# Iowa High School Baseball Coaches Association

## Nomination Ballot for Board of Directors

Section 2. Board of Directors. (A) The representatives to the Board of Directors shall be elected by the members within their district. By October of each year, the association members will receive an official blank nomination ballot. Upon voting, the nomination ballot is to be returned (within 10 days from mailing) to the executive director. The three receiving the highest number of votes shall be considered the nominees. In case of a tie of more than three, all those in the tie shall be considered nominees. In case the number of nomination ballots for any of the nominees is a majority of the number of members in the respective district, he shall be declared elected. The executive director shall prepare and mail official election ballots to the members of each district. Upon voting, the election ballot is to be returned (within 10 days of mailing) to the executive director. The person receiving the highest number of votes shall be declared elected. The second highest person to receive votes shall be considered the alternate and in the event of inability of an elected Director to serve, an alternate will be appointed to the Board of Directors.

Please nominate two coaches and two umpires from your district, who are members of the Iowa High School Baseball Coaches Association, of which are to be voted upon to serve to as members of the Board of Directors to represent your district.

# SPRING MEETING NOTES

The 2009 Spring meeting of the Iowa High School Baseball Coaches Association was held at Veterans Memorial Stadium in Cedar Rapids on Tuesday, April 28th. The meeting was called to order by Lee Toole at 5 PM in the Argon Insurance Suite. Those in attendance were Lee Toole, Dave Rock, Brett Hoyer, Jerry Roling, Gary Paulsen, Don Taylor, and Jay Ryan.

## REVIEW OF 2009 CLINIC:

a. Lee received a lot of positive phone calls and emails about the clinic and the new site. The Marriott Hotel was very happy with the number of rooms rented and the way the clinic was run. Dave Hardy reported that it was as smooth as the clinic has run.

b. There was a good crowd at the Iowa bubble on Sunday morning. Coach Dahm made it more of a question/answer format. There was discussion about moving that session to Friday evening, but it was agreed on that Sunday is the best time to have it considering high school basketball games, out of town speakers, and the banquet.

c. There was discussion of having the clinic on Saturday and Sunday due to coaches coming from out of town and conflicts with high school sports. The group agreed to continue with the current format for a couple years and re-evaluate.

d. Steve Hanson will be the chairman of the newly formed Clinic Evaluation Committee. They will develop a tool to evaluate all of the clinicians.

e. There was discussion on video taping all sessions and selling those tapes to coaches similar what is done at the ABCA. There would be a need for better technology but Lee would look into this issue.

f. Next year there would be screens behind the clinicians. If someone can not see the speaker they could look up on the screen.

g. The vendors were very happy with their location. Next year there may be a possibility of a meet and greet with the vendors. Craig Allison from True Pitch and Denny St. Germain would supply the food?

h. The suggestion was made to go away from the tickets for lunch, FCA breakfast, and the banquet; your coaches badge would be good enough.

i. Attendance at the FCA breakfast was better than in the past because of the site of the clinic. Coaches stayed at the hotel and found it easier to get to the breakfast.

## CLINIC SPEAKERS FOR 2010:

a. Mike Anderson from Nebraska will be the featured speaker. Other possibilities are Bryan Cain, Jim Hendry, and Bryan O'Connor from Virginia.

b. Lee will continue to develop a list of speakers from the college and professional ranks.

c. There was discussion of using some of our high school coaches for the mini-clinics. They would use a cross-section of coaches from all classes.

d. There was discussion of how much each speaker was being paid. There is a set rate for college and pro coaches. To get a national speaker more money would be spent. Brett Hoyer will develop a budget for speakers.

## ALL-STAR SERIES IN CAROLL:

a. John Waddle and Dan Pomeroy have things under control and everything is progressing on time. The dates of the All-Star Series will be Aug. 6-9.

b. There will be a staff meeting in Carroll on August 5th at 7 PM.

## NEW ALL-ACADEMIC FORM:

a. A new form has been developed and is in the newsletter. It will also be available on the web-site.

## PERFECT GAME WEBSITE FOR HS:

a. No action on this issue. Coaches support Perfect Game but don't want to endorse the web-site?

## SCHOLARSHIP PROPOSAL FOR ALL-ACADEMIC ALL-STATE WINNER:

a. This scholarship would go to the captain of the All-Academic team. This will continue to be the Lanny Peterson Award winner. But that individual will now get a 1-2,000 scholarship that will be named the Dan Dawson All-State Academic Scholarship. The scholarship will be named after Dan Dawson, a former Dowling baseball player, who has ALS. This will come at no cost to the Coaches Association. Should I mention who is heading up the funding for this scholarship? (Is it someone from the I Cubs?)

## ADDITIONAL COMMENTS:

a. There has been a lot of good comments about the association and the clinic emailed to Lee.

b. The gift to Pinky and Flo was a very nice gesture on behalf of the association.

c. Lee is looking into having Gene Schultz and Denny Olejniczak speak at the clinic in the future.

d. Trying to have the fall meeting at a night game.

e. Send out a post card reminding coaches that the newsletter will be online.

f. A special thanks to the Argon Insurance group for allowing the coaches association to have the spring meeting in their suite at Veterans Memorial Stadium.

g. A reminder to coaches that they will need to use Quick Stats this summer. Many coaches have expressed frustration about the extra time that it will take and the availability of other coaches to look at your stats. The State will not change their mind on this issue.

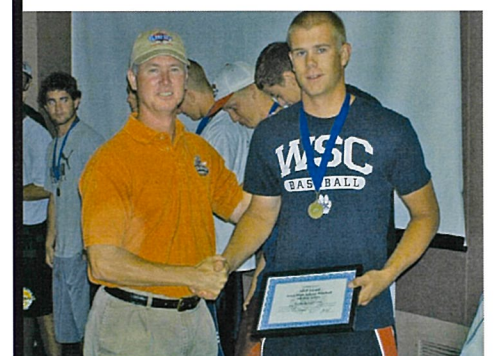

Chad Piersma from Sioux City North High School. Chad is ranked 1st in his graduating class, has a 4.00 GPA, with a 35 ACT score. His baseball honors include first team all-conference, first team all-district, all-state honors both his junior and senior year, and then to top the summer off, his Sioux City North team wins the Class 4A State Tournament.
