# IHSBCA Clinic Board Meeting Minutes Friday, January 28, 2011 Marriott Hotel – Cedar Rapids

The meeting was called to order by President John Waddle @ 11:00am. Minutes from the November meeting were approved. John reported that Lee continues to do a great job directing our association. Lee's salary will be frozen at his own request and will be re-evaluated in two years. In lieu of the salary freeze, Lee asked to replace his current copy machine with an updated model. He also asked to begin replacing the current association banquet banners as they are becoming worn/torn. John mentioned that the 2012 clinic next year will be held one week earlier - January 20-22, 2012. This will help in our efforts to secure college coaches as speakers since their college season is being moved forward one week. The association is also looking at the feasibility of moving the clinic to Des Moines in 2013 on an experimental basis. John also mentioned that the Thursday night meetings have new starting times. The Steering committee meeting will begin at 6:30pm followed by the Board of Directors at 8:30pm. This format allows more traveling time for those involved. Motion to accept the Presidents report was made by Jerry Roling, seconded by Tim O'Neill.

The Executive Director's report was given by Lee Toole. Lee mentioned that over 300 coaches had pre-registered for the clinic, along with 31 umpires and 23 vendors. Lee mentioned that all the speakers were accounted for and the banquet numbers stood at 240 members and guests. All seven Hall of Fame inductees would be at the banquet. Phil Katz and Jay Ryan will be in charge of introducing the speakers. Lee reminded everyone to turn in the clinic evaluation sheets as this provides much needed feedback on how to improve the clinic. It was mentioned that Perfect Game would be sponsoring a hospitality room during the weekend clinic and Gary Nyhus would be providing hospitality following the banquet Saturday night. Lee reminded everyone that the clinic ends at the University of Iowa Bubble on Sunday, 9:30am-11:30am. Lee encouraged everyone to visit the vendors. It was also mentioned that the Hall of Fame pictures would be at 5:30 pm on Saturday. Motion was made to accept the adoptions to the constitution. Jack Lynch motioned to accept the adoptions and Lee's report, seconded by Dave Rock.

The Hall of Fame report was given by Roger Hoel. Roger mentioned that nominations were down and encouraged members to nominate deserving members. His committee met on Friday morning and selected the nominees for the 2012 Hall of Fame. Motion to accept Rogers report was made by Mike Pauley and seconded by Tom Jenk, Jr..

Mike Morrison gave the All District Committee Report. Mike went over the protocol on how to change districts. Mike also mentioned that his committee had been assigned to look at the all-star series balance and come up with recommendations on how to create a better, "Competitive Balance" among large vs. small schools. Also mentioned that finding coaches to coach in the all star series has been an issue in recent years, everyone was encouraged to get their assistant coaches involved with the All Star Series. John Waddle echoed these sentiments. Tim O'Neill motioned to accept report, seconded by Dick Smith.

The Awards Committee report was given by Phil Katz. Phil mentioned that he was still working on the new design for the Hall of Fame award. He had everything ready to go but due to a computer mishap at school, all the designs and information were lost. Ryan Stensland of Lisbon has been asked to design a new Bill and Sherry Freese Contributors Award. Phil mentioned with over 60 awards and a budget of over \$5,000 dollars, it would be hard to find any association across the nation that does a better job honoring its members. Paul Keitel motioned to accept the report, seconded by Chris Oberbroeckling.

Lee Toole gave the All-Star Committee report. The Council Bluffs Chamber of Commerce is working with Lee to secure the hotel and banquet facility for the series this August. Games will be played at Lewis Central High School, Iowa Western Community College, and we are trying to secure the new Ameritrade Stadium in Omaha for Sunday's games. Don Taylor motioned to accept Lee's report, seconded by Jack Lynch.

Mike Pauley gave the Umpire Committee report. He reported that his committee created and supplied the flier that the Iowa High School Athletic Association sent to every Iowa baseball coach and registered umpire in the spring of 2010 urging them to become members of the association. A mail-in coupon was included in this flier. Mike also reported on a successful All-Star series in Cedar Rapids for all 16 umpires that were selected by the committee. The committee also selected 12 umpires from each of the four districts to be nominees for District umpire of the year honors, with one district winner to become the Brent Prange Umpire of the Year recipient. These nominated umpires have first chance to work the 2011 All-Star Series which is to be held in Council Bluffs. Mike was proud to report that the headliner for this years' umpire session at the clinic would be Kyle McNeeley, chairman of the National Federation Baseball Rules Committee. Motion was made by Rich Collison to accept the umpire committee report, seconded by Steve Schantz

John Waddle gave the Lanny Peterson Award report. John mentioned that it was a neat experience to be involved in this selection process. Nick Thimesch from Marshalltown was the 2010 Lanny Peterson Award winner. Nick had outstanding credentials and was a very deserving recipient. Gary Paulsen then gave a quick All Academic report. Gary reviewed the formula and briefly went over the selection process. Like John, Gary said the experience was a good one and mentioned that there were over 74 applicants. Dave Rock motioned to accept both reports, seconded by Tom Souhrada.

Mark Hey gave the Rating Poll Committee report. It was recommended that all coaches update QuikStats, (at least the scores), after each game so that accurate records can be used and reported back by the IHSAA. Mark explained that four coaches have been assigned to help gather needed information for the rankings in each class. These assigned coaches are:

Troy Rood, Mason City—4A

Keith McSweeney, Solon 3A

Jake Souhrada, Wilton 2A

Matt Zoske, BCLUW 1A

Mark explained how each would have a contact person from each conference, in each class. These contacts would e-mail information about teams in their district. Troy, Jake, Keith, and Matt will organize this information from their class, based on the input from coaches and quikstats. This information will be forwarded to Troy Rood by 5:00pm each Sunday. Troy will then contact Todd Kimm to finalize the rankings. Tim O'Neill will update the pre-season form. It was recommended that this form be e-mailed to coaches and posted on the website. Mike Pauley motioned to accept report, seconded by Jake Souhrada.

Steve Hansen gave the Mini-Clinic and Clinic Evaluation Committee report, followed by the IHSBCA Advisory Report. Steve mentioned that he would like to video tape the mini-sessions and suggested asking the audience if anyone had "Tech Experience" to contact him. Steve then gave a lengthy report on the IHSAA Advisory Committee. Steve explained that the state was considering changing the beds classification system for 2A and 1A. Last season there were more 2A schools (128) than 1A schools (123), but as many as 5 to 10 schools may be without baseball this season. The state was not comfortable with 2A having more schools than 1A, so the following 3 options were on the table for the IHSAA classification committee:

- Leave it alone, keep 128 2A schools with the rest to follow in Class 1A.
- 2. 96/rest scenario. Cut 2A to 96 teams and leave the rest in Class 1A.
- 3. 50/50 split. Divide 1A/2A schools in half, (this would need revision every year).

Steve's committee suggested a 112/rest scenario. Steve felt that the 96-rest scenario, seemed the most popular. Steve mentioned that in December, the Board of Control approved the 96-rest scenario, which might take place this year. Steve tactfully, expressed his frustration with this decision. Steve reviewed the ejection report. There were 96 ejections during the 2010 baseball season, up 23 from last season. Of those, 23 were coach's ejections. Steve informed the group that starting this year, ejected coaches must go on-line and watch a sportsmanship video from the National Federation. The coach must print a certificate, at a cost of \$25.00, then fax it to the IHSAA before he is allowed to coach again. No certificate equals No Coaching. Steve mentioned this could amount to more than a 1 game suspension due to the closeness of games and the timeline involved with this process. Steve mentioned that No composite bats are legal in 2011, except those listed on the IHSAA web site. In 2012, all bats must be BBCOR approved with a sticker on the bat. Steve talked about the possibility of an "Open Hitting" time frame in 2012. We are to create a proposal for the board. Steve mentioned that Roger Barr gave us some key areas that needed to be addressed in order to have a "CHANCE" at getting this plan adopted by the Board of Control. It was the feeling of the Advisory Committee, that we could not stray too far from the ground rules that Roger set up. Roger is the person who needs to agree with this proposal. If we as baseball coaches can accept the model that Roger Barr suggested, even if it is not exactly what we would like, then we have a chance to gain some pre-season hitting freedoms. The committee's opinion was that we get what we can get and not become greedy. Greedy could get us shutout. Seeding was discussed next. With the poor response from 4A coaches last year, 11 schools had to be called by the IHSAA, seeding could be in trouble. Over 20% of our 4A coaches/AD's either don't want seeding or don't care enough about it to fill out one sheet of paper and fax it in. Based on a comment by Roger, the 4-A apathy displayed will surely impact the opportunity for other classifications to begin seeding. If the 4A coaches remain negligent, then we have given the IHSAA all the ammo it needs to remove seeding from high school baseball. The coaches advisory committee recommended that we stick to the plan established several years ago and move forward so experimental seeding can take place this summer for 3A. The 3A proposal was rejected by the board in December. Based on the December vote, it leaves us wondering how long seeding will be in existence. The current climate also makes the potential "pre-season hitting option" seem like a fairy tale, but we won't know until we try. Motion to accept report made by Dave Middleton and seconded by Gary Nyhus.

The Junior Showcase Committee report was given by Trent Eckstein. Things went very well this year, we had 6 pro scouts in attendance, along with over 35 college coaches. This summer's showcase will be at Iowa Western. Trent mentioned that a key to this system working better was that high school coaches need to only recommend players with true college potential. One suggestion was to maybe have a spring showcase. Another suggestion was to have one central location. Don Taylor motioned to accept the report, Dick Smith seconded. Lee brought up that Don Lyons had been recommended to replace John Waddle on the chairs. Dave Rock motioned to accept this nomination, seconded by Steve Schantz. Mike Pauley motioned to adjourn the meeting, Gary Nyus second. Meeting adjourned at 11:58am.

## Iowa High School Baseball Coaches Association Presents the 2011 Junior Showcase



The Iowa High School Baseball Coaches Association will be holding the 2nd Annual Junior Showcase for the top junior baseball players in Iowa.

The date will be Thursday, August 4th, at the lowa Western Community College baseball field. The showcase will begin at 9:00 a.m. and conclude by 4:00 p.m. The purpose of the event is to allow the top seniors-to-be showcase their baseball abilities to both college coaches and professional scouts.

No games will be played. All players will be timed in the 60 yard dash. Catchers will be timed on their throws to second. Outfielders will show their arm strength with throws from right field to third base and home plate. First basemen will field ground balls and display their arm strength to third base. Shortstops, second basemen, and third basemen will field ground balls at their respective positions and show their fielding ability and arm strength with a variety of throws to first base. They will also turn a couple of double plays. Pitchers will throw 15 pitches off the mound, showing their fastball, curveball, change up, and any other pitches. All players will be given an opportunity to take 10 swings on the field. Players may only work out at one position.

Coaches are asked to nominate their 2012 graduates whom they feel have the potential to play college baseball. IF YOU ARE NOMINATING, PLEASE INFORM PLAYERS THAT THEY MAY BE SELECTED. This will decrease any surprises. Coaches are asked to have their nominations forms sent to Jeremy Langner by July 1, 2011. Nomination forms will be available on-line at <a href="https://www.iowahsbca.net">www.iowahsbca.net</a>. Coaches are asked to please nominate only those players they feel have the ability to play college baseball at some level. We believe to provide coaches and scouts with the best talent, players should have already received conference and district honors. We ask that you nominate and rank them, in the order of their collegiate baseball potential. Once a player has been selected, he will be sent an acceptance form and a player information form to be signed and returned to Jeremy Langner, along with a check for \$40 made out to the IHSBCA. If the forms and check are not returned by July 20th, that player may not be included in the showcase and another player may be invited. All proceeds from this event will go directly to the lowa High School Baseball Coaches Association. No individuals will share in any profits from this event.





## <u>Dates</u>: 1A and 2A meetings – July 10<sup>th</sup> at 1:00 pm 3A and 4A meetings – July 17<sup>th</sup> at 1:00 pm

#### Nomination priorities to follow while selecting your All-District teams:

- 1) Nomination of a player must be made by his coach (Head, Assistant, AD)
- 2) Coach/school must be a current member of the IHSBCA
- 3) Coach/AD must be in attendance at the district meeting to nominate player
- 4) Year in school of player
- 5) Previous All-District and/or All-State honors
- 6) Look at the "degree of difficulty" of the players team schedule/record

#### Other suggestions to keep in mind:

- 1) Nominations will be taken from the floor for each position. A player must have over 50% of the votes to be selected for each team. (Approved March 11, 1989).
- 2) Use regular season stats only! **No** post-season tournament stats.
- 3) Each school gets one vote, per position/player. Coaches should be prepared to show 2010-2011 membership card or school should be checked-off the membership list in order to vote. If coach is not a member of the Association, coach must join immediately before meeting begins and pay for this remaining year and next year's dues; which will be \$60.00, (2010-2011 and 2011-2012). Annual dues for membership are \$30 for one year. (September thru August)
- 4) Majority vote rule in place for each position chosen at All-District meeting.
- 5) A Utility player must have played at more than one position. Example: Pitcher/SS, SS/Catcher, Out Fielder/Pitcher, Catcher/First baseman. (Player must have played in at least 20% of those games at that second position!)
- 6) Make sure a third/second baseman has played those positions for the majority of the season! (Don't allow a shortstop, who has played very little third or second, move over and take that position away from a regular third or second baseman because they did not make it at "SS" when voting was completed for that position.)
- 7) There are **NO ties**. Only select the number of players as there are lines for on the roster sheets according to the % of schools attending the meeting. Continue voting until all ties are resolved, (Approved February 2006.) Consider the above priorities if a tie continues to occur after a number of voting sessions.






