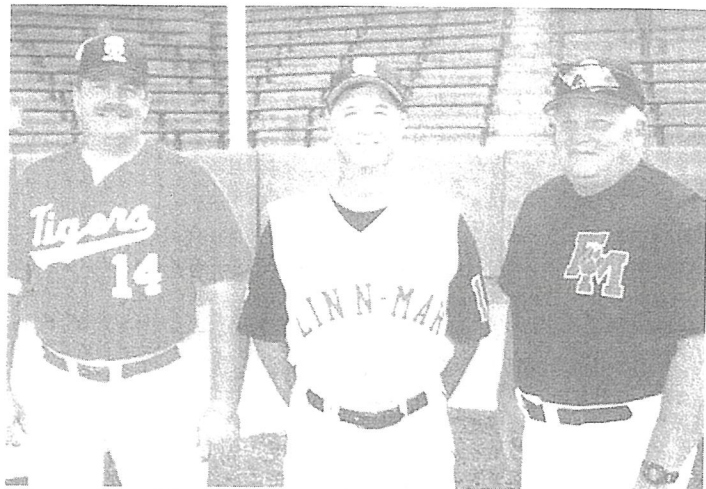

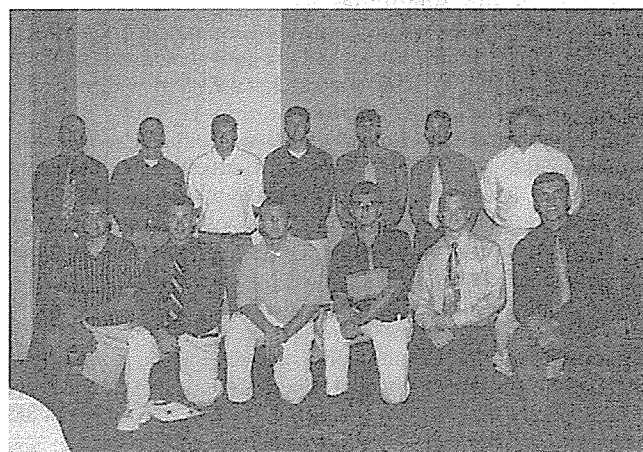

2002 National Federation Baseball Major Rule Changes:

In another move toward minimizing the risk of injury from bats in high school baseball, the National Federation of State High School Associations' Baseball Rules Committee has approved the Ball Exit Speed Ratio (BESR) performance standard for all non-wood bats, effective January 1, 2003.

At its June 22-24 meeting in Indianapolis, the Baseball Rules Committee voted that all non-wood bats must have the BESR certification mark to be legal for high school baseball beginning with the 2003 season.

In addition to the current requirements (which took effect with the 2001 season) of 2 5/8 inches for the diameter of the bat barrel and a minus-3 differential between the length and weight of the bat (a 33-inch-long bat, for example, cannot weigh less than 30 ounces), the BESR mark ensures a maximum exit speed of 97 miles per hour and that the bat has met the moment-of-inertia requirement.

"Adding the BESR requirement for bats used in high school baseball is a continuation of changes made for the 2001 season to ensure that bat performance mirrors the performance of wood bats," said Elliot Hopkins, NFHS liaison to the Baseball Rules Committee. "The main goals with all the recent changes in bat requirements have been to minimize the risk of injury to high school student athletes, and maintain the balance between offense and defense and keep within the sound traditions of the game."

Another major change approved by the NFHS Baseball Rules Committee was the return of the appeal play in high school baseball after an absence of 18 years. Rule 8-2 now will state: "For failure to touch a base (advancing or returning), or failure to tag up as soon as the ball is touched on a caught fly ball, the runner may be called out if an appeal is made by the defensive team." The defensive team may appeal during a live ball immediately following the play and before a pitch, legal or illegal. A dead-ball appeal can be made by a coach or any defensive player, with or without the ball, by verbally stating that the runner missed the base or left the base too soon.

Hopkins said the appeal play is a tradition in baseball; and since the play has remained in effect in other rules codes, the committee believed it was time to restore the play in high school baseball.

In addition to the additional bat requirements, four other equipment-related changes were approved by the committee. In Rule 1-1-5, the committee voted that the catcher's helmet should have double ear flaps. Beginning January 1, 2003, the catcher's helmet and mask combination shall meet the NOCSAE standard; in order to qualify for the NOCSAE standard, the testing procedures entails side-of-head impact test.

Previously, Rule 1-1-6 simply stated that casts, splints and braces must be padded. The committee approved more specific language to state that all casts, splints and braces on coaches and players must be padded with at least one-half inch of closed-cell, slow-recovery rubber or other material of the same minimum thickness and having similar physical properties.

A note was added to Rule 1-3-5 which gives the umpire authority, at his discretion and with no penalty to the offending team, to remove a bat that continually discolors the game ball. In Rule 1-1-6, the committee added more specific language to state that any player equipment judged by the umpire to be unreasonably dangerous is illegal.

Other rules changes approved by the NFHS Baseball Rules Committee:

- Coaches and umpires, in addition to players, now may wear prostheses and use mobility devices.
- State associations now have the option of using the 1 0-run mercy rule.

Baseball is the fourth-most popular sport for boys at the high school level with 451,701 participants during the 1999-2000 season, according to the 2000 High School Athletics Participation Survey conducted by the NFHS. In terms of school sponsorship, baseball ranks third with 14,610 schools offering the sport for boys. In addition, there were 1,354 girls in 94 high schools across the country who participated in baseball during the 1999-2000 season.

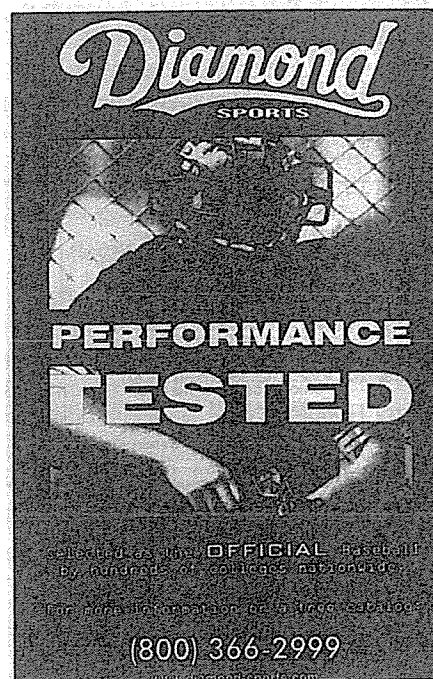

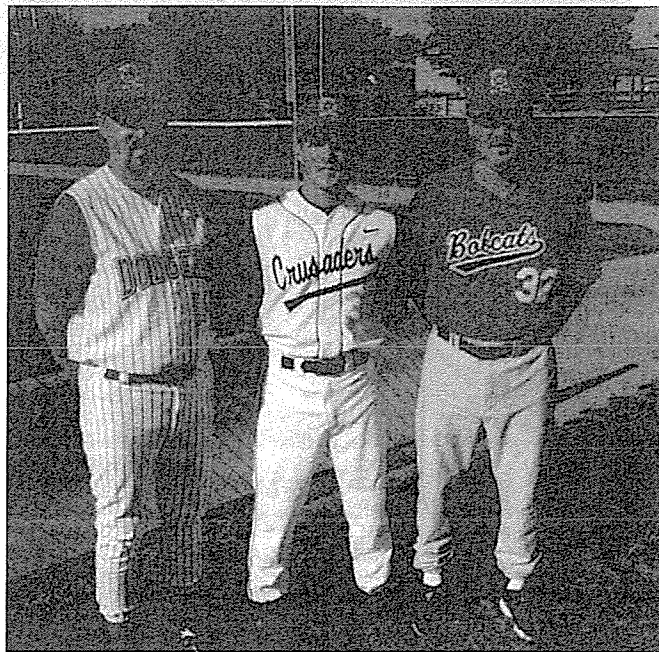

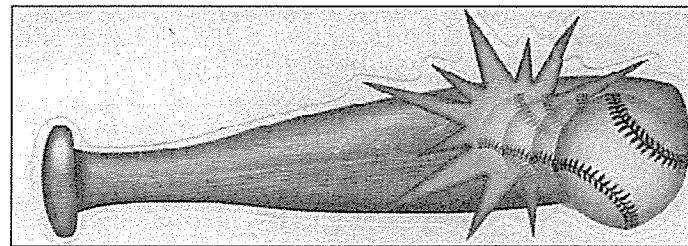
2001 All-Star Baseball Olympics Winners:

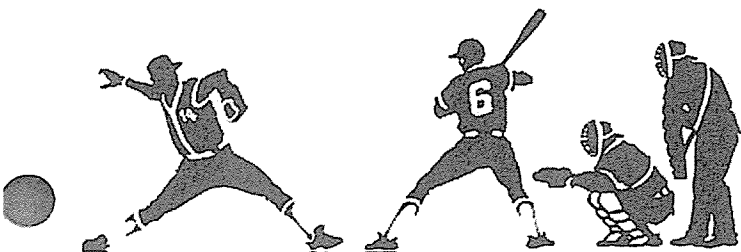
