

MINUTES OF THE GENERAL MEETING March 11, 1977

The meeting was called to order by President Mick Mattice at 10:35 A.M. at Cedar Rapids Washington High School.

Report of Secretary: Introduction of New Directors was made by Jim Ellwanger, Secretary. Minutes of preceding meeting (March 13, 1976) were approved. Al Seabrooke moved that the minutes be approved, seconded by Bob Watson. Motion carried.

Financial Report by Executive Secretary: Treasurer Al Seabrooke reported that he had checked over the books and they are in order. Lowell Thomson moved and Jim Jagim seconded that financial report be accepted. Motion carried.

<u>President's Report</u>: Mick Mattice thanked all committee members, officers, especially executive secretary, and board members for the excellent job all have done during the past year.

Executive Secretary's Report: "Pinky" Primrose made the following comments to the membership present:

1. Reported that clinic is all set with all speakers coming and banquet biggest in history.

2. Finances are in order with year ending in the black.

3. In regards the All star game, a suggestion that we go easy at first, don't jeopardize the association financially.

4. Committee members are really important -- talk it up.

5. Let's get active coaches in the Hall of Fame as well as the other areas.

Ten-year pin for membership is good.

7. Special thanks to Duane Banks; he has really helped our Association; lots of work and effort was given.

All District Committee Report: Dennis Olejniczak gave report of suggestions to members. Suggested that certificates for being named All District be sent out earlier to the honored players. Al Seabrooke moved and Lenny Weih seconded that All District Committee set up guidelines and get material to All District meetings for handing out certificates. Motion carried. Also suggested that All District teams be selected by classes. Two teams in each class with 3 pitchers, 2 catchers, 4 infielders, 3 outfielders, and 2 utility players selected on each team. Jim Schulz moved and Dave Posegate seconded that All District committee report be put in effect with 14 players on each team with 2 teams selected from both A and AA schools in each district according to tournament pairing distinction of A or AA

school by the Iowa High School Athletic Association. Motion carried.

All State Coach Committee Report: Dick Core gave committee report. Suggested that we honor past Coaches of the Year with a table at banquet each year. Following discussion of Coach of the Year award, Doug Albertson moved and Jim Schulz seconded that association award All State Coach of the Year to both Class A and AA. Motion carried.

Hall of Fame Committee Report: Marv Thelan suggested as a guideline that a questionaire be sent out in regards Hall of Fame nominations. Also we should establish a form to follow as a resume for nominees to the Hall of Fame.

Constitution Committee Report: Doug Dunlap reported that constitution changes appeared in last newsletter. No proposals to change the constitution at this time.

Membership Committee Report: Joel Franklin reported that there is lots of work to be done with only about 45% of the coaches as members. Only four conferences have 100% membership; the Mississippe Valley, Mississippi Eight, Southeast Seven, and the Big Eight. A breakdown of coaches as members in each district is as follows: Southwest-41%; Northwest-37%; Central-43%; Northeast-53%; and Southeast-53%. Joel also suggested that we continue to work hard to increase the membership.

All State Rating Poll Committee Report: Bob Watson recommended that District representatives be responsible for serving on committee with Chuch Burdick, and in areas where representatives do not cover all of the district, select from coaches in that area.

All Star Game Committee Report: Committee members are Dave Posegate, Ames chairman; Jim Ellwanger, St. Edmond, Fort Dodge; Jim Mahoney, Johnston; John Boddicker, YJB; and Stuart McCord, Lawton. Dave Posegate reported th at All Star game dates will be August 13th and 14th, 1977. Bring players in on Friday for practice and banquet. First year games will be held in Ames, second year in Iowa City. Format to be followed will be:

North "A" vs. South "A" North "AA" vs. South "AA"

Losers Game #1 vs. Losers Game #2

Winners Game #1 vs. Winners Game #2 Committee will select four coaches with highway 30 as dividing line. Each head coach to select his two assistants as he desires. Duane Banks will find sponsors for the All Star Games.

Dave Posegate reported on the development of the All Star game and handed out guideline sheet which provided large amount of discussion. Possible dates are Saturday and Sunday August 6 or 7th, or August 12th or 13th.

Other committees had nothing to report at this time until meetings are held tomorrow morning at 9:30.

President's Report: Mick Mattice made the following comments:

Communications are not good, need more contact between coaches either written or by phone.

All Star game will need a total effort of everyone.

College coaches are needed to do more to get them involved

This clinic will be the best in attendance in our nine years and largely due to the great speakers on the program.

Communications: Bob Feller sent letter saying due to business in Japan he will be unable to attend clinic to receive Hall of Fame award.

Old Business: Girls' softball coaches as members of association. No real interest at present time. Several coaches are attending clinic without special session being established for softball coaches.
