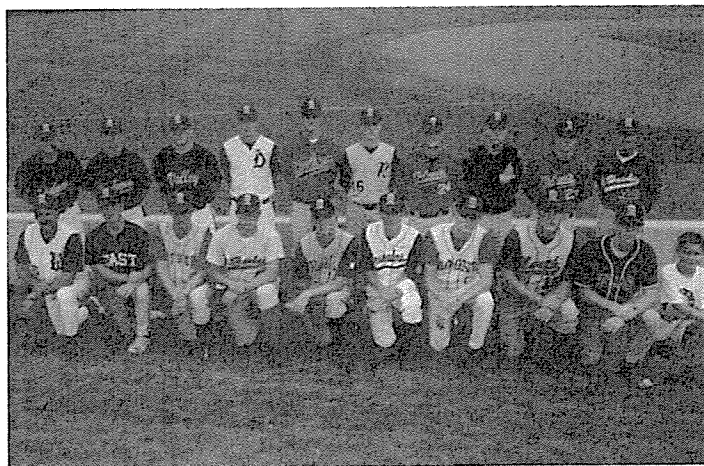
All the players and coaches are to be congratulated.

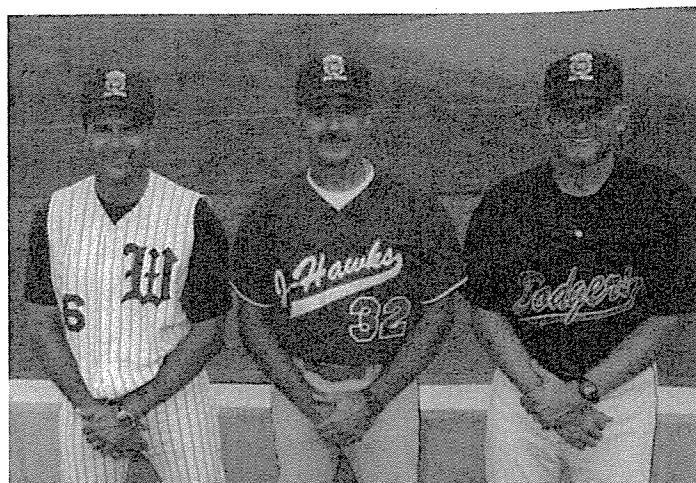
### Mike Mogard, Marshalltown, wins the Lanny Peterson Award:

The recipient of the Lanny Peterson Award was Mike Mogard of Marshalltown High School. Mike ranked 1st in his graduating class with a GPA of 4. His honors include: Baseball and Wrestling Varsity Letters (9,10,11,12), Division 2 rating for vocal solo (10), Division 1 rating for vocal solo (11), National Honor Society (11,12). He was a member of the Spanish Club for four years. In his Community Service Activities he belonged to FAAD (Friends against Alcohol and Drugs), PACT (Peers Actively Communicating with Teens), Dare Role Model Program, Youth Group and Bible Study and Student Rotarian and helped organize a school-wide canned food drive and participated in the annual Salvation Army Christmas supper. Mike played outfield on the State Champion Marshalltown team. He hit .440 his senior year, with 13 doubles, 1 triple and 10 homeruns. He had 57 RBIs. He was chosen on the All State Super team in 2001 and 2002. Mike is attending University of Iowa enrolled in Pre-Dentistry. Coach Hanson said Mike Mogard is the most disciplined, hardworking student athlete he has ever coached.

This award, named for the work Lanny has done for the Association and as a baseball umpire, is given to a member of the Academic All-State team. This award is announced at the Recognition Banquet and presented to the player who exhibits the high academic and athletic standards which Lanny Peterson exemplified during his career as a teacher and umpire at Linn Mar and Kennedy High Schools.

### Large Number Of Academic Nominations:

A large number of Academic nominations were received. The committee chose 20 First Team members and 20 Honorable Mention. This list appears elsewhere in the newsletter. We want to congratulate these young men for their outstanding high school careers in academics as well as in baseball.

### Jeff Clement, IHSBCA/PRO-LINE HAT Player of the Year:

Jeff Clement of Marshalltown received the IHSBCA/Pro-Line Hat Player of the Year Award. Jeff had four outstanding years at Marshalltown. He won the home run Individual honors in the Baseball Olympics and also was named to the Super Team for four years. Jeff will play baseball at the University of Southern California. Jeff ended his prep career with 75 home runs, plus 2 in the All-Star Series. He set a national record with 75 home runs, two more than James Peterson of Winterset, when they broke the record of 70 held by Drew Henson, Brighton, MI set in 1995-98. Jeff also set a record in receiving the most bases on balls, with 72 walks this summer and 214 bases on balls for his career to top the national charts. He was named to the 2002 BCA All-American First Team.

Congratulations to Jeff for his outstanding high school career.

Umpires should also nominate candidates from their district.

## 2003 National Federation Baseball Major Rule Changes:

**1-2-5 (new)** It is recommended that when the dugout area is extended, for any reason, R shall be extended toward the out field on a line parallel to the foul line. The extension of the dugout area shall be equally applied for both teams.  
**Rationale:** Dugout areas are being extended closer to the foul lines and home plate causing concern over liability issues. Also, this is providing greater opportunities for unsportsmanlike actions to occur.

**A2-29-6 (new)** Defensive appeal of a runner failing to touch a base or tag up is not a play.  
**Rationale:** To make the distinction that an appeal is not a play.

**3-1-11** Add to the rule: have any object in his possession in the coach's box other than a rule book, scorebook, a Personal Digital Assistant (PDA) or comparable electronic score-recording device which shall be used for scorekeeping purposes only;  
**Rationale:** To allow a coach the flexibility to use a traditional scorebook or a comparable electronic device.

**3-3-2** Revise last line: He may return when requested by an umpire to attend to an ill or injured player.  
**Rationale:** The committee felt R was not appropriate for an ejected coach to arbitrarily return to the playing area unless specifically requested by an umpire.

**5-2-2b** Exception Change rule to: A runner who is on or beyond a succeeding base when the ball became dead, or advances and touches a succeeding base after the ball became dead, may not return and shall be called out upon proper and successful appeal.  
**Rationale:** Brings this ruling in alignment with appeal rule instituted in 2001.

**8-2-5** Add to the rule: If a runner who misses any base (including home plate) or leaves a base too early, desires to return to touch the base, he must do so immediately. If the ball becomes dead and the runner is on or beyond a succeeding base, he cannot return to the missed base and, therefore, is subject to being declared out upon proper and successful appeal.  
**Rationale:** Recommended in order to clean up affected rules from last year's rule change.

**8-2 (Art. 1-5)** For failure to touch a base (advancing and returning), or failure to tag up  
 Penalty as soon as the ball is touched on a caught fly ball, the runner may be called out if an appeal is made by the defensive team. The defense may appeal during a live ball immediately following the play and before a pitch (legal or illegal), granting an intentional base on balls, or before the next play or attempted play. If the offensive team initiates a play before the next pitch, the defensive team does not lose the right to appeal. A live ball appeal may be made by a defensive player with the ball in his possession by tagging the runner or touching the base that was missed or left too early. A dead ball appeal may be made by a coach or any defensive player with or without the ball by verbally stating that the runner missed the base or left the base too early. Appeals must be made (1) before the next legal or illegal pitch, (2) at the end of an inning, before the pitcher and all infielders have left fair territory, (3) before an intentional base on balls is granted, or (4) on the last play of the game, an appeal can be made until the umpires leave the field of play. NOTE: When a play by its very nature is imminent and is obvious to the offense, defense and umpire(s), no verbal appeal is necessary, e.g. runner attempting to retouch a base that was missed, or a failure to tag up and a throw has been made to that base or plate while a play is in progress.  
**Rationale:** Prevents the defense from intentionally walking batters it does not want to face and then appealing a missed base. Preventing the defense from making pick-off plays and then appealing a missed base. Will allow defense to appeal if offense initiates a play (i.e. stealing a base). A defensive coach shall verbally appeal only during a dead ball situation.

**8-4-2i** Add to the end of the rule: does not retouch his base before a fielder tags him out or holds the ball while touching such base after any situation (8-2-1,2,3 and 4). Umpire may also call him out at end of playing action upon proper and successful appeal. Also, it is not necessary for runner to retouch his base after a foul tip (2-16-2);  
**Rationale:** Recommended in order to clean up affected rules from last years rule change.

**B-4-2q** Add to the end of the rule: is on or beyond a succeeding base when the ball is declared dead (5-2-2b exception) after having left a base too soon on a caught fly ball, or he failed to touch a preceding base, or he continues and touches a succeeding base after the ball has become dead, and the defense initiates a proper and successful appeal.  
**Rationale:** Clarification that the runner is not automatically out at the end of all playing action unless defense makes proper appeal.

### Major Editorial Rule Changes

**8-4-2f** f. as a runner or retired runner, fails to execute a legal slide, or does not attempt to avoid the fielder or the play on a force play at any base;  
**Rationale:** This is an editorial change in order to correct a previously omitted phrase.

### Minor Editorial Rule Changes

**2-19-1** Add to the rule: (rule does not preclude outfielders from being allowed to attempt to make the catch)...  
**Rationale:** This is an editorial change to discern the outfielder's ability to attempt to make a catch.

**3-1 -2** Note Delete "c" from rule reference 6-2-2c. **Rationale:** There is no 6-2-2c exception.

**25 YEARS AGO (1977):** Jim Schulz, Bettendorf was President. Davenport West and Ken Dohse won the Class 2A Summer State championship. Johnston and Jim Mahoney won the Class 1A Summer Championship. 159 coaching changes took place. Vern Bredeson, C.R. Jefferson, Jim Laake, Benton Community, Bill Sapp, Boone all retired. First All-Star Series was won by the South. Stiff penalties for misconduct by players and coaches were going to be introduced to member schools.

**20 YEARS AGO (1982):** Byron Rhodes of BCL was President. Don Miller, Davenport Assumption; Joe McFarland, Norwalk; Dan Reid, Burlington Notre Dame and Jim Van Scoyoc, Norway won the State Championships. Mike Bradmeyer of United Community of Boone, won the Vince Meyer Award. 110 coaches dropped out of coaching. Jerry Lister and Small East won the All-Star Series.

**15 YEARS AGO (1987):** Jim Kloewer of Stuart was President. State Champions and Coaches were: Jerry Zinn and Tom Souhrada of Davenport West; Dan Bolte, Camanche; Gaylord Schelling, Tri-Center, Neola and Jim Van Scoyoc of Norway. Large West coached by Steve Mohr of Valley West Des Moines won the All-Star Series. Kevin Burns of Muscatine won the Vince Meyer Award. 119 coaches dropped out of coaching. All-Star Games were in Cedar Rapids.

**10 YEARS AGO (1992):** Jim Donohue of Martensdale-St Marys was President. Chris Crome of Davenport North won the Vince Meyer Award.
