At the same time as I have broadening my knowledge and resources with regards to disability and accessibility in the church, I have been eager to share my thoughts with the whole congregation. Thinking about how we might find a reframing of our mindset beneficial to how we understand the work of being an affirming and accessible congregation. I hope to get these conversations started on my first Sunday back in the pulpit as I will invite you to imagine what a church looks like when we first pay attention to accessibility concerns, rather than responding after there is a need. While there may always be circumstances and needs that we find ourselves responding to, I have found myself hopefully imagining how we as a congregation can make our worship and fellowship spaces accessible and welcoming the first time someone visits.

But I am getting ahead of myself. There will be plenty of time for us to catch up and share our ideas with one another after I return from my sabbatical. In preparation for my return I would like to bring a couple things to your attention. 1) I plan on doing a book study on the book "My Body is Not a Prayer Request" by Amy Kenny. If you are interested in participating I want you to consider if a mid-week gathering or a Sunday after worship (either option has the possibility of gathering around food) for this study. 2) As my phone and email officially "turn back on" on Tuesday September 3<sup>rd</sup>, I will be spending a few days in Washington D.C. with other Disciples clergy at the clergy retreat hosted by the Pension Fund. While I am at the retreat I will be making and returning phone calls and emails, just know there may be a slight delay based on the retreat schedule and time zone difference.


