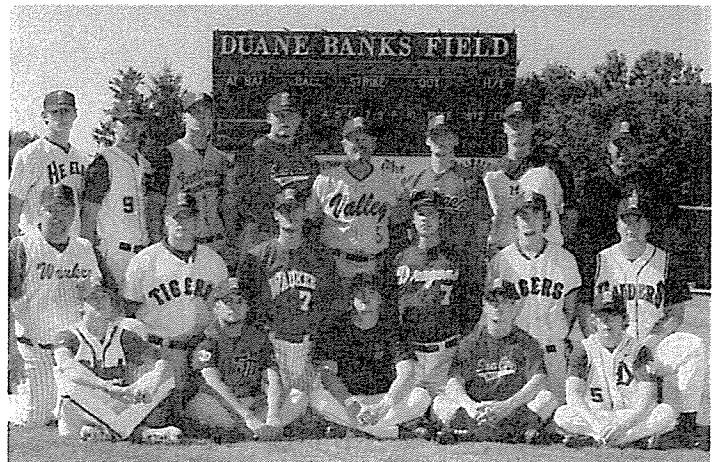

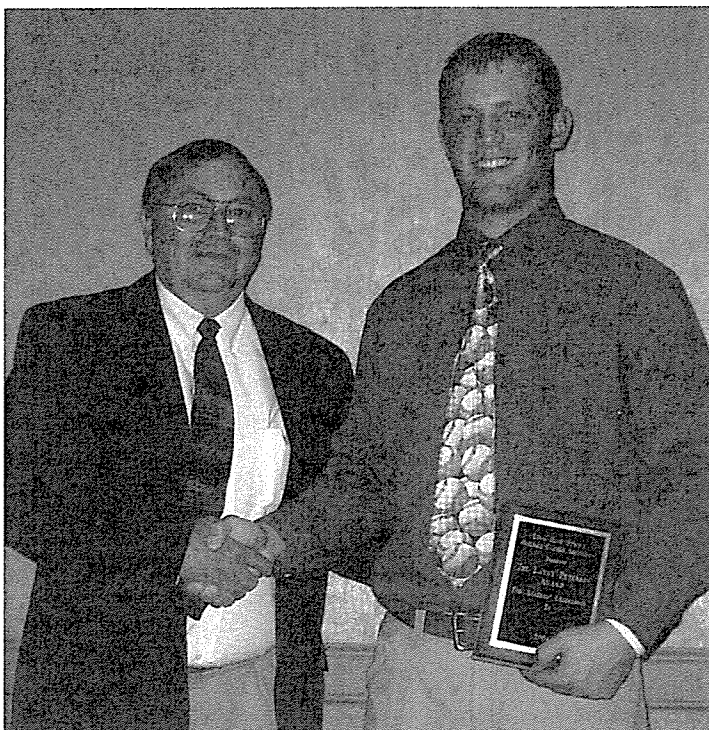
Kyle Rehnstrom wins the Lanny Peterson Award:

The recipient of the Lanny Peterson Award was Kyle Rehnstrom of Sioux Central High School. Kyle ranked 1st in his graduating class of 45 with a GPA of 3.99. His honors include Baseball Varsity Program (9,10,11,12). Kyle was the student Senate President. He was All Conference for four years. He was All District in Football, Basketball and Baseball. He was All-State his junior and senior years. He plans to play at the University of Northern Iowa as a catcher and pitcher. His pitching record was 7-0 in 2004; his over-all record was 18-2. Kyle hit .602 his senior year, with 11 doubles and 14 homeruns, 32 total over three years. He had 58 RBIs in 2004 and 144 over three years. He was chosen on the All-State team in 2003 and 2004.

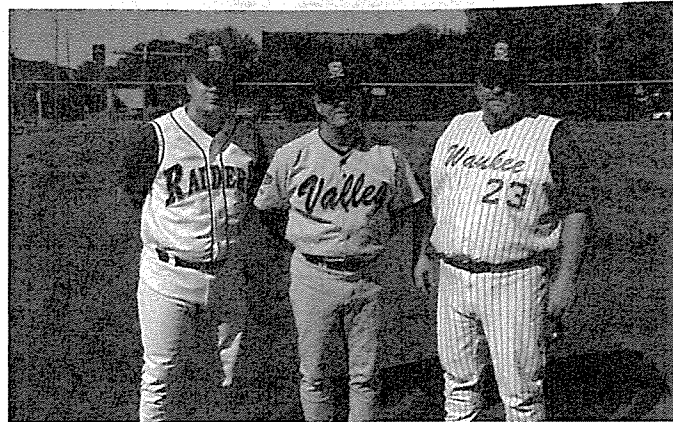
This award, named for the work Lanny has done for the Association and as a baseball umpire, is given to a member of the Academic All-State team. This award is announced at the Recognition Banquet and presented to the player who exhibits the high academic and athletic standards which Lanny Peterson exemplified during his career as a teacher and umpire at Linn Mar and Kennedy High Schools.

Tyler Howe IHSBCA/PRO-LINE HAT Player of the Year:

Tyler Howe of Northeast Goose Lake received the IHSBCA/Pro-Line Hat Player of the Year Award. Tyler had three outstanding years at Northeast (Goose Lake). Tyler led Northeast as a pitcher and hitter for three years. He had a 27-6 pitching record with a 2.00 ERA over the three years, striking out 205 while walking 78. Tyler gave up only 30 hits for the 2004 season, and had a .629 batting average. Tyler had 11 doubles (40), 3 triples (8), 8 homeruns (34), 50 RBI's in 70 times at bat and scored 43 times with 44 hits. Tyler will play baseball at Kirkwood Community College in Cedar Rapids. He was a Super Team member. He led the Small East All-Stars to second place. He was voted the MVP for the Small East.

Congratulations to Tyler for his outstanding high school career.

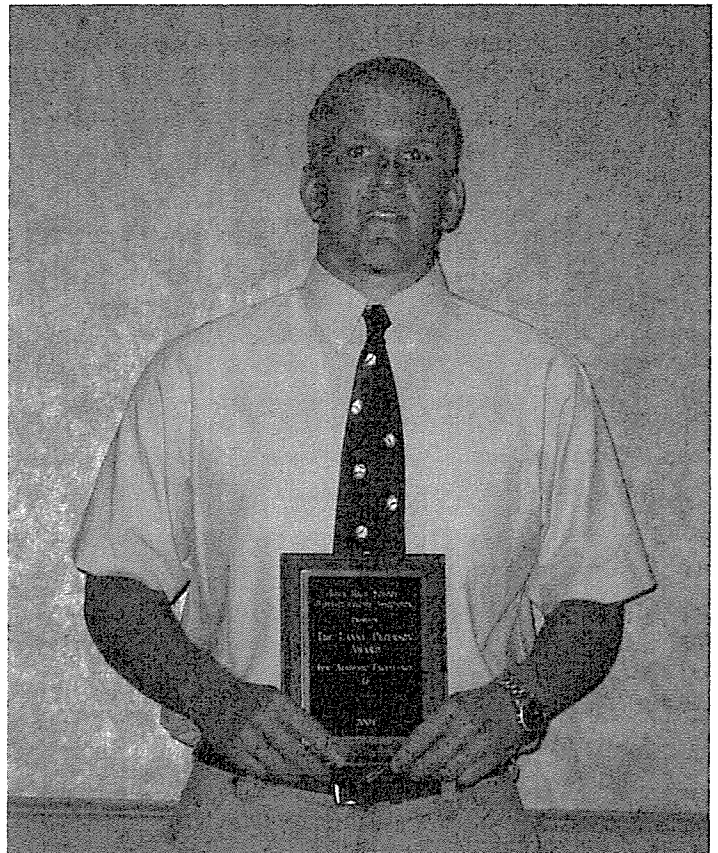
Coaching Changes: Once again there were 75 baseball coaches changing/dropping out of coaching. This is up from 2003 season when 68 coaches dropped out.

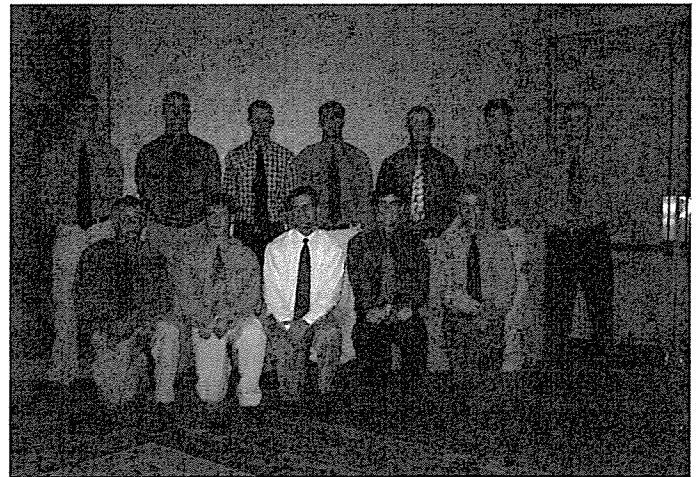

2005 National Federation Baseball Major Rule Changes:

INDIANAPOLIS, IN (June 22, 2004) — At its annual meeting in Indianapolis, Indiana, on June 18-19, the National Federation of State High School Associations (NFHS) Baseball Rules Committee defined what is a balk and what is not for a high school baseball pitcher.

Rule 6-1-1 was revised to specify when a baseball pitcher can turn his shoulders toward base runners while on the mound. It is now legal for a pitcher to turn his shoulders to check a runner if he is in the set position and in contact with the pitcher's plate. However, if the pitcher turns his shoulders in the windup position to check a runner, it is a balk. Turning the shoulders after bringing the hands together during or after the stretch is also a balk.

"The use of the shoulder turn while in the set position does not afford the pitcher an advantage," said B. Elliot Hopkins, NFHS assistant director and liaison to the NFHS Baseball Rules Committee. "The prohibition of such actually creates a disadvantage."

In other changes, Rule 1-4-6 states that players now have the option of wearing batting helmets equipped with attached facemasks or guards. Regardless of whether the mask is produced with the helmet or attached after the helmet is manufactured, all attached facemasks or guards must meet NOCSAE standards at the time of the mask's attachment.

"NOCSAE recently developed a standard for facemasks and guards, and the committee felt it would be prudent to incorporate that new standard into our existing rule," said NFHS Baseball Rules Committee Chairman Greg Brewer.

The committee also modified rules pertaining to coaches uniforms. Rule 3-2-1 was changed to state that a coach who is not in his or her team's uniform shall be restricted to the bench or dugout and cannot enter the field unless one of his or her players is ill or injured. Along the same lines, any coach occupying the coach's box must be dressed in his or her team's uniform.

Also, Rule 3-1-1 was clarified so that if an illegal player on either offense or defense is discovered by an umpire, that player shall be restricted to the bench or dugout for the rest of the game. If an illegal offensive player re-enters the game, he will be called out immediately and ejected; an illegal defensive player will simply be ejected.

Baseball is the fourth-most popular sport among boys at the high school level with 453,792 participants during the 2002-03 season, according to the High School Athletics Participation Survey conducted by the NFHS. It also ranks third in school sponsorship with 14,988 schools offering the sport.

Catching Up Column:

West Des Moines Valley added to its back-to-back Iowa 4A state championships by being named the No. 1 team in the BCA-Regal Awards sponsored Summer Baseball Top 10 for the second consecutive year. West Des Moines slipped past Wisconsin's Oak Creek for the top position. Ankeny and Lincoln D.M. finished fifth and sixth, respectively, in the Top 10 with Mason City at the No. 9 position giving Iowa four teams in final Top 10.

The four winners of the Bob Feller Iowa High School Pitching Awards are: Class 1A--Matt Davitt of Martensdale-St. Marys; Class 2A--Adam McDermott of Cascade; Class 3A--Tad Berry of Charles City; Class 4A--Jason Belk of Davenport North. The four young men were honored at the Bob Feller Museum.

Casey Blake, from Indianola, is playing third base for the Cleveland Indians having a great year!

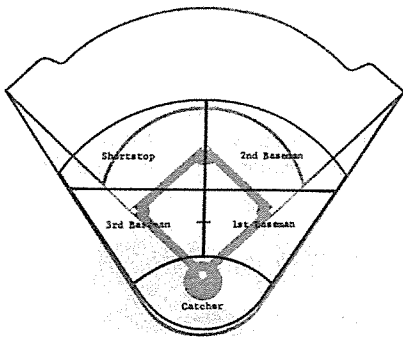

POP FLIES TO THE INFIELD



- A. An infield pop fly will be all infielders' responsibility, and they must try for the ball until one fielder takes charge by calling for the play.
 1. When calling, yell loudly three or four times.
- B. As designated in the diagram, each infielder has his area, but he may take the play out of his area if he has taken charge of the play.

NOTE: Especially on windy days, do not call for play too soon.
- C. **WHEN PITCHER HELPS:** On questionable pop flies around the sound area, and after one or more infielders have called for the play, the pitcher then calls the last name of the fielder he thinks is in the best position to make the play.
- D. The catcher must not give up on pop flies too quickly.
- E. All pop flies directly behind the 1st and 3rd basemen will be the responsibility of the 2nd baseman and the shortstop.

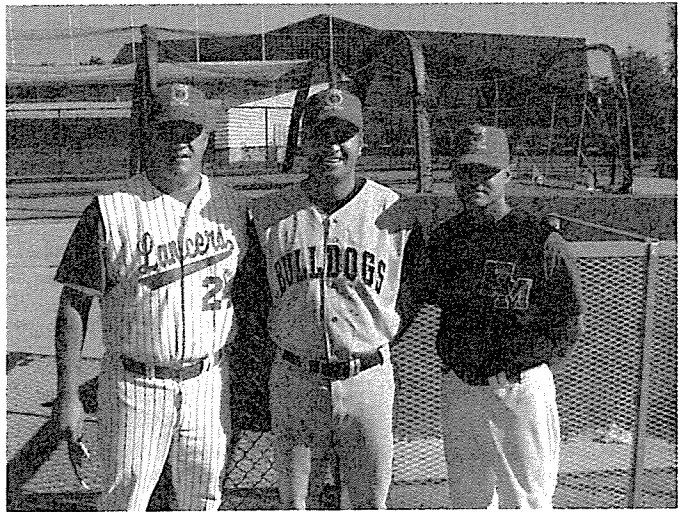

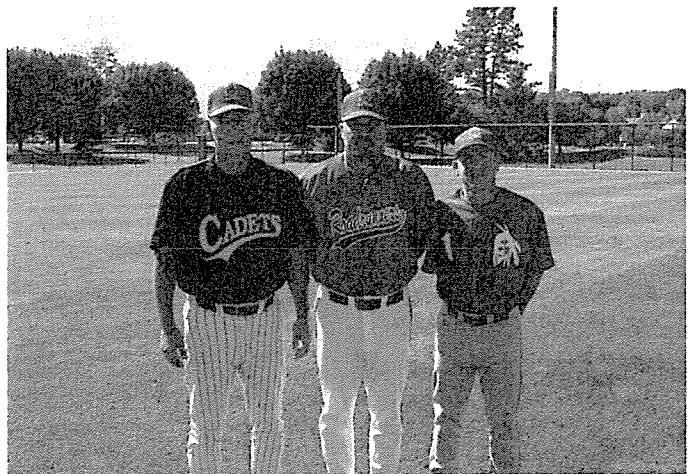
2004 All-Star Baseball Olympics Winners:

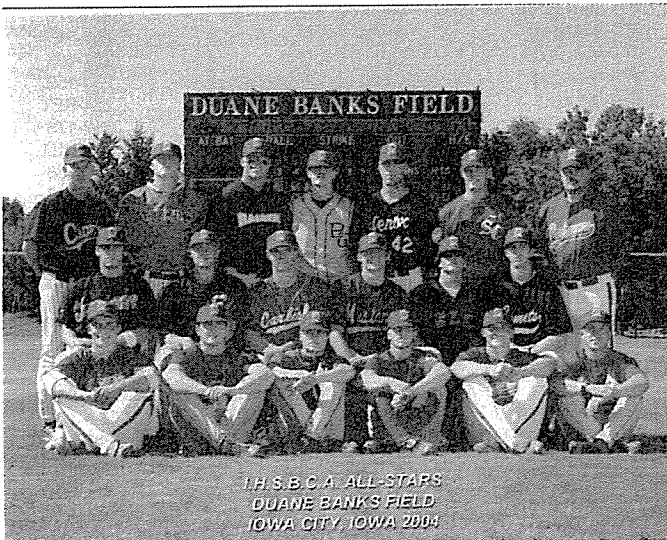
