CHANGES:**

2-10-2 Neither team shall leave its dugout (bench) or bullpen area while the pre-game conference is being conducted.

Rational: The committee was concerned with the safety of participants involved in the pre-game conference and eliminating distractions that are often a result of teams warming up on the field.

3-3-1g Delete the rule

Rationale: The rules committee and the National Federation believe that situations involving objectionable markings is better served by local educators.

3-3-2 A coach who is ejected shall leave the vicinity of the playing area immediately and is prohibited from further contact, direct or indirect, with the team during the remainder of the game.

Rationale: Rules did not specify what happens to an ejected coach. Now the coach must immediately leave the vicinity of the playing area and have no communication with team personnel during the remainder of the game.

10-2-3j The Umpire-in-chief shall keep a written record of both defensive and offensive team charge conferences.

Rationale: The umpire-in-chief has been required to record defensive conferences for some time. During a long inning, an umpire or coach may forget that the offense has used up its conference should another be requested. Also, in the event of a suspended game, it would be prudent to have recorded the offensive conferences as well as the defensive conferences.

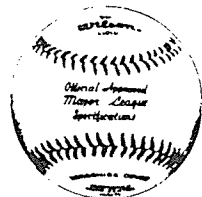
## IOWA HIGH SCHOOL BASEBALL COACHES ASSOCIATION ACADEMIC ALL-STATE TEAM
