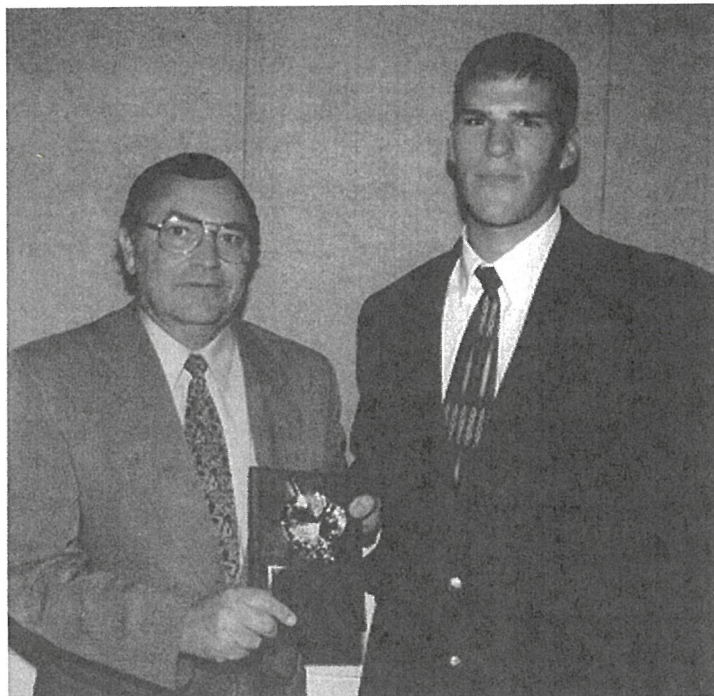

## Trevor Pals Wins The Lanny Peterson

**Award:** The recipient of the Lanny Peterson Award was Trevor Pals, of Clinton High School. Trevor had an ACT score of 35; he ranked 1st in his graduating class of 287 with a GPA of 4.576. State of Iowa Scholar, President's Award for Educational Excellence. QUAD CITY TIMES Academic Scholar, Army Reserve national Scholar/Athlete Award, Air Force Math & Science Award, James Elsesser Scholarship, Academic All-Conference in Baseball and Soccer. Great River Bend Cyclone Scholarship, Academic Pursuit Quiz Bowl Honors. DES MOINES REGISTER Academic All State Team-Southeast Region, USA TODAY Academic Team honorable Mention. National Merit Scholar Program Commended Scholar, Top 2% Tandy Technology Scholar, Tandy Scholar Recognition in Math, Science & Computers. Iowa Engineering Society State Scholarship, University of Iowa Presidential Scholarship, University of Iowa Engineering Excellence Scholar, Purdue University Golden Honors Scholar, Purdue University Valedictorian Scholarship and many more. Trevor participated in soccer and baseball during his high school career. He hit .438 his senior year, with 13 doubles, 1 triple and seven homeruns. He had 29 RBI's. He was involved in pitching also, having a 4-5 record, with a 4.58 ERA. He was All-Conference in 1998 and 1999. Trevor plans on attending University of Iowa, enrolling in the school of Electrical Engineering.

This award, named for the work Lanny has done for the Association and as a baseball umpire, is given to a player selected from the players who were nominated for the academic All-State team. This award is announced at the Recognition Banquet and presented to the player who exhibits the high academic and athletic standards which Lanny Peterson exemplified during his career as a teacher and umpire at Linn Mar and Kennedy High Schools.

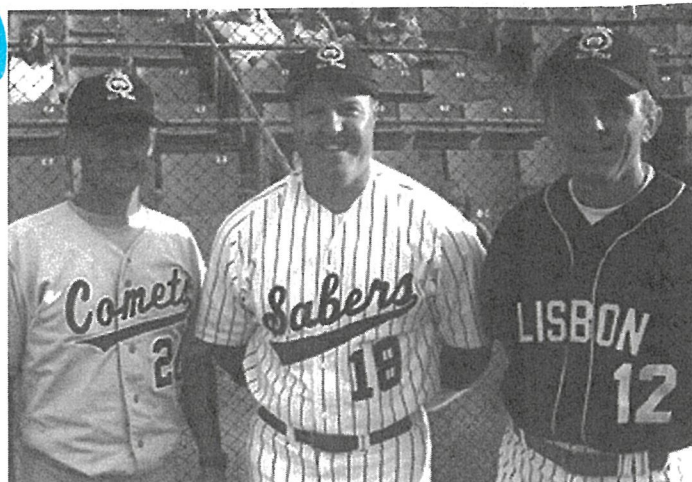

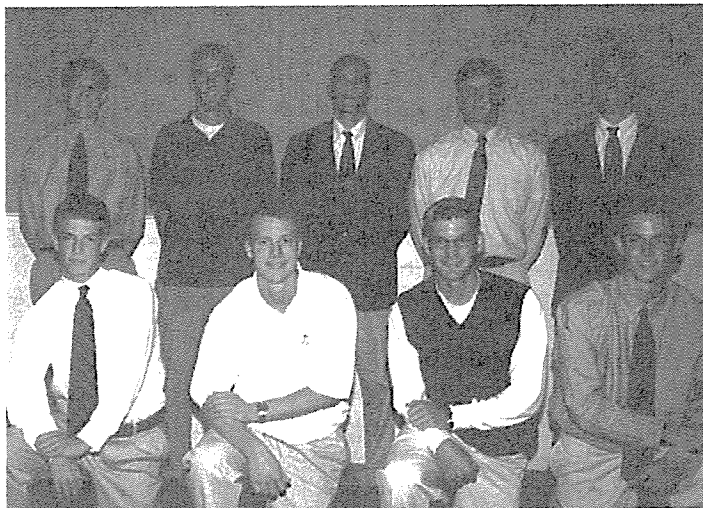

## 2000 National Federation Baseball Major Rule Changes:

**1-1-5**---Beginning January 1, 2001, the catcher's helmet and mask combination shall be required.

**Rationale:** Previously there was no standard

**1-3-4**---The coefficient of restitution (COR) of baseballs shall not exceed .555.

**Rationale:** To help ensure consistency concerning ball liveliness. Coefficient of restitution is a measure of ball liveliness.

**1-3-5**---Beginning in 2000, baseballs shall have the NFHS authenticating mark.

**Rationale:** To help ensure ensure that balls meet NFHS specifications.

**1-3-5**---Note 2: A bat performance standard shall be implemented January 1, 2002.

**Rationale:** Risk minimization, maintenance of the appropriate balance between offense and defense and preservation of the sound tradition of the sport are the reasons for the rules change.

**2-28-3**---Time of the pitch in the windup position has been revised..

**Rationale:** With the change in 6-1-2, certain revisions needed to be made to be consistent the new rule (6-1-2).

**6-1-2**---A pitcher may assume the windup position with his hands apart and then bring them together. After bringing his hands together, the time of the pitch would then be the moment he makes any motion with his arms or legs prior to delivering the pitch.

**Rationale:** The rule was not being enforced the same throughout the country. The new rule is intended to make understanding and enforcement easier for coaches and umpires.

**Play 2:** In the windup position, F1 takes his signal with his hands apart. He then brings his hands together and takes his signal again before delivering the pitch.

**Ruling:** Legal. F1 may bring his hands together in front of his body and hesitate before pitching.

**7-3-1**---If the batter leaves the batter's box, delaying the game, and none of the exceptions to the batter's box rule applies, the plate umpire shall charge a strike to the batter. Only if batters begin to delay the game and take advantage of the spirit of the rule with enforcement be necessary.

**Rationale:** The rules change better addresses the intent of the rule.

**Play 3:** B1, after a called strike, steps out of the batter's box to visit with the on-deck batter. The umpire tell B1 to return to the batter's box. B1 ignores the umpire's request.

**Ruling:** The umpire shall call a strike on B1. Whether the batter delays or not is always umpire judgement.

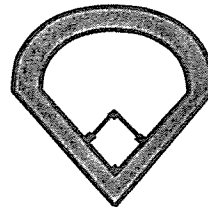



**Scott Pose,** from West Des Moines Dowling has been playing with the Royals this year after coming over from the Yankees.

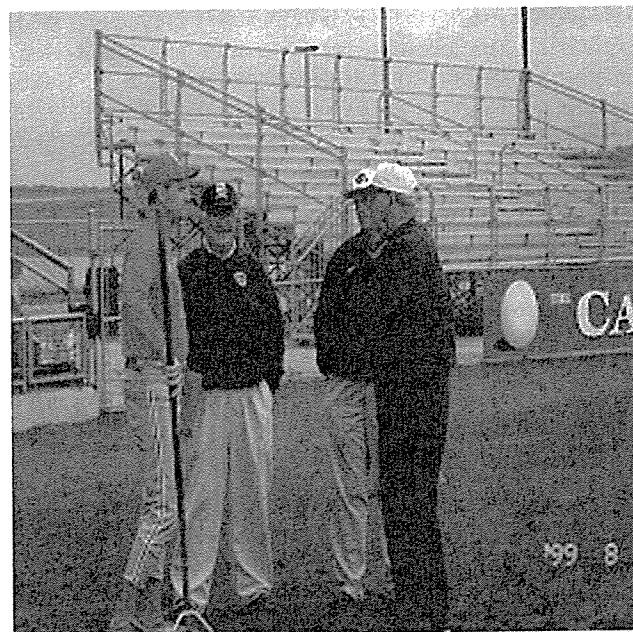

**Bob Vrbicek Passes Away:** Long time Umpire and Hall of Fame member Bob Vrbicek passed away this summer after a long battle with Parkinson's Disease. Bob was one of the first Umpires in the Hall of Fame; he also worked with Umpires in many of our early clinics. Bob was the umpire supervisor for IHSAA in the state tournament, and gave many rules meetings around eastern Iowa. Bob graduated from Wilson High School in Cedar Rapids, going to Iowa Teachers College in Cedar Falls after graduating from high school. He then went into the service for several years, coming back to Cedar Rapids, where he coached and officiated in football, basketball and baseball for many years. He is a member of the IHSAA Officials Hall of Fame as well as the IHSBCA Hall of Fame. Bob taught and coached in Cedar Rapids for many years, was an Athletic Director at Marion and ended his teaching career in Cedar Rapids as a facilitator at Jefferson High School. Bob left a wife, Jeraldine, two sons and a daughter. Bob will be missed by his many friends.

**Ankeny baseball coach sues school board for slander:**

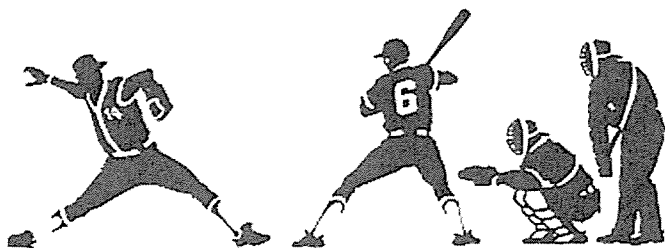

**CHANGE IN BAT RULE PROPOSED**

The National Federation of State High School Associations' Baseball R Committee has proposed a change in the specifications for non-wood bats in size, weight and moment of inertia would replicate wood.

The new rule, which, if adopted by the NFHS Board of Directors, would phased in through the 2001 season, would require that non-wood bats have a 2-inch maximum barrel diameter, a minus-3 unit maximum differential (measured without the grip) and a minimum moment of inertia of 9,000 oz-in<sup>2</sup> measured at the 6-inch point from the knob. Such a weight and moment of inertia would cause the effort required to swing a non-wood bat to replicate closely effort required to swing a wooden bat.

The committee noted that it intends to adopt a maximum exit ball speed well, but stated that it believed it was premature to do so at this point and to consider adoption of a maximum exit speed of the ball next summer, with target implementation of January 2002.

Currently, high school baseball rules limit the barrel diameter to 2 1/2 inch and allow for a minus-5 difference in the length and weight of the bat, which means that a bat cannot weigh more than 5 ounces less than the length of the bat, e.g., a 35-inch-long bat cannot be less than 30 ounces. If the new rule approved, a 35-inch-long bat could not weigh less than 32 ounces.

Because of the unusually high level of interest and the diversity of opinion that exists throughout the nation with respect to baseball bats, the NFHS Board of Directors decided that this proposed bat rule change should be circulated to the NFHS membership and other interested parties known to the NFHS, as well as released to the media and the general public through the NFHS Web site (nfhs.org). The NFHS Board of Directors will meet by conference call to consider adoption of the proposal.

The Baseball Rules Committee had the following to say regarding its proposal to implement the aforementioned bat standards:

"We do not want to act in a way that imposes undue hardship on any of the affected parties student-athletes, parents, high schools, dealers and manufacturers. Rules are exact, but the rule-making process often cannot be. We must do the best job we can in the midst of well-meaning but often conflicting interests and beliefs. At this time, the changes we are proposing seem to us to be appropriate for play at the high school level.

"With respect to implementation, we are guided by the premise that the greater the safety risk posed by a given product or procedure, the greater the economic dislocation appropriate when fashioning a remedy. Bats pose some safety risks to student-athletes, coaches, umpires and spectators. The abrupt disallowance of certain previously permissible bats would cause some hardship to student-athletes, parents, high schools, dealers and manufacturers.

"We are aware that student-athletes have suffered bat-related injuries in 1999 and in previous years. However, the committee is not aware of a material change in the rate of such injuries. Nor does the committee believe that the rate of such injuries has yet become materially greater than it would be if wooden bats were in general use. The change proposed by the committee may be viewed, in part as precautionary against a future uptrend in injuries."

The rule change suggested by the committee is a lowering of the ceiling of permissible bat performance. Non-wood bats meeting the new three-part criteria set forth herein have always been permissible and student-athletes and high schools are free to utilize them immediately.

The committee has recommended a two-year phase-out period for bats that are currently permissible but that would no longer be allowed after the new rule takes full effect. During the first year (the 2000 season), such bats, whenever purchased, could be used. During the second year (the 2001 season), such bats that were purchased before the end of the 1999-2000 academic year could be used. Effective with the 2002 season, such bats would no longer be permissible.
