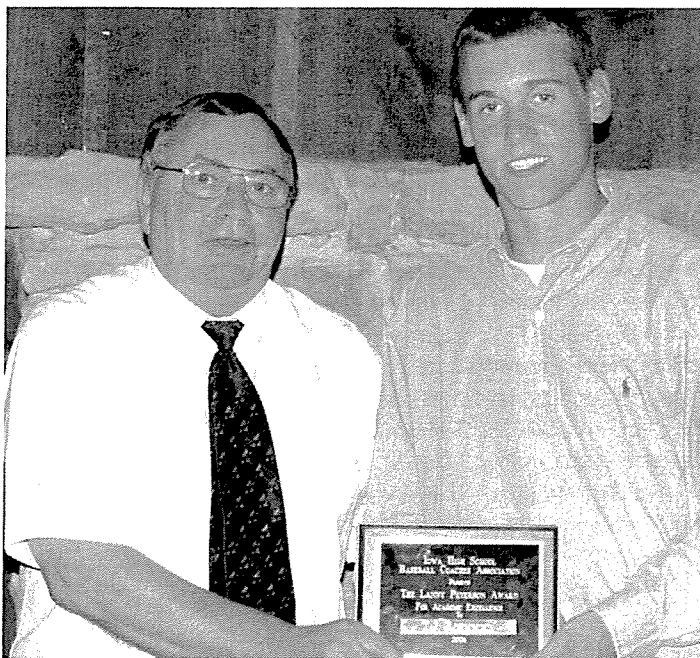

**2006 All-Star Most Valuable Player Awards:** The All-Star Most Valuable Players were: Small East, Steve Chamberlin, Center Point-Urbana; Large East, Adam Slager, Iowa City West; Small West, Trevor Conner, Creston; Large West, T.J. Roemmich, West Des Moines Dowling. Congratulations to these fine young ball players.

**T.J. Roemmich wins the Lanny Peterson Award:** The recipient of the Lanny Peterson Award was T.J. Roemmich, West Des Moines Dowling High School. T.J. ranked 1st in his graduating class with a GPA of 4.015, having a 31 ACT score. His honors include First Team All State two years in a row including the Super team as a senior, First Team All-District and First Team All-Conference, 2005 and 2006, Dowling Team MVP and Team Captain and MVP for the Large West in the 2006 All Star Series. T.J. was also named to the BCA All Midwest Second Team made up of players in a seven-state area. T.J. hit 23 doubles in 2005 which placed him in second all time for doubles in a season for Iowa preps. During his career, T.J. hit 43 doubles, 18 home runs, 117 RBI's. He accepted a scholarship to play baseball at Creighton University and will major in business.

This award, named for the work Lanny has done for the Association and as a baseball umpire, is given to a member of the Academic All-State team. This award is announced at the Recognition Dinner and presented to the player who exhibits the high academic and athletic standards which Lanny Peterson exemplified during his career as a teacher and umpire at Linn Mar and Kennedy High Schools.

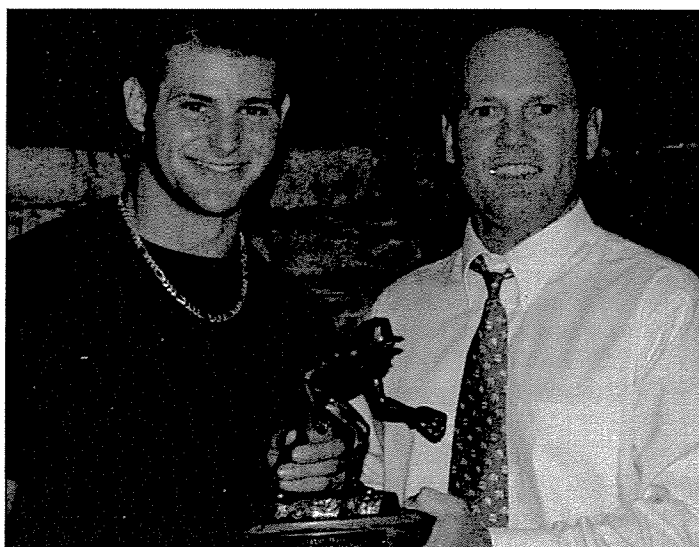
**Jeremy Weih, IHSBCA/PRO-LINE HAT Player of the Year:** Jeremy Weih of Wilton High School received the IHSBCA/Pro-Line Hat Player of the Year Award. Jeremy had four outstanding years at Wilton. Jeremy was a Super Team member for two years. In his four years at Wilton, Jeremy batted .462, scoring 162 runs, stole 95 bases and had 195 hits, 40 doubles and 4 triples. In his four years he had 29 homeruns and collected 85 RBI's. Jeremy currently holds 3 career records at Wilton and 4 single season records. He was a catcher. He was drafted in the 41st round. Jeremy is attending the University of Northern Iowa where he will be working out as a catcher. Congratulations to Jeremy for his outstanding high school career.

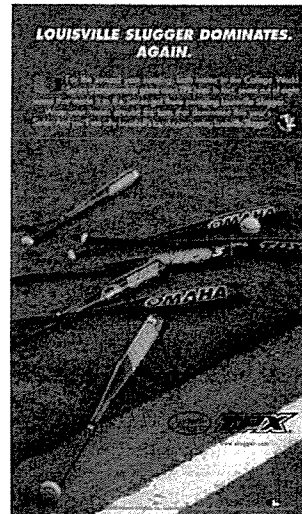

Terry Heald, 67, passed away this past summer in his home following a long courageous battle with cancer. Terry was born in Cedar Rapids, graduated from Franklin High School and Coe College. He began his teaching and coaching career at M-F-L Schools in Monona and moved to Marion in 1979. He retired to golfing and teaching at Kirkwood in 1999. Terry was a member and past president of the Iowa High School Baseball Coaches Association and a member of the Hall of Fame. He was member of the 30-Year Longevity Club and the 600-Win Club. Terry served on the Steering Committee for many years. He was an avid St. Louis Cardinal fan and attended many Metro sporting events. His survivors are his wife Peggy, daughter Julie and son John. John presently is the sophomore coach at C.R. Jefferson. The Association will miss Terry Heald.

## 2007 Rule Changes

INDIANAPOLIS (July 18, 2006) - Effective with the 2007 high school baseball season, a team playing with fewer than nine players may return to nine players. In addition to this change, 12 other rules revisions were approved by the National Federation of State High School Associations (NFHS) Baseball Rules Committee at its June 16-17 meeting in Indianapolis. These rules changes subsequently were approved by the NFHS Board of Directors.

"Rule 4-4-1f allows a team that had to drop down to eight players to return to nine later during the game," said Greg Brewer, assistant director of the Alabama High School Athletic Association and chairperson of the NFHS Baseball Rules Committee. "This will also help promote participation."

Rule 3-3-1 n addresses revised penalties for initiating malicious contact on offense or defense. Transgressors will now result in the ball being immediately dead, and if on offense, the player is ejected and declared out, unless he has already scored. If the defense commits the malicious contact, the player is ejected; the umpire shall rule either safe or out on the play and award the runner(s) the appropriate base(s) he felt they would have obtained if the malicious contact had not occurred.

Other rules pertaining to malicious contact were also revised, as were their corresponding entries in the running table and dead-ball table.

"With these changes, we hope to be more definitive on offensive and defensive malicious contact," said Elliot Hopkins, NFHS assistant director and liaison to the Baseball Rules Committee.

In another change, Rule 6-2-1 now states that a ball will be called each time a pitcher brings his pitching hand in contact with his mouth, either without distinctly wiping off the pitching hand before it touches the ball or while in contact with the pitcher's plate.

Rule 3-2-1 was revised to state that one player or coach may occupy each coach's box while his team is at bat. A coach or player occupying the coach's box shall remain in the box from the time the batter enters the batter's box until the release of the ball by the pitcher. If the coach or player steps out of the box during this time, regardless of who violates the rule, the head coach will be restricted to the bench/dugout.

"A player or coach standing outside the box gains an unfair advantage as to where the opposing pitcher intends to pitch the ball," Hopkins said. "The box-bound player or coach does not have the same angle or disadvantage. This rule seeks to correct these unfair advantages and prevent distractions the pitcher may experience during his delivery."

Another rule change (Rule 3-3-4) stipulates that whenever team members are loosening up in an area that is not protected by a fence or other structure, another member of the team with a glove must be positioned between them and the batter to protect them from a batted or thrown ball.

"This is a risk minimization initiative to protect individuals who are not watching the activity in the field," Hopkins said.

In another effort to minimize risk, Rule 10-2-1 was revised to specify that when behind the plate, the umpire-in-chief shall wear proper safety equipment including, but not limited to chest protec-

tor, face mask, throat guard, plate shoes, shin guards and protective cup (if male).

A new signal was adopted that uses the point motion for the start of the game. This will align NFHS officials with other rules codes to begin a contest and put a ball back in play.

In an effort to make baseball compatible with other NFHS sport rules, Rule 1-4-4 now states that a commemorative or memorial patch, not to exceed 4 square inches, may be worn on jerseys without compromising the integrity of the uniform.

In addition to the rules changes, the committee identified Points of Emphasis for the 2007 season. Among those are malicious contact, concussions, good sporting behavior, face protection, umpire's professionalism, non-adult baseball shaggers and game management.

Baseball is the fourth-most popular sport among boys at the high school level with 459,717 participants during the 2004-05 season, according to the High School Athletics Participation Survey conducted by the NFHS. It also ranks third in school sponsorship across the nation.
