All-Star Games Schedule: The players, coaches, umpires and staff will be staying at the Frontier Inn in Clinton. The Honors Dinner will be held at the Eagle Point Lodge Saturday night at 6:00 p.m. All games will be played at River View Stadium.

1/ Players will arrive Thursday, August 3rd. Individual pictures for inclusion in the program will be taken after check in.

2/ Players from Small Schools East will report by 10:30 a.m. Large Schools East players will report at 10:45 a.m.

3/ Players from Small Schools West will report at 11:00 a.m. and players from Large Schools West will report at 11:15 a.m.

4/ Practice for West teams will be 12:15 p.m.--2:45 p.m. Practice for the East teams will be from 2:45 p.m.--4:15 p.m. Small West and Small East-City Freshman Diamond near Stadium; Large West and Large East-Camanche High Diamond.

5/ First Round 7-inning games will start at 5:30 p.m., Thursday, Aug. 3, Small Schools West vs. Large Schools West, followed by Small Schools East vs. Large Schools East.

6/ Second Round 7-inning games will start at 5:30 p.m. Friday, Aug. 4, Small Schools West vs. Large Schools East, followed by Small Schools East vs. Large Schools West.

7/ Saturday, Aug. 5, games will begin at 11:00 a.m., Small Schools West vs. Small Schools East followed by Large Schools West vs. Large Schools East.

8/ At 6:00 p.m. Saturday, the Honors Dinner will be held at the Eagle Point Park Lodge in Clinton.

9/ Sunday, Aug. 6, at 11:00 a.m., the two teams with the poorest records will play for 3rd and 4th place. The two teams with best records will play for 1st and 2nd place following the first game.

11/ M.V.P. players will be announced after each game on Sunday.

## All Star Squad Regulations:

1. Each squad will consist of 16 players (2 catchers, 4 pitchers, 5 infielders, 4 outfielders and 1 utility).

## **PLAYER SELECTION:**

First priority: Coach's recommendation form

Second priority: All District Team

Third priority: Coach a member of the association.

## Rules:

1/ All players chosen must play.

2/ The pitchers can pitch a full game.

3/ All games will be 7 innings in length unless extra innings are necessary.

4/ Tie breaker system will be announced in advance for who will play for 1st and 2nd place. Example: Head to Head competition, most runs scored, least runs given up, most hits, least hits given up. All of the examples can be given points. The two teams with the most points will play for 1st place. This system will give more boys an opportunity to play and show what they can do. We will not restrict a pitcher on amount of innings he can pitch in one day.

\*\*\*\*\*Players who do not make the All District Team will still be eligible to play in the All-Star Series. \*\*\*\*





## IHSBCA Spring Meeting Wednesday, April 26<sup>th</sup>, 2006: Kernels Stadium

Topics discussed and summaries:

All State voting guidelines: No intra-district  $2^{nd}$  team player can "jump" a  $1^{st}$  team All district player when being named to an All State team. (i.e. A  $2^{nd}$  team All District Shortstop from the 4A West district cannot take an all state SS position ahead of a  $1^{st}$  team all district shortstop from 4A West).

Stats that are used when voting for All State players and All District Players will be stats from the regular season games only. The nomination form for All State selection committee to consider must be filled out at the All District meeting with the regular season stats only.

Evaluation of the 2005 All Star Series. Phil Katz presented and the members at the meeting commented on the outstanding job he did. Phil recognized a problem with a lot of people looking for free food. The food and beverages are for the players and coaches. Once the players and coaches have all been served, then others can come forward for food. Other suggestions:

Hire someone to sell advertising - (10%?)

We will need a professional photographer this year

Need to get envelopes of information out to parents and kids that are selected. Send this to the parents when notifying them of their selection.

Include in the letter/envelope the necessary envelopes the photographer requires. The Olympics continues to go well

Katz raised over \$3,000 in donations and advertising.

Clinton appears to be on track with Lenny Weih, Dave Rock, Tom Souhrada, and Paul Keitel heading up the All Star Series this summer.

Des Moines needs to take a turn at hosting this event. Every game does not need to be played at Principal Park. Des Moines has never hosted? Why not? Some times we do need to pay to play on a particular field. Finding advertisers

It was noted that the All Star Series was never intended to be a fund raiser for the association

Evaluation of the Clinic

Need more space for exhibitors or fewer exhibitors. Need to take care of the people who have been regular exhibitors at our Clinic. Be careful not to overbook. Some of the best supporters (like Graphic Edge) deserve preferential treatment for booth location.

Speakers at this year's clinic were excellent.

Let's get the host and the mini-clinic speaker to meet BEFORE the mini-clinics begin so they can touch base about pertinent issues.

There is a strong sentiment from association members that Iowa High School coaches (particularly state championship coaches) be given an opportunity to speak in some fashion (either in mini-clinics or as main speakers) as was done in the past. A mix of college, pro, and high school speakers would be well received. It seems we have gone full circle here as in the past (when clinic was in March) we used to have a large percentage of high school speakers as the college and pro guys were busy at that time. Now there is sentiment to bring an Iowa high school element back to the line up of speakers.

It's ok to rotate college speakers every other year or every 3<sup>rd</sup> year. We don't need to see the same college speakers every year and this would give the opportunity to hear other college coaches speak. Iowa and UNI could rotate every other year, there could be a 3 or 4 year rotation among certain junior college and division 3 coaches. The same for division 2 and NAIA coaches.

#### Banquet

An issue for the awards committee to consider was brought up: Do a smaller awards ceremony at the Saturday Luncheon (similar to what ABCA does). Give win club, longevity, all district awards, etc. at this luncheon – more coaches will be present and it will be a more efficient manner of disseminating awards/certificates.

Change Longevity awards to 15-25-35 – and 50 year awards to model after the IHSAA. The IHSAA modeled their program after the National Association. This is another issue for the Awards committee to consider.

Speaker: What is the role of the speaker? It was discussed that the role of a speaker should be to inform and/or entertain. Is this consistent with the purpose of our banquet. The purpose of our banquet is to honor and recognize. We allow 3-4 minutes per speaker for the featured Hall of Fame members; yet allow much more time for the speaker. We also allow the media and contributor of the year the opportunity to speak but don't give the state coaches/umpire of the year an opportunity to speak and thank his assistants, etc. etc.

To speed things up a little bit we should get started as soon as the last person gets his food.

### Friday Night Social

Concerns rose about the noise level at Muddy Waters due to the fact that they always have a live band scheduled for that particular Friday night. Hoyer will reevaluate the location of the social.

**Evaluation of Spring Meeting** 

The Spring meeting is a great idea - an opportunity to speak casually and trouble shoot/brainstorm ideas for the membership/steering committee to consider. The timing is good as it's still close enough to the clinic to recall pertinent issues and discuss possible solutions to any concerns that were raised by association members at the clinic.
