message from the dugout:

A few reminders as the baseball regular season comes to an end and we gear up for the post season, all-district selection meetings, and the all-star series:

- 1) Check the schedule for the time and place of your All-District meetings in each class.
- Please get your All-Academic nomination forms and your All-Star nomination forms to me ASAP. Forms are available in this newsletter, on the website, and at your All-District meetings.
- 3) The All-Academic player nomination forms are due by July 17, 2012.
- 4) The All-Star Series player nomination forms are due by July 17, 2012.
- 5) The 2012 All-Star Series will be in Clinton on August 2 5. Games during the four day series will be played at Ashford University Field, home of the Clinton Lumber Kings, minor league Class "A" affiliate of the Seattle Mariners. Please attend and enjoy!
- 6) Reminder coaches are needed for the All-State player selection meetings, which take place during the All-Star Series in Clinton on Friday, August 3rd at 11:00am.

 These All-State player selection meetings will be held at Clinton High School. You can sign-up for the All-State selection meetings at your All-District meetings. We will need two coaches per district.
- 7) We have had another great response towards our 3rd annual "Junior Showcase"! A big "Thank you" to everyone for getting the word out. At this point, our registration for the showcase is well over 125 high school juniors. It is not to late to get your junior players registered. Contact Jeremy Languer at www.languerj@waterloo.k12.ia.us. Showcase information can be found on the website www.lowahsbca.net.
- B) Don't forget! To attend your All-District meeting, you must be a current 2012 association member. If you have not yet renewed your membership for this year, you still have time to do so. If you decide to pay at your all-district meeting, you will need to pay for not only this current membership year, but also for next years membership. So, it will cost you \$60 at the meeting for this year and the next year's membership. This is an association policy.
- 9) FYI the guidelines used for selecting players at the All-District meetings are found on the next page in this newsletter.

All-District priorities to follow during your July meetings:

<u>Dates</u>: 1A and 2A meetings – July 8th at 1:00 pm 3A and 4A meetings – July 15th at 1:00 pm

Nomination priorities to follow while selecting your All-District teams:

- 1) Nomination of a player must be made by his coach (Head, Assistant, AD)
- 2) Coach/school must be a current member of the IHSBCA
- 3) Coach/AD must be in attendance at the district meeting to nominate player
- 4) Year in school of player
- 5) Previous All-District and/or All-State honors
- 6) Look at the "degree of difficulty" of the players team schedule/record

Other suggestions to keep in mind:

- 1) Nominations will be taken from the floor for each position. A player must have over 50% of the votes to be selected for each team. (Approved March 11, 1989).
- 2) Use regular season stats only! **No** post-season tournament stats.
- 3) Each school gets one vote, per position/player. Coaches should be prepared to show 2011-2012 membership card or school should be checked-off the membership list in order to vote. If coach is not a member of the Association, coach must join immediately before meeting begins and pay for this remaining year and next year's dues; which will be \$60.00, (2011-2012 and 2012-2013). Annual dues for membership are \$30 for one year. (September thru August)
- 4) Majority vote rule in place for each position chosen at All-District meeting.
- 5) A Utility player must have played at more than one position. Example: Pitcher/SS, SS/Catcher, Out Fielder/Pitcher, Catcher/First baseman. (Player must have played in at least 20% of those games at that second position!)
- 6) Make sure a third/second baseman has played those positions for the majority of the season! (Don't allow a shortstop, who has played very little third or second, move over and take that position away from a regular third or second baseman because they did not make it at "SS" when voting was completed for that position.)
- 7) There are <u>NO ties</u>. Only select the number of players as there are lines for on the roster sheets according to the % of schools attending the meeting. Continue voting until all ties are resolved, (Approved February 2006.) Consider the above priorities if a tie continues to occur after a number of voting sessions.





WHAT IS BBCOR?

BBCOR (Batted Ball Coefficient of Restitution)

This is the new performance standard that is replacing BESR (Ball Exit Speed Ratio).

Rather than measuring the ratio of the ball exit speed to pitch and bat speeds (like with BESR), BBCOR measures the trampoline effect of the bat. In the past, when a pitched ball made contact with an alloy or composite bat, the barrel would flex inward ever so slightly and the ball would retain some of its energy resulting in farther hits. Wood bats don't have as much "give" to them and the ball loses much of its energy upon impact. Like BESR, the BBCOR standard ensures that non-wood bats perform more comparably to wood bats in an attempt to level the playing field.

It also accounts for how bats perform after they've been broken in. Since the advent of composite bats, it was found that the more they were used the better they performed. This led to tampering with the bats to artificially accelerate the break-in process and improve bat performance. To account for this, bats are now tested after various stages of simulated use in the lab, so that a bat never performs beyond the BBCOR standard at any point during its useful life.

ALL-STAR SQUAD REGULATIONS:

Each squad will consist of 16 players: (2 catchers, 4 pitchers, 5 infielders, 4 outfielders and 1 utility).

PLAYER SELECTION:

First priority:
Coach's recommendation
Second priority:
All District Team
Third priority:
Coach is a member of the association.

RULES:

- 1. All players chosen must play.
- 2. The pitchers can pitch a full game.
- 3. Friday night games will be 9 innings. All other games will be 7 inning games, unless extra innings are needed.
- If needed, a tie breaker system is in place for the Sunday Championship games.
 Will be announced before Sunday's games.

Example: Head to Head competition, most runs sored, least runs given up, most hits, least hits given up. All of the examples can be given points. The two teams with the most points will play for 1st place. This system will give more boys an opportunity to play and show what they can do. We will not restrict a pitcher on amount of innings he can pitch in one day.

*Players who do not make the All-District Teams will still be elgible to play in the Series.

2012 ALL-STAR SERIES IN CLINTON, AUGUST 2-5:

The 36th Annual All-Star Series games will be held in Clinton this summer. Games will be played at Ashford University Field home of the Clinton Lumber Kings. Coaches need to nominate their deserving senior players by filling out an All-Star Series form found in this newsletter or on the website. Please enclose a photo of your player, along with as much information as possible to give those coaches selecting the teams the best opportunity to select our best high school players.

The Board of Directors passed a policy that any player or coach selected to participate in the All-Star Series must have a minimum sponsorship fee of \$225.00. More always helps defray the cost of the series. It will be the high school coach's responsibility to help their players get sponsorships for the All-Star Series. This policy is necessary in order to off set the cost of putting on the All-Star Series. If you have questions or concerns, please contact your district representative or an officer for further explanation. Please have sponsorship fees paid and sponsorship names turned into the Executive Director no later than August 2nd if your player is selected.

Iowa High School Baseball Coaches Association Presents the 2012 Junior Showcase



The lowa High School Baseball Coaches Association will be holding the 3rd Annual Junior Showcase for the top junior baseball players in lowa.

The date will be Sunday, July 29, 2012 and held at Southeast Polk High School in Pleasant Hill, lowa. The showcase will begin at 9:00 a.m. and conclude by 3:00 p.m. The purpose of the event is to allow the top seniors-to-be showcase their baseball abilities to both college coaches and professional scouts.

No games will be played. All players will be timed in the 60 yard dash. Catchers will be timed on their throws to second. Outfielders will show their arm strength with throws from right field to third base and home plate. First basemen will field ground balls and display their arm strength to third base. Shortstops, second basemen, and third basemen will field ground balls at their respective positions and show their fielding ability and arm strength with a variety of throws to first base. They will also turn a couple of double plays. Pitchers will throw 15 pitches off the mound, showing their fastball, curveball, change up, and any other pitches. All position players will be given an opportunity to take 10 swings in the cage. Players may only work out at one position.

Coaches are asked to nominate their 2013 graduates whom they feel have the potential to play college baseball. IF YOU ARE NOMINATING, PLEASE INFORM PLAYERS THAT THEY MAY BE SELECTED. This will decrease any surprises. Coaches are asked to have their nominations sent to Jeremy Langner by July 1, 2011. Nominations will all be ONLINE and can be completed at http://www.iowahsbca.net/junior showcase. Coaches are asked to please nominate only those players they feel have the ability to play college baseball at some level. We believe to provide college coaches and scouts with the best talent, players should have already received conference and district honors. If you cannot access the nomination website, please email Jeremy Langner at langneri@waterlooschools.org or call 319-215-2293 or email Trent Eckstaine fourshotrem@hotmail.com or call 712-540-7909.

Once a player has been selected, he will be sent an acceptance form and a player information form to be signed and returned to Jeremy Langner, along with a check for \$50 made out to the IHSBCA. If the forms and check are not returned by July 15th, that player may not be included in the showcase and another player may be invited. All proceeds from this event will go directly to the lowa High School Baseball Coaches Association.

The IHSBCA appreciates your efforts in supporting both the association and providing a positive experience for Iowa's high school baseball players.
