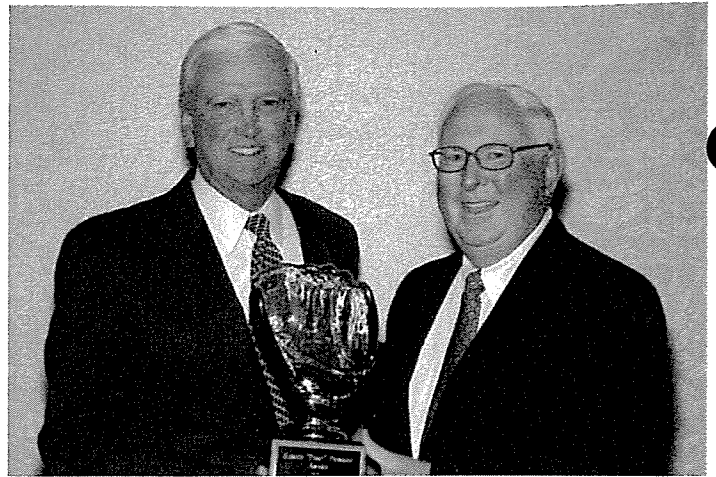

More would help to defray the cost of the All-Star Series. **It will be the high school coach's responsibility to get sponsors for the player if he wishes him to play in the All-Star games.** This policy is necessary in order to offset the high cost of putting on the All Star series. If you have any questions about this policy, contact any officer or director in your area; they will explain it to you. Sponsor names and fees must be paid to Executive Secretary no later than Saturday, July 30, if your player is selected.

All-Star Games Schedule: The players, coaches, umpires and staff will be staying at the Crowne Plaza Hotel in downtown Cedar Rapids. The Honors Banquet will be held at the Crowne Plaza Hotel, Saturday night, August 6, at 6 p. m. All games will be played at Veterans Memorial Stadium.

1/ Players will arrive Thursday, August 4th. Individual pictures for inclusion in the program will be taken after check in.

2/ Players from Small Schools East will report by 10:30 a.m. Large Schools East players will report at 10:45 a.m.

3/ Players from Small Schools West will report at 11:00 a.m. and players from Large Schools West will report at 11:15 a.m.

4/ Practice for all teams will be 12:15 p.m.--2:45 p.m. Practice sites: Large East-Jefferson High Diamond; Large West-Kennedy High Diamond; Small West-Washington High Diamond; Small East-Marion High Diamond.

5/ First 7-inning games will be at 5:30 p.m., Thursday, Aug. 4, Small Schools West vs. Large Schools West, followed by Small Schools East vs. Large Schools East.

6/ Second 7-inning games will be at 5:30 p.m. Friday, Aug. 5, Small Schools West vs. Large Schools East, followed by Small Schools East vs. Large Schools West.

7/ Saturday, Aug. 6, games will begin at 11:00 a.m., Small West vs. Small Schools East followed by Large Schools West vs. Large Schools East.

8/ At 6:00 p.m. Saturday, the Honors Banquet will be held at the Crowne Plaza Hotel in downtown Cedar Rapids.

10/ Sunday, Aug. 7, at 11:00 a.m., the two teams with poorest records will play for 3rd and 4th place. The two teams with best records will play for 1st and 2nd place following the first game.

11/ M.V.P. players will be announced after each game on Sunday.

All Star Squad Regulations:

1. Each squad will consist of 16 players (2 catchers, 4 pitchers, 5 infielders, 4 outfielders and 1 utility).

PLAYER SELECTION:

First priority: Coach's recommendation form

Second priority: All District Team

Third priority: Coach a member of the association.

Rules:

1/ All players chosen must play.

2/ The pitchers can pitch a full game.

3/ All games will be 7 innings in length unless extra innings are necessary.

4/ Tie breaker system will be announced in advance for who will play for 1st and 2nd place. Example: Head to Head competition, most runs scored, least runs given up, most hits, least hits given up.

All of the examples can be given points. The two teams with the most points will play for 1st place.

This system will give more boys an opportunity to play and show what they can do. We will not restrict a pitcher on amount of innings he can pitch in one day.

******Players who do not make the All District Team will still be eligible to play in the All-Star Series.** ****

If a coach fills out a player profile form that is found in this newsletter and sends it in, this player will have the same opportunity as a player on the All District Team. This system is necessary because a number of good ball players have been left off the All-Star squads because a coach could not get enough votes for his player at the All District Selection meetings. A reminder that each player must have \$150.00 worth of sponsor fees in order to play in the All-Star Series.

BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING
February 3, 2005**

The meeting was called to order at Cedar Rapids Crowne Plaza Hotel by President Paul Keitel at 7:30 P.M.

Paul made a few general announcements and then had introductions of Officers and Directors. The minutes of the November 2004 meeting were mentioned as being in the newsletter. They were accepted.

Executive Secretary Pinky Primrose read the Financial report and a motion was made by John Zahn to accept the report, seconded by Jack Lynch. All were in favor.

The Steering Committee report was given by Jim Gebhart. Dave Rock has been selected to go through the chairs. An Executive Secretary report was given by Pinky. It was agreed that everything is being run smoothly.

Roger Hoel gave the Hall of Fame report and announced that the 2006 Hall of Fame nominees would be selected at their meeting 8:45 A.M. Friday morning.

John Waddle gave the All-District committee report reporting the information that was in the Dec/Jan/Feb. Newsletter.

Phil Katz gave both the Awards and All-Star committee reports. Four District Field of the Year Awards have been suggested and work has already begun on the 2005 All-Star Series in Cedar Rapids.

Gary Paulsen's Umpires committee stated that a huge thank you was owed to retiring IHSA Executive Dave Harty.

The Lanny Peterson Award and Academic All-State committee report were given by Jerry Roling. He stated that 75 student/athletes were nominated for All-State Academic Honors with 20 students making the First Team and 20 Honorable Mention. Three players were interviewed for the Lanny Peterson Award winner.

The Audit report was given by Bret Hoyer and everything is in order.

Lee Toole continues to head up the Rating Poll with contributions from people all over the state.

The membership committee report was made by Dave Middleton with encouraging news in regard to coach's memberships. There are 78 umpires as registered members. Quite honestly this is a pathetically low number.

Steve Hanson gave the All-State Coaches committee report. Anyone who has questions on how this is handled should contact his committee.

Out-going President Paul Keitel's report emphasized how his year in office has broadened his skills as a communicator.

The Budget was accepted by a motion from Tom Souhrada and seconded by Tim O'Neill. The Executive Secretary's job was reviewed and it was recommended that the position be given a \$500 raise to \$15,800 a year. A motion was made by Dan Pomeroy and Seconded by Steve Hanson. Carried.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:30 p.m.

Meeting was brought to order by President Paul Keitel at 10:30 A.M. The minutes of the previous meeting were accepted by a motion from Mike Davis and seconded by Rick Davis. Motion carried.

The Financial report was presented by Executive Secretary Pinky Primrose. It was moved by Dave Rock and seconded by Tom Jenk, Jr. to accept the financial report. Motion carried.

Since the reports from the officers and committees are basically a report from the Board of Directors minutes, we will only make notes of new information.

Roger Hoel's Hall of Fame Report stated that the committee will be capped at fifteen members and the meetings will be closed. Nominations from the class of 2006 Hall of Fame will be presented at the Fall Board of Directors' Meeting for their vote.

The All-District Committee's recommendation for 3A District realignment and restructuring of All-State Teams will also be voted on at the Fall Meeting.

Dave Rock was recommended to go through the chairs. Motion by Tom Souhrada and Seconded by Gary Nyhus to approve. Motion carried.

Hall of Fame Committee: 14 members attended. Voted on 2006 nominees for Hall of Fame. Requested 15-member Committee. Continued looking for nominees to the Coaches, Players and Contributors Categories.

All State Committee: Seven members attended. Found no new business to bring to the attention of the Association.

Rating Committee: Six members attended. No changes at this point.

All District Committee: Six members attended. No changes to the Class 3A rebalancing format for 2005. Refer to the last newsletter for assignments. Number adjustments for 2005 All-District Teams: Class 4A--West reduced to 12 players. Class 2A increased to 16 players. Class 3A reduced to 17 players. New proposals for 2005 Fall Board of Directors Meeting. Add 1 utility position to Class 1A Teams--15 total players. Reduce 4A West pitchers to 2 (currently at 3) 11 Total Players. Discuss at 2005 Fall Board of Directors meeting. Should the 4A North & 4A South Central District each nominate 2 coaches to send to the All-Star Series to vote on the All-State teams? (Current format) Concern: They are all essentially from the same conference. We are trying to avoid a duplication of conferences. Does the current system favor the 4A Central players when it comes to All-State recognition?

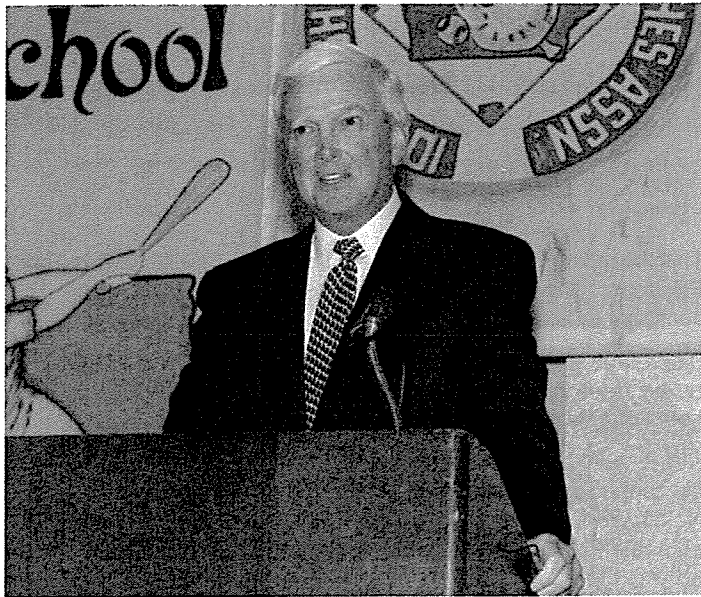

Please complete the form and return to Pinky Primrose if you haven't already done so. This is needed for the Hall of Fame Committee! This form can be found in the last newsletter or on the web at www.iowahsbca.com.

For other awards, please fill out the nomination forms and send them in as soon as possible. The committees will be working on them for the next awards banquet.

Guidelines For the Nomination To HALL OF FAME FOR COACHES:

1. Any IHSBCA member may nominate a qualified baseball person. **Should have three letters of recommendation!**
2. This must be done on the official two-page nomination form which may be obtained from the IHSBCA Office, 4211 High Ridge Rd. S.E., Cedar Rapids, IA 52403 or off the web site. This form must be completed and returned to the IHSBCA office by September 1 of a given year in order to be eligible for selection the following year.
3. Eligible nominees must meet the following prerequisites:
 - a/ Must have served as a head baseball coach of a high school, 2-year college, 4-year college, umpire, player or contributor to baseball (local/state/national level)
 - b/ Must have served a minimum of 20 years in the aforementioned institution(s).
 - c/ Must have significantly contributed to the advancement and betterment of baseball in his area, district, state or nation.
 - d/ Must have made major contributions to the IHSBCA (such as serving on committees, filling offices, All Star Series, attending clinics, encouraging membership).
 - e/ Must be representative of:
 - i) high moral character and ethical standards
 - ii) excellence recognized beyond the local level
 - iii) demonstrated leadership

4. After the September 1 deadline, the entire file is given a preliminary review by the Committee Chairman. The Committee Chairman will forward the file, containing his report, to the Hall of Fame Committee. His report will attest to the candidate's qualifications pertaining to all prerequisites aforementioned.

5. The Hall of Fame candidates will be selected from nomination forms and will be notified by December before the February Banquet where they receive the award.

6. Those declared elected for that year will be inducted at a banquet at the IHSBCA clinic in February.

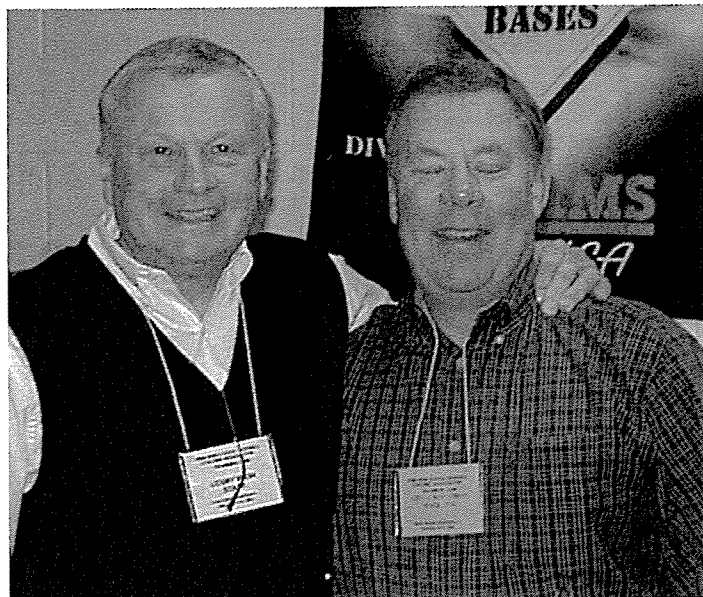
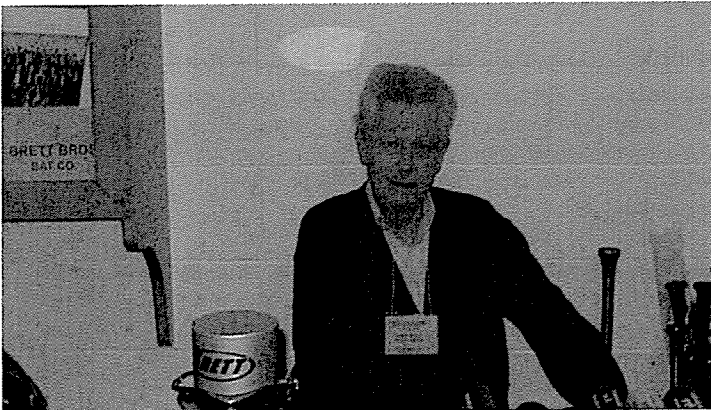
7. Candidates not selected the initial year will remain in the "pool," and will automatically be considered for 5 consecutive years. If the candidate is not selected the fifth year, he will not be considered further until he is nominated another time.

8. Awards may be made posthumously.

Changing Districts and Class: At the recent Board of Directors meeting the following guidelines were approved. 1/ A school may move up a class, but not down a class. 2/ In order to move into another district or up a class, the member school must apply in writing by January 15th. 3/ The school must stay in that district or classification for five years. The only exceptions would be if the school's classification changes (by the State) or their conference is realigned. 4/ Apply in writing to the President or Executive Secretary. 5/ A school could move down with approval if all schools in conference are of a lower class.

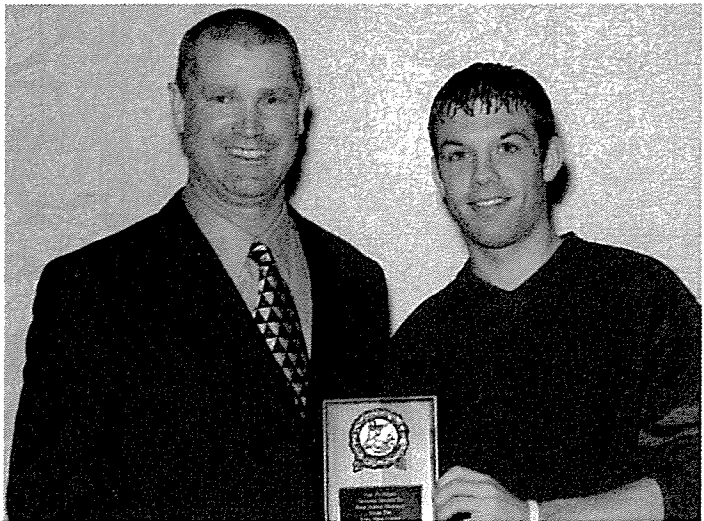
