2005 All-Star Most Valuable Player Awards:

The All-Star Most Valuable Players were: Small East, Luke McDermott, Cascade; Large East, R.J. Jerrick, Iowa City West; Small West, Jake Dooley, Martensdale-St. Mary's; Large West, David Callahan, Sioux City Heelan. Congratulations to these fine young ball players.

John Lee wins the Lanny Peterson Award: The recipient of the Lanny Peterson Award was John Lee of Mason City High School. John ranked 1st in his graduating class of 311 with a GPA of 4.0, having a 31 ACT score. His honors include Baseball Varsity Program (10,11,12). He was All Conference and All District for three years. He was All-State his junior and senior years. He plans to play at the University of Nebraska-Lincoln as an outfielder. His pitching record was 7-1 in 2005. John hit .444 his senior year, with 14 doubles, 6 triples and 4 homeruns. He had 26 RBIs in 2005. He was 4 for 9 in the All-Star Series with one triple.

This award, named for the work Lanny has done for the Association and as a baseball umpire, is given to a member of the Academic All-State team. This award is announced at the Recognition Banquet and presented to the player who exhibits the high academic and athletic standards which Lanny Peterson exemplified during his career as a teacher and umpire at Linn Mar and Kennedy High Schools.

Large Number Of Academic Nominations: A large number of Academic nominations were received. The committee chose 20 First Team members and 20 Honorable Mention. This list appears elsewhere in the newsletter. We want to congratulate these young men for their outstanding high school careers in academics as well as in baseball.

Wes Freie, IHSBCA/PRO-LINE HAT Player of the Year: Wes Freie of Wilton High School received the IHSBCA/Pro-Line Hat Player of the Year Award. Wes had four outstanding years at Wilton. Wes led Wilton as a pitcher and hitter for three years. He had a 8-0 (37-3) pitching record in 2005 with a 0.55 (1.04) ERA, striking out 89 (423) while walking 14 (87). Wes gave up only 23 hits for the 2005 season, and had a .554 (.523) batting average. Wes had 5 doubles (50), 0 triples (3), 13 homeruns (44), 47 (198) RBI's in 74 (521) times at bat and scored 41 (137) times with 41 (212) hits. Wes will play baseball at University of Iowa. He was a Super Team member for two years. Congratulations to Wes for his outstanding high school career.

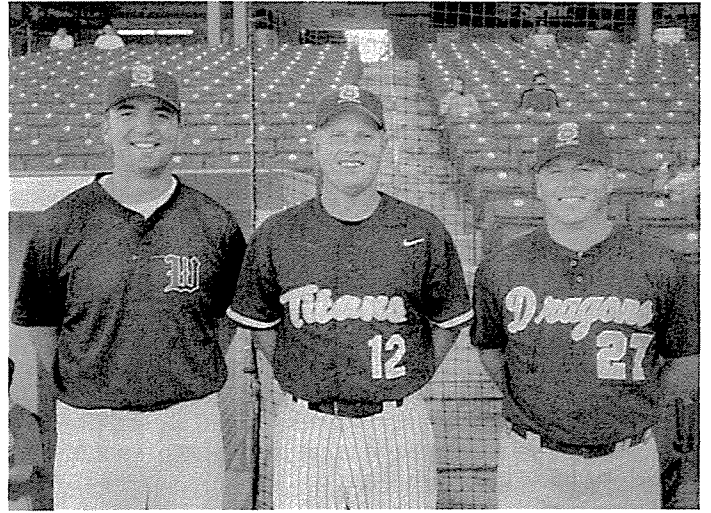
Coaching Changes: There were 106 baseball coaches changing/dropping out of coaching. This is up from 2005 season when 75 coaches dropped out.

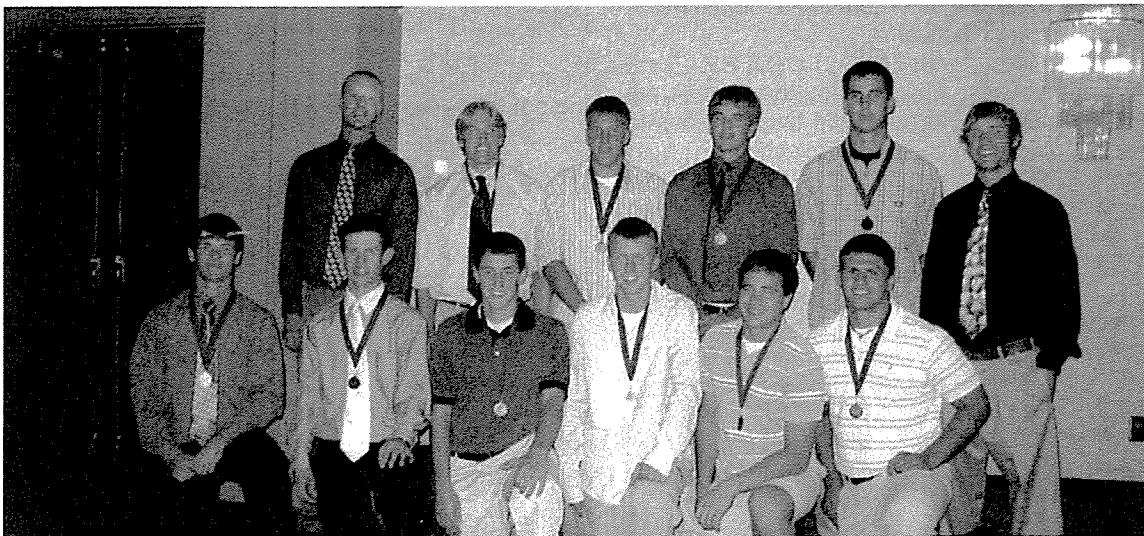

2006 Baseball Rules Changes:

INDIANAPOLIS, IN (July 14, 2005) — At its annual meeting June 17-18 in Indianapolis, Indiana, the National Federation of State High School Associations (NFHS) Baseball Rules Committee adopted a new rule that permits the pitcher or defensive players to wear non-glare facial or head protection while on the field. Rule 1-5-5, which is designed to minimize risk of injury, was one of 12 rules addressed at the meeting.

"In the few occasions that pitchers are hit by the ball, most of the occurrences are above the neck," said B. Elliot Hopkins, NFHS assistant director and liaison to the NFHS Baseball Rules Committee. "The committee felt that players who want to wear protection should be able to."

In other changes, Rule 1-3-6 was revised to eliminate the confusion this past season with the legality of two-toned gloves. The modification bans any white or gray colors on the glove or mitt worn by the pitchers. This rule was revised due to the popularity of two-toned gloves, which typically have not been distracting.

As a means of providing additional coverage to the definition of a foul ball, Rule 2-16-1e was added. It states that a ball inadvertently declared foul by an umpire that touches the ground is a dead ball.

The committee also revised Rule 2-10-2, which now mandates a meeting involving the umpires, both head coaches and team captains (if available) near home plate before each game.

"Good sportsmanship is the rationale behind the pregame conference," said NFHS Baseball Rules Committee Chairman Greg Brewer, assistant director of the Alabama High School Athletic Association. "We want to make sure everyone is properly uniformed, understands the rules and that there is no miscommunication between the umpires and the teams."

Eight other minor changes were approved by the committee, including two involving baserunning rules and two revisions to dead-ball rules. A listing of all rules changes is attached.

Baseball is the fourth-most popular sport among boys at the high school level with 457,146 participants during the 2003-04 season, according to the High School Athletics Participation Survey conducted by the NFHS. It also ranks third in school sponsorship with 14,984 schools offering the sport.

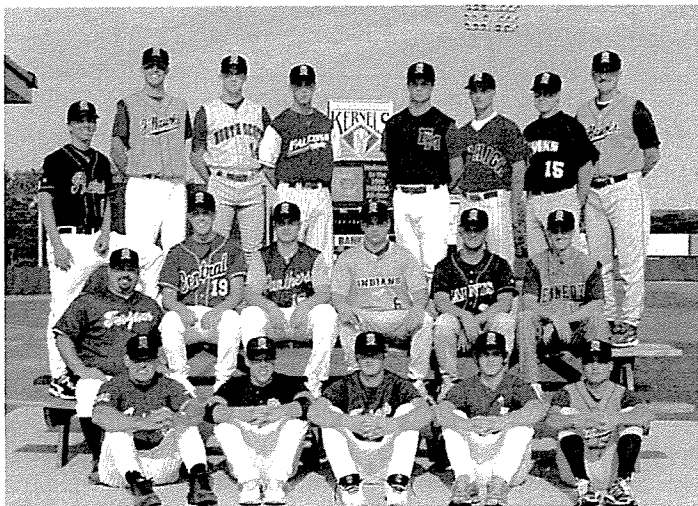
Don Taylor (Former President of IHSBCA) is back in baseball as Cedar Rapids Prairie coach after a few years of retirement.

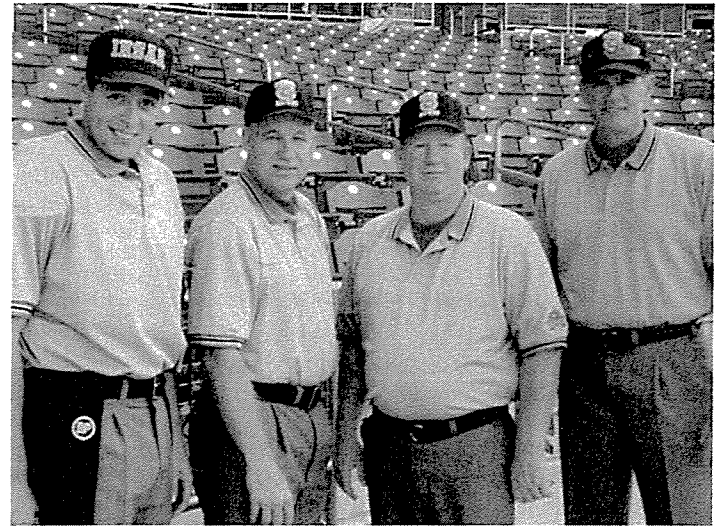
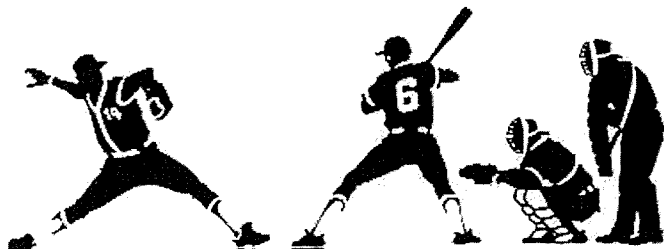
2005 All-Star Baseball Olympics Winners:

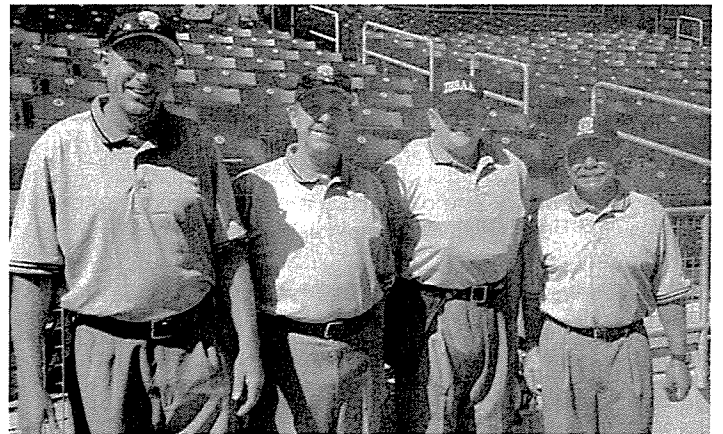
