# CLINIC BOARD of DIRECTORS MEETING NOTES

The IHSBCA annual clinic Board of Directors meeting was held on Thursday, January 28th at the Marriot Hotel in Cedar Rapids. The meeting was called to order at 7:40pm by President Bret Hoyer. He welcomed everyone and introductions were made. Minutes from the fall meeting were discussed. Motion to accept by Don Taylor, 2nd by Mike Pauly. Lee presented the financial report. Lee has set-up a spreadsheet comparing past to current year expenses. This should help with projecting future years expenses. At this time all accounts are in good shape. The report noted a profit made from the '09 clinic and all-star series. Gary Nyhus moved to accept the financial report. A 2nd by Jerry Roling.

Bret Hoyer gave the presidents report. He recommended that Phil Katz go through the officer chairs. This motion was 2nd by Tom Souhrada. Motion passed.

Lee gave Executive Directors report. A few changes with clinic speakers. Dan Gable was not able to attend this year. Ed Mathey from Northern Illinois will fill that spot. Ryan Brownlee and Mike Anderson switched speaking spots due to travel time. It was reported that 330 coaches had pre-registered. Lee noted that last year we paid for an extra 70 no-show meals at the banquet. This year we will pre-order 250 meals. The umpires portion of the clinic will rotate sites. Steve Hanson put together the mini-clinic packets and evaluation forms. Milo Hamilton will not be able to attend HOF Banquet. Will be inducted next year. May need to look at future clinic format to accomodate school cuts.

Hall of Fame Committee report given by Roger Hoel. Nominations for the class of 2011 are in. Committee will meet on Friday morning to make their selections. Members are encouraged to continue to look for former players, coaches, and umpires who are deserving to put into the Hall of Fame.

All District Committee report by Mike Morrison. Have revised all-state and all-district forms to match with Quikstats. Added an additional utility/multi pos. spot on the all-district forms.

Awards Committee report by Phil Katz. Would like to move committee meeting time next year to Friday AM. Work in progress re-designing HOF plaque. 400 win club and above will receive plaque.

All-Star Committee report by Lee Toole. Series will be in Cedar Rapids. Games will be played in Kernels Stadium and at Kirkwood College. The 2011 All-Star Series will be in Council Bluffs.

Umpire Committee report by Mike Pauly. Mike will draft a letter to send out to conference commissioners hoping to get more umpires to join the association. The IHSAA and Roger Barr have approved the plate work/mechanics part of the clinic towards certification of officials to allow umpires to work during post-season tournament play.

Lanny Peterson Award report was given by Bret Hoyer. It was brought up that Tim Strellner would like to donate money in the form of a scholarship, to go along with the Lanny Peterson award in the amount of \$500. It was also discussed to start an endowment fund to keep this scholarship going year to year. Coaches will be able to donate towards this scholarship on the membership form.

State Rating Poll report by Randy Wee. Reminder of committee meeting on Friday morning. Randy will work again this summer with Todd Kimm from Radio Iowa. Please call in your records.

Membership Committee report by Dave Middleton. They are tracking the number of coaches from year to year who join the association. They are also tracking the attendance/coaches who attend the all-district meetings. Want to increase membership.

Clinic Evaluation Committee Report by Steve Hanson. The new committee has developed a form for coaches to evaluate the clinic topics and speakers. This form will also give coaches an opportunity to make suggestions for future clinics. This will help towards the evaluation of clinic speakers, topics, and the mini-clinic format. We hope this tool can help to continue to improve the clinic. Visit the website for results.

IHSAA Advisory Committee report by Steve Hanson. Several changes from the IHSAA this year. If an assistant coach leaves the dugout or coaches box to question a judgment call, the assistant and head coach will be banned to the dugout. Teams traveling the furthest for the State Tournament will play the last game of the afternoon or first game in the evening. The 4A seeding is permanent and 3A schools will start seeding in 2011. Tournament time, higher seeded teams will host games, unless they have no lights. In this situation, an alternate field will be found that does not require an increase in travel time. If one is unavailable, the lower seed team may host.

Audit Committee/Constitution Committee report by Bret Hoyer. The committee has gone over the constitution and cleaned up/up-dated some of the language.

Steering Committee report by Dave Rock. Dave noted that Lee Toole has done an excellent job as the Executive Director. Lee has created an environment for open communication among all members. He has also brought in more dollars in sponsorships. Dave recommended that Lee receive an increase in pay of \$500. Motion by Mike Morrison and Roger Hoel. Motion passed.

Communications: Thank You to Rick Wulkow and the IHSAA for their \$1,500 donation to help with clinic costs. A suggestion made that we move the Thursday night clinic meetings 1 hour later to help with travel. Another suggestion was to make the 1st games of the All-Star Series 9 inning games. This would give more players the opportunity to play earlier during the series in case bad weather moves in later on that weekend. Presents the 2010 Junior Showcase

The Iowa High School Baseball Coaches Association will be holding the First Annual Junior Showcase for the top junior baseball players in Iowa.

The date will be Thursday, August 5th and held at Cedar Rapids Kennedy baseball field. The showcase will begin at 9:00 a.m. and conclude by 3:00 p.m. The purpose of the event is to allow the top seniors-to-be showcase their baseball abilities to both college coaches and professional scouts.

No games will be played. All players will be timed in the 60 yard dash. Catchers will be timed on their throws to second. Outfielders will show their arm strength with throws from right field to third base and home plate. First basemen will field ground balls and display their arm strength to third base. Shortstops, second basemen, and third basemen will field ground balls at their respective positions and show their fielding ability and arm strength with a variety of throws to first base. They will also turn a couple of double plays. Pitchers will throw 15 pitches off the mound, showing their fastball, curveball, change up, and any other pitches. All players will be given an opportunity to take 10 swings on the field. Players may only work out at one position.

Coaches are asked to nominate their 2011 graduates whom they feel have the potential to play college baseball. IF YOU ARE NOMINATING, PLEASE INFORM PLAYERS THAT THEY MAY BE SELECTED. This will decrease any surprises. Coaches are asked to have their nominations forms sent to Jeremy Langner by July 1, 2010. Nomination forms will be available on-line at [www.iowahsbca.net](http://www.iowahsbca.net). Coaches are asked to please nominate only those players they feel have the ability to play college baseball at some level. We believe to provide coaches and scouts with the best talent, players should have already received conference and district honors. We ask that you nominate and rank them, in the order of their collegiate baseball potential. If you don't receive the nomination form please email Jeremy Langner at [langnerj@waterloo.k12.ia.us](mailto:langnerj@waterloo.k12.ia.us) or call 319-215-2293.

After the nomination process closes on July 1, 2010, the selection committee will consult with high school coaches from around the state, college coaches, and professional scouts in attempting to select the top players to be invited to the showcase.

Once a player has been selected, he will be sent an acceptance form and a player information form to be signed and returned to Jeremy Langner, along with a check for \$40 made out to the IHSBCA. If the forms and check are not returned by July 20th, that player may not be included in the showcase and another player may be invited. All proceeds from this event will go directly to the Iowa High School Baseball Coaches Association. No individuals will share in any profits from this event.

The showcase is being held in conjunction with the IHSBCA All-Star Series. All players will receive 2 complimentary tickets to the evening games at Veterans Memorial Stadium. The IHSBCA appreciates your efforts in supporting both the association and providing a positive experience for Iowa's high school baseball players.

All-District priorities to follow during your July meetings:

Dates: 1A and 2A meetings – July 11<sup>th</sup> at 1:00 pm

3A and 4A meetings – July 18<sup>th</sup> at 1:00 pm

Nomination priorities to follow while selecting your All-District teams:

- 1) Nomination of a player must be made by his coach (Head, Assistant, AD)
- 2) Coach/school must be a current member of the IHSBCA
- 3) Coach/AD must be in attendance at the district meeting to nominate player
- 4) Year in school of player
- 5) Previous All-District and/or All-State honors
- 6) Look at the "degree of difficulty" of the players team schedule/record

Other suggestions to keep in mind:

- 1) Nominations will be taken from the floor for each position. A player must have over 50% of the votes to be selected for each team. (Approved March 11, 1989).
- 2) Use regular season stats only! No post-season tournament stats.
- 3) Each school gets one vote, per position/player. Coaches should be prepared to show 2009-2010 membership card or school should be checked-off the membership list in order to vote. If coach is not a member of the Association, coach must join immediately before meeting begins and pay for this remaining year and next year's dues; which will be \$60.00, (2009-2010 and 2010-2011). Annual dues for membership are \$30 for one year. (September thru August)
- 4) Majority vote rule in place for each position chosen at All-District meeting.
- 5) A Utility player must have played at more than one position. Example: Pitcher/SS, SS/Catcher, Out Fielder/Pitcher, Catcher/First baseman. (Player must have played in at least 20% of those games at that second position!)
- 6) Make sure a third/second baseman has played those positions for the majority of the season! (Don't allow a shortstop, who has played very little third or second, move over and take that position away from a regular third or second baseman because they did not make it at "SS" when voting was completed for that position.)
- 7) There are NO ties. Only select the number of players as there are lines for on the roster sheets according to the % of schools attending the meeting. Continue voting until all ties are resolved, (Approved February 2006.) Consider the above priorities if a tie continues to occur after a number of voting sessions.
