

### **Brian Inloes wins the Lanny Peterson Award:**

The recipient of the Lanny Peterson Award was Brian Inloes of Mount Ayr High School, ranked 1st in his graduating class with a GPA of 4.00 and an ACT score of 33. His honors include 3 time 1st Team All Conference catcher; 3 time 1st team All District catcher; 2nd Team All Conference basketball. Brian was also named to the 2nd Team All-State Football and made the All State Academic teams in Baseball and Football. During his career, Brian hit 17 doubles, 11 home runs, 118 RBI's. He had a 22-6 career record in pitching with 154 SO. He was involved in the Student Council, FFA, SADD, HELP, FCA, NHS, Class Officer, Drama Club, Pep Club, Church Youth Group and VP of Student Council and Senior class. He played in the 2007 All-Star Series. He accepted a scholarship to play baseball at Harding University and will major in business.

This award, named for the work Lanny has done for the Association and as a baseball umpire, is given to a member of the Academic All-State team. This award is announced at the Recognition Dinner and presented to the player who exhibits the high academic and athletic standards which Lanny Peterson exemplified during his career as a teacher and umpire at Linn Mar and Kennedy High Schools.




**Denny Barton presents Brian Inloes the Academic Player of the Year Award.**

### **Jared Norris, IHSBCA/PRO-LINE HAT Player of the Year:**

Jared Norris of Urbandale High School received the IHSBCA/Pro-Line Hat Player of the Year Award. Jared had three outstanding years at Urbandale. He was 1st Team All-District three times, 1st Team All-Conference three times, 1st Team All-State in 2005, 2nd team in 2006 and Super Team in 2007. Jared was a Super Team member for two years. In the past year at Urbandale, Jared batted .466, scoring 47 runs, stole 95 bases and had 195 hits, 40 doubles and 4 triples. In his four years he had 8 homeruns and collected 38 RBI's. He was a first baseman. Jared is attending the University of Iowa where he plans on playing baseball. Congratulations to Jared for his outstanding high school career at Urbandale.

## Some Association Past History

**40 YEARS AGO (1968)** Organization plans for the Association started at Ames, with the invitation from Coach Cap Timm of Iowa State. This meeting was called together by Pinky Primrose of Cedar Rapids Washington to see if there was enough interest to start an organization to promote high school baseball in the state of Iowa. It was recommended that dues be \$3.00. The state was divided into 9 Districts: Chairmen of each District were: NW Corner, looking for one; District 2, Don Burgess, Denison; District 3, Keith Meyers, Shenandoah; District 4, Elmer Starr, Mason City; District 5, Clair Rierison, Iowa State; District 6, Bob Bielstein, Des Moines Lincoln; District 7, Dennis Olejniczak, Decorah; District 8, Bernie Hutchison, Norway; District 9, Bill Holmstrom, Iowa City and Bill Freese, Davenport Central. Plans were started for the first clinic.

**35 YEARS AGO (1972):** Plans for the fifth clinic were underway. Dues were \$5.00. 150 coaching changes took place. 23 schools have not named their coach. Mason City, coached by Elmer Starr, won the State Summer Tournament. Vern Bredeson was President. Norway won the fall championship.

**30 YEARS AGO (1977):** Jim Schulz, Bettendorf, was President. Davenport West and Ken Dohse won the Class 2A Summer State championship. Johnston and Jim Mahoney won the Class 1A Summer Championship. 159 coaching changes took place. Vern Bredeson, C.R. Jefferson, Jim Laake, Benton Community and Bill Sapp, Boone, retired. First All-Star Series was won by the South. Stiff penalties for misconduct by players and coaches were going to be introduced to member schools.

**25 YEARS AGO (1982):** Byron Rhodes of BCL was President. Don Miller, Davenport Assumption; Joe McFarland, Norwalk; Dan Reid, Burlington Notre Dame and Jim Van Scoyoc, Norway won the State Championships. Mike Bradmeyer of United Community of Boone, won the Vince Meyer Award. 110 coaches dropped out of coaching. Jerry Lister and Small East won the All-Star Series.

**20 YEARS AGO (1987):** Jim Kloewer of Stuart was President. State Champions and Coaches were: Jerry Zinn and Tom Souhrada of Davenport West; Dan Bolte, Camanche; Gaylord Schelling, Tri-Center, Neola and Jim Van Scoyoc of Norway. Large West coached by Steve Mohr of Valley West Des Moines won the All-Star Series. Kevin Burns of Muscatine won the Vince Meyer Award. 119 coaches dropped out of coaching. All-Star Games were in Cedar Rapids.

**15 YEARS AGO (1992):** Jim Donohue of Martensdale-St Marys was President. Chris Crome of Davenport North won the Vince Meyer Award. State champ coaches were Mel Murken, Ankeny; Jim Murphy, Davenport Assumption; Marc Bergan, Postville and Gene Schultz, Lansing Kee. Large East, coached by Jack Leabo, Davenport Central, won the All-Star Series. 66 coaches dropped out of coaching. All-Star Series was in Cedar Rapids

**10 YEARS AGO (1997):** Gary Nyhus of Mason City Newman was President. Scott Miller of Dubuque Wahlert was the Lanny Peterson Award recipient. State champ coaches and teams were Brad Rose, Ottumwa; Andy McGaffin, Spencer; Jeff Schweibert, Mount Vernon and Thomas Elsbecker, Swea City. Large West coached by Ric Powell of Des Moines East won the All-Star Series. 90 coaches left the profession. The All-Star Series was held at Council Bluffs.

**5 YEARS AGO (2002):** Charles Stumpff of Iowa City West was President. Mike Mogard of Marshalltown was the Lanny Peterson Award recipient. Jeff Clement of Marshalltown was the IHSBCA/PROLine HAT Player of Year winner. State champ coaches and teams were Steve Hansen, Marshalltown; Joel Johnson, Knoxville; Bruce Rholl, Eagle Grove and Tony Adams, Mason City Newman. Large West coached by Denny Barton of Urbandale won the All-Star Series. 71 coaches left the profession. The All-Star Series was held at Veterans Memorial Stadium in Cedar Rapids.

## 2007 All-Star Baseball Olympics Winners:

Large West won the team Olympics--by placing first in relay/cutoff throw, first in accuracy throw, and second in homeruns. Individuals recognized included: Jeff Kerian of Large West from Sioux City Heelan who scored near perfect 8 in the accuracy throw missing only 1 pitch. Winning the homerun contest was Dustin BeGuhn, of Alburnett for the Small East with 3 homeruns in 10 outs at Waterloo West's field. The Coaches fungo champion was Justin Dehmer of Small West who is the head coach at Earlham High School.

Each team divided up by their own choice into 4-person squads. Each player represented their team in one event. First place in that event earned their team 4 points, 2nd got 3 points, etc.

## 2008 Baseball Rules

INDIANAPOLIS, IN (July 9, 2007) -- Beginning with the 2008 high school baseball season, fielders without possession of the ball will not be allowed to deny access to the base that a runner is attempting to achieve.

This change in Rule 2-22-3 is one of numerous rules revisions approved by the National Federation of State High School Associations (NFHS) Baseball Rules Committee at its annual meeting June 12-14 in Indianapolis. The rules changes subsequently were approved by the NFHS Board of Directors.

"This rules revision will be very beneficial because it will minimize the risk of injury for both offensive and defensive players," said Elliot Hopkins, NFHS director of educational services and liaison to the Baseball Rules Committee.

A revision to Rule 3-2-1 rescinds the previous rule that stated a coach or player occupying the coaches' boxes shall remain there upon the batter entering the batter's box until the release of the ball by the pitcher if requested by the opposing coach. Beginning with the 2008 season, one player or coach may occupy each coach's box while his or her team is at bat.

"This rule was virtually impossible to enforce in the past," Hopkins said. "The umpire does not normally focus on the coach in the box, and shouldn't have to split his or her focus between the coach and the game. In addition, a lot of fields are not properly lined with coaches' boxes, and it's tough to say where the coach should be if the marks are not clear."

Along with the previous rule, multiple rules changes were made regarding head coaches. Rule 3-2-4 requires the head coach to be in attendance at the pregame conference if available. If he or she is not present, the head coach will be restricted to the dugout for the remainder of the game unless he or she must attend to a sick or injured player.

Another rule, Rule 1-1-2, suggests the importance of both the captain and the head coach being in communication with the umpires. Both must be present at the pregame conference, and the head coach is responsible for ensuring that his or her team is in compliance and will adhere to good sportsmanship. The rule also requires the name, shirt number, position and batting order of each starter to be placed on the lineup card. The name and shirt number of each eligible substitute should also be placed on the card, but are not required.

"It is important and necessary to require lineup cards to be filled out correctly," Hopkins said. "We looked at the vocabulary for the requirements for substitutions and changed 'shall' to 'should' in the section concerning eligible substitutions because there is no violation or penalty outlined if the eligible substitute's name is not listed on the card."

Two final rules changes deal with equipment and apparel. Rule 1-3-6 will require a pitcher's glove to be removed from the game if it includes the colors of white and/or gray and is noticed by the umpire or opposing team.

"It is the coach's responsibility to make sure his team is properly equipped, and it is the umpire's responsibility to enforce the rules," Hopkins said. "Instead of penalizing the opposing team with a multi-base award, the glove will only be required to be removed."

According to Rule 10-1-9, it is necessary that umpires dress alike in heather gray slacks and either a navy pullover shirt or a state association-adopted shirt. They are not required to supply a wide variety of shirts beyond what is necessary.

Baseball is the fourth-most popular sport among boys at the high school level with 470,671 participants during the 2005-06 season,


according to the High School Athletics Participation Survey conducted by the NFHS. It also ranks third in school sponsorship across the nation with 15,290 schools.
