I.H.S.B.C.A. announces the 2007 All-Star Series in Waterloo, August 2-3-4-5, 2007:

The Thirty-first Annual All-Star Games will be held in Waterloo at the Waterloo River Front Stadium, Aug. 2-3-4-5, 2007. Any coach who feels he has a player or two who should be playing in the All-Star Games should fill out the Player Recommendation sheet that is enclosed in this Newsletter. Please enclose a photo of your player (if available) with the recommendation sheet. The guidelines for the All-Star selection can be found on that sheet. All of the advance information we can get on the best ball players will help in the selection of the All-Stars.

The Board of Directors passed a policy that any player or coach selected to participate in the All-Star Series must have a minimum of **\$200.00** of sponsors' fees. More would help to defray the cost of the All-Star Series. **It will be the high school coach's responsibility to get sponsors for the player if he wishes him to play in the All-Star games.** This policy is necessary in order to offset the high cost of putting on the All Star series. If you have any questions about this policy, contact any officer or director in your area; they will explain it to you. Sponsor names and fees must be paid to Executive Secretary no later than Saturday, July 28, if your player is selected.

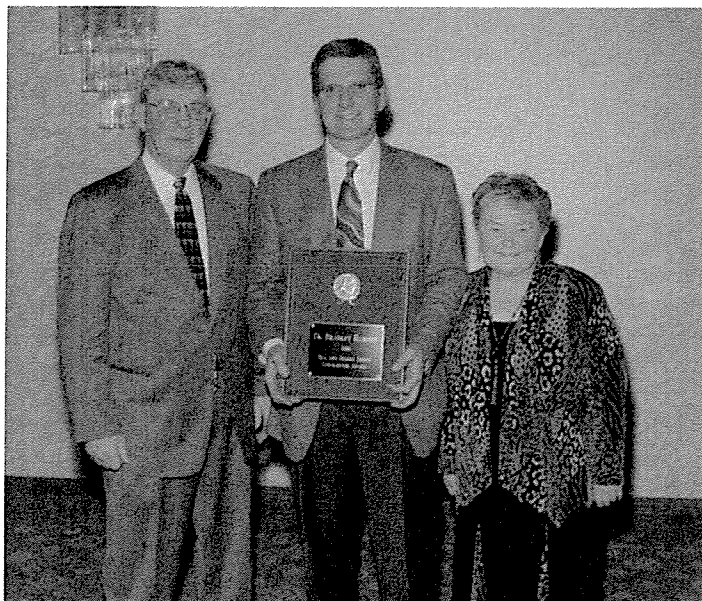

All-Star Games Schedule: The players, coaches, umpires and staff will be staying at the Ramada Hotel and Convention Center in Waterloo. The Honors Dinner will be held at the Sullivan Brothers' Convention Center Saturday night, August 4th, at 6:00 p.m. All games will be played at River Front Stadium.

1/ Players will arrive Thursday, August 2nd. Individual pictures for inclusion in the program will be taken after check in.

2/ Players from Small Schools East will report by 10:30 a.m. Large Schools East players will report at 10:45 a.m.

3/ Players from Small Schools West will report at 11:00 a.m. and players from Large Schools West will report at 11:15 a.m.

4/ Practice for West teams will be 12:15 p.m.--2:45 p.m. Practice for the East teams will be from 2:45 p.m.--4:15 p.m. Small West and Small East-East High School Diamond and Large West and Large East-West High School Diamond.

5/ First Round 7-inning games will be at 5:30 p.m., Thursday, Aug. 2, Small Schools West vs. Large Schools West, followed by Small Schools East vs. Large Schools East.

6/ Second Round 7-inning games will be at 5:30 p.m. Friday, Aug. 3, Small Schools East vs. Large Schools West, followed by Small Schools West vs. Large Schools East.

7/ Saturday, Aug. 4, games will begin at 10:30 a.m., Small Schools West vs. Small Schools East followed by Large Schools West vs. Large Schools East.

8/ At 6:00 p.m. Saturday, the Honors Dinner will be held at the Sullivan Brothers' Convention Center.

9/ Sunday, Aug. 5, at 10:30 a.m., the two teams with the poorest records will play for 3rd and 4th place. The two teams with best records will play for 1st and 2nd place following the first game.

11/ M.V.P. players will be announced after each game on Sunday.

All Star Squad Regulations:

1. Each squad will consist of 16 players (2 catchers, 4 pitchers, 5 infielders, 4 outfielders and 1 utility).

PLAYER SELECTION:

First priority: Coach's recommendation form

Second priority: All District Team

Third priority: Coach a member of the association.

Rules:

1/ All players chosen must play.

2/ The pitchers can pitch a full game.

3/ All games will be 7 innings in length unless extra innings are necessary.

4/ Tie breaker system will be announced in advance for who will play for 1st and 2nd place. Example: Head to Head competition, most runs scored, least runs given up, most hits, least hits given up. All of the examples can be given points. The two teams with the most points will play for 1st place. This system will give more boys an opportunity to play and show what they can do. We will not restrict a pitcher on amount of innings he can pitch in one day.

*****Players who do not make the All District Team will still be eligible to play in the All-Star Series. ****

If a coach fills out a player profile form that is found in this newsletter and sends it in, this player will have the same opportunity as a player on the All District Team. This system is necessary because a number of good ball players have been left off the All Star Squads because a coach could not get enough votes for his player at the All District Selection meetings. A reminder that each player must have **\$200.00** worth of sponsor fees in order to play in the All Star Series.

Future All-Star Games: The following location has been set for future a Iowa High School Baseball Coaches Association All-Star series. 2008 series will be held in Des Moines or Cedar Rapids.

Looking for Members who are Interested in Selecting All State Teams: Each all state team will be selected by coaches of that class. Anyone interested in helping select the All State teams should volunteer at **your District Meetings**. The teams will be selected on Friday morning, Aug. 3, at 11:00 a.m. at West High School in Waterloo. If you are interested, make sure you volunteer at the District Meeting in July.

Only those selected at the District meetings and by the Executive Secretary will choose the All-State Teams.

IHSBCA Board Meeting: 39th IHSBCA Coaches and Umpires Clinic Thursday, February 2nd 2007, Monarch Room, Crown Plaza Hotel, Cedar Rapids, IA

President Lee Toole called the meeting to order at 7:35 p.m.

Jack Lynch and Jerry Roling 2nd to accept the minutes from the Fall meeting. Bret Hoyer, Audit Committee, gave the financial report. Gary Paulson motioned and Mike Pauly 2nd to accept the financial report.

The steering committee reported that umpires will provide feedback on the Diamond of the Year award.

Phil Katz recognized Nabisco for donating cookies to the lunch for Friday at Wash H.S. Randy Mathews and the Warrior Baseball program were sponsoring the lunch as school was not in session.

There was brief discussion with regards to printing costs of the newsletter. Could all coaches sign up to receive the newsletter via e-mail, rather than through the mail? This could cut in half or more the number of newsletters that need to be printed and mailed, saving printing costs and postage costs. Discussion regarding putting a box to indicate this on the membership form should be very easy as coaches are already asked to supply their e-mail addresses on the forms. No action taken.

Phil Katz, chair of the Awards Committee, recommended that contributor of the year award be cut and should be taken care of by the local organization. Phil Katz reported that there are over 60 awards currently being distributed by the IHSBCA. Charlie Vessell of Turface will be awarding one pallet of material to the State Field of the Year Award winner.

Discussion regarding the suite at Principal Park on championship Saturday took place. The suite costs the association \$400 for 20 tickets. All officers of the IHSBCA and All Star coaches are welcome. This year Dan Pomeroy went out and "recruited" members to come to the suite as turnout wasn't that strong. Discussion was held on ways to communicate this opportunity to all officers and All Star coaches. Mike Pauly motioned to keep the room. Lee Toole recommended that we continue this for one more summer and re-evaluate this fall at the fall meeting. Mike Pauly motioned in favor of this proposal. 2nd Phil Katz, the motion carried.

Lee gave the president's report and stated that Pinky would like to continue as Executive Secretary. Jerry Roling motioned and Jack Lynch seconded that Pinky's salary be increased by \$500. Motion carried.

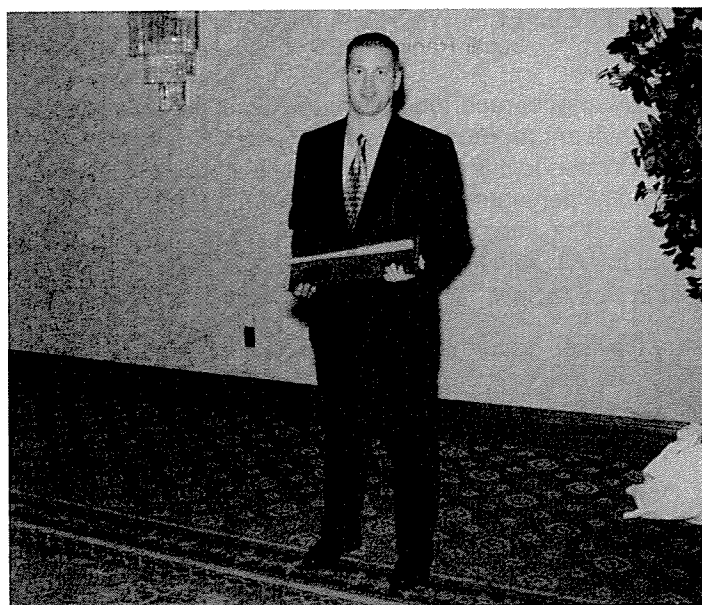

Denny Barton read to the membership the scrimmage and practice rule as is listed in the IHSAA Bulletin.

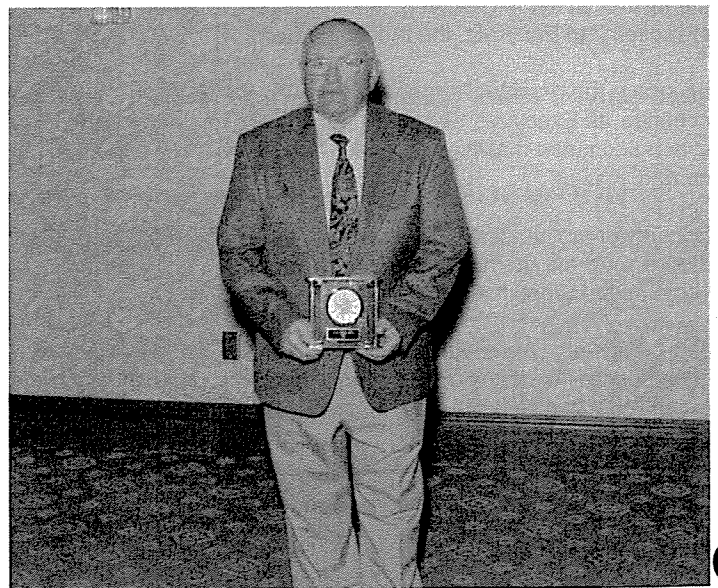

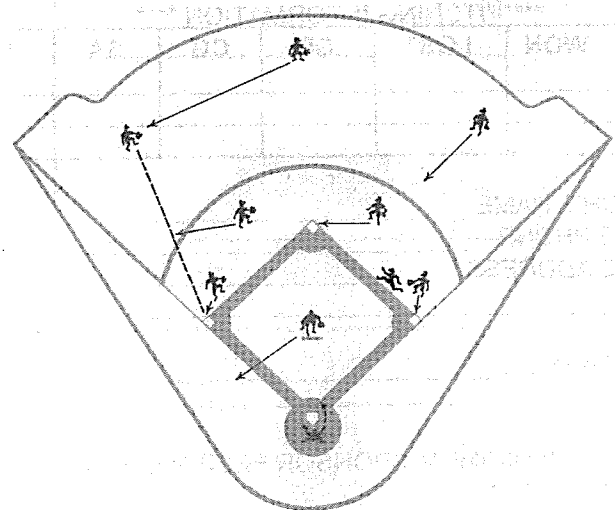
