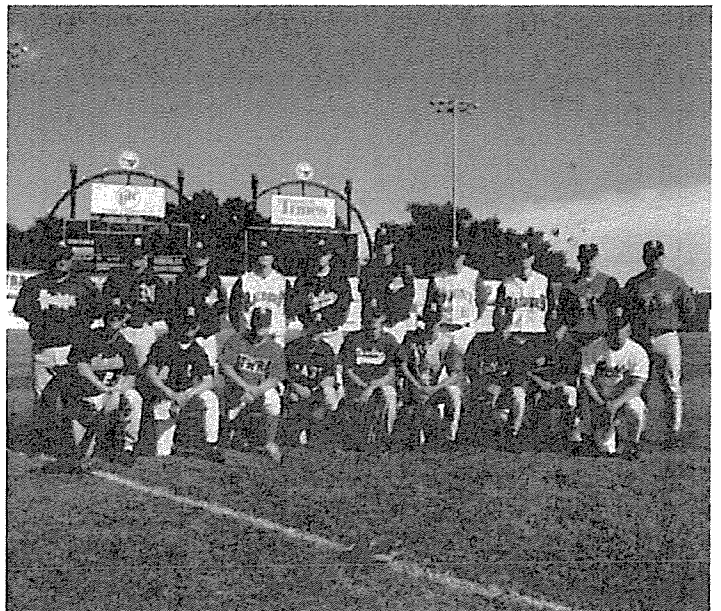
All the players and coaches are to be congratulated.

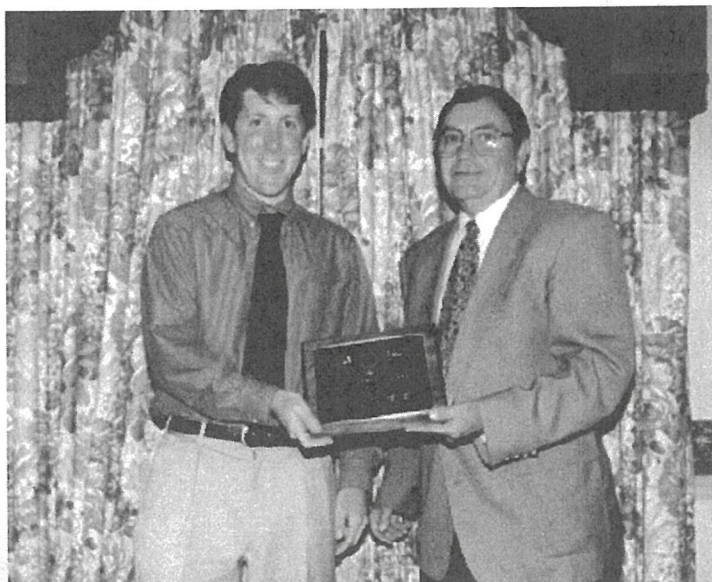
2000 All-Star Most Valuable Player Awards:

The All-Star Most Valuable Players were: Small East, Ben Wyckoff, Center Point; Large East, Ryan Trytten, Ottumwa; Small West, Matt Fjelland, North Polk; Large West, Matt Daeges, Harlan. Congratulations to these fine young ball players.

Nathan Spanheimer Wins The Lanny Peterson Award:

The recipient of the Lanny Peterson Award was Nathan Spanheimer, of Iowa City West High School. Nathan had an ACT score of 35; he ranked 1st in his graduating class of 360 with a GPA of 4. His honors include: State of Iowa Scholar, President's Award for Educational Excellence, National Merit Scholar, National Honor Society, West High Honor Roll (9-12), Lamp of Learning Award (9-12), State Mathematics Competition Qualifier, Regional Mathematics Competition Qualifier, Regional Mathematics Team Championship, American Invitational Mathematics Examination, Iowa ARML Team Qualifier, American High School Mathematics Examination, six top ten finishes in state and national competitions. He was involved in Iris Radio Programming for the Blind Volunteer Reader, Johnson County Senior Center "Meals on Wheels" Home Deliverer, Johnson County Democrats Volunteer, Babe Ruth Assistant All-Star Coach. Biological Research Aide at V.A. Hospital, Johnson County American Legion Baseball Team. He hit .292 his senior year, with 1 double and 1 homerun. He had 19 RBI's. He was also involved in pitching, having a 2-4 record, with a 3.19 ERA. Nathan is attending Duke University enrolling in Pre-Med.

This award, named for the work Lanny has done for the Association and as a baseball umpire, is given to a player selected from the players who were nominated for the academic All-State team. This award is announced at the Recognition Banquet and presented to the player who exhibits the high academic and athletic standards which Lanny Peterson exemplified during his career as a teacher and umpire at Linn Mar and Kennedy High Schools.



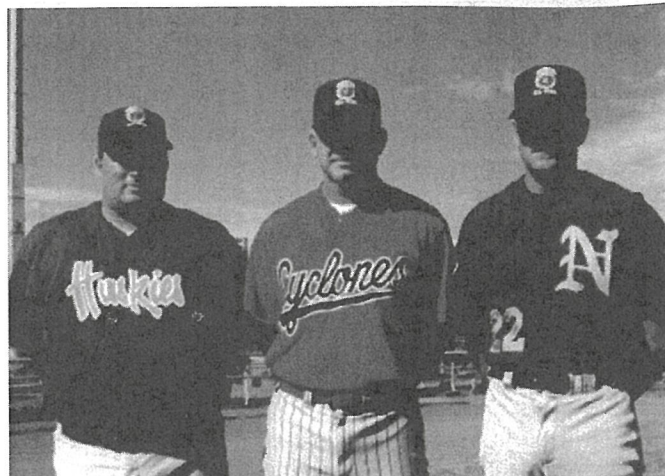

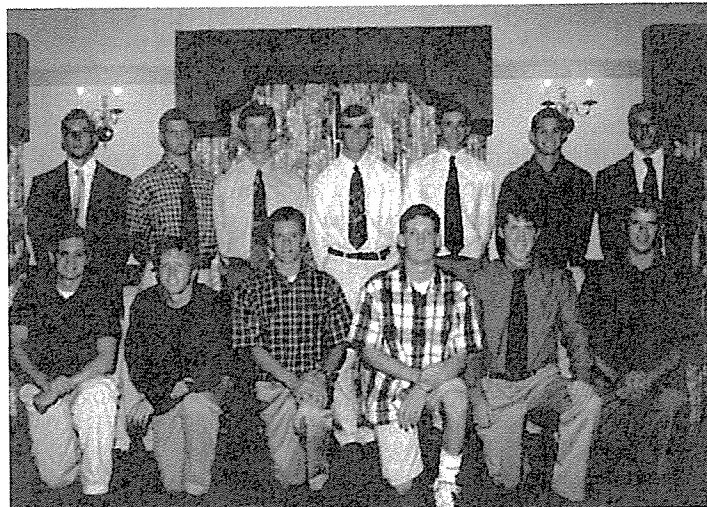

2001 National Federation Baseball Major Rule Changes:

1-1-5--- By state association adoption, to allow for special occasions, commemorative or memorial patches, that will be uniformly placed, not to exceed 2 1/4 square inches, to be worn on jerseys in an appropriate and dignified manner without compromising the integrity of the uniform.

Rationale: To provide state associations some flexibility in certain unforeseen situations that would warrant such a request from a member school.

1-1-5--- Beginning January 1, 2003 the catcher's helmet and mask combination shall meet the NOCSAE standard.

Rationale: The original effective date may have been a bit ambitious. Distributors claim that the manufacturers have not yet tooled up for this process.

1-3-5--- The diameter at the thickest part of the bat should be no greater than an 2 5/8", the bat shall not weigh, numerically, more than three ounces less than the length of the bat (e.g., a 33-inch-long bat cannot weight less than 30 ounces).

Rationale: The NFHS Board of Directors approved this bat specification during the January midwinter meeting and was unable to be included in the 2000 Baseball Rules Book.

1-3-5--- Bats that are altered, that deface the ball, or that do not meet the rule specifications are illegal. (see 7-4-1a). Bats that are broken, cracked, or dented shall be removed upon discovery without penalty.

Rationale: The committee was concerned that the penalty (The batter is out when he enters the batter's box with an illegal bat or is discovered having used an illegal bat. If the infraction is discovered before the next pitch following the turn at bat of the player who used an illegal bat, the defense may take the penalty or the result of the play.) was too severe if a broken, cracked, or dented bat was discovered. However, bats that are altered, that deface the ball, do not meet the rule specification, shall still carry the same penalty as before.

2-28-3--- For the windup position, the "time of the pitch" occurs when the pitcher

6-1-2:--- (a) first starts any movement of his arm(s) or leg(s)

6-2-3--- after stepping onto the pitcher's plate with his hands already together in front of his body; (b) with both arms at his side, first starts any movement with both arms or leg(s) prior to the pitch; (c) with either hand in front of the body and the other hand at his side, after bringing his hands together, first starts any movement of his arms(s) or leg(s) prior to the pitch. For the set position, the "time of the pitch" occurs the instant the pitcher, after coming to a complete and discernible stop, starts any movement with arm(s) and/or leg(s) that commits him to pitch.

Rationale: There was some confusion as to how the rule was being applied. This simply clarifies the rule.

4-2-3--- The umpire-in-chief shall receive verification from both coaches that all participants are properly equipped and emphasize to the coaches and captains that all participants are expected to exhibit good sporting behavior throughout the game(s).

Rationale: To officially, by rule, emphasize the importance of sportsmanship to the educational values of baseball.

6-1-4--- Replace the position of the pitcher's glove in the set position. The new rule reads "He shall come to a complete and discernible stop (a change of direction is not considered an acceptable stop) with the ball in both hands in front of the body and his glove at or below his chin.

Rationale: The committee wanted to better clarify the intent of what was required in the set position.

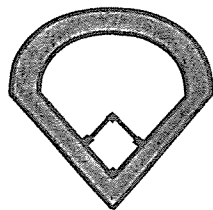

25 YEARS AGO (1975): Jim Jagim, Valley West Des Moines was President. Burlington and Dick Wagner was the Summer State champ Class 2A. Granville-Spalding and Jim Walker won Summer Championships Class 1A. 140 coaching changes took place. Dues were \$3.00. Bob Leach took over the Marshalltown High position from Rick Mathews.

20 YEARS AGO (1980): Terry Heald of Marion was President. Chuck Sutherland of East Des Moines' team beat Charles City and Gene Schultz of Kee High of Lansing defeated Bancroft St. John for the State Championships. 148 coaches dropped out of coaching. Jim Mahoney and 2A West won the All-Star Series.

15 YEARS AGO (1985): Jim Mahoney of Johnston was President. State Champions and Coaches were: Brad Clement, Marshalltown; Ron Wymer, Turkey Valley; Marv Thelen-Remsen St. Marys; Eugene Meister-Bancroft St. Johns. Tom Jenk, Jr. and the Small East team won the All-Star Series. 133 coaches dropped out of coaching. All-Star Games were in Des Moines. Bill Freese, Davenport Central, and Dave Posegate, Ames, retired.

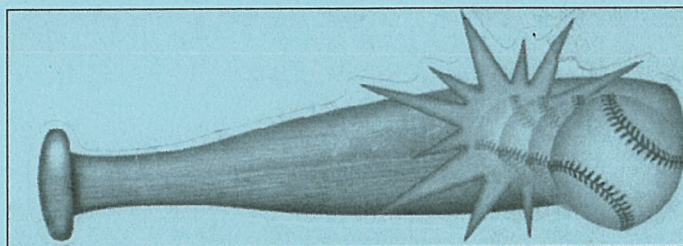

POP FLIES TO THE INFIELD



Man on 2nd base, or
Men on 2nd and 3rd bases.

Pitcher:
Back up Home plate.

Catcher:
Cover Home plate.

1st Baseman:
Cut-off man! Take a position
about 45 feet from Home plate
in line with left fielder and
Home plate.

2nd Baseman:
Cover 2nd base.

Shortstop:
May have to cover 3rd base if
3rd baseman cannot recover.

3rd Baseman:
Cover 3rd base if possible.

Left Fielder:
Make low throw to the plate.

Center Fielder:
Back up left fielder.

Right Fielder:
Come in quickly to try and
cover 1st base.

An infield pop fly will be all infielders' responsibility, and they must try for the ball until one fielder takes charge by calling for the play.

1. When calling, yell loudly three or four times.

As designated in the diagram, each infielder has his area, but he may take the play out of his area if he has taken charge of the play.

NOTE: Especially on windy days, do not call for play too soon.

WHEN PITCHER HELPS: On questionable pop flies around the mound area, and after one or more infielders have called for the play the pitcher then calls the last name of the fielder he thinks is in the best position to make the play.

The catcher must not give up on pop flies too quickly.

All pop flies directly behind the 1st and 3rd basemen will be the responsibility of the 2nd baseman and the shortstop.
