Court Appointed Special Advocates (CASA) are trained volunteers who advocate for abused and neglected children in family court. CASA volunteers deal with abuse, neglect, and abandonment cases referred to them by Child Protective Services (CPS).

Preparing for Christmas

It is hard to believe that the Advent and Christmas seasons are almost here. As we start to make preparations for these seasons we wanted to pass along a little information to you.

- 1. We will be bringing some new and old practices into our worship service. As we learn some new songs that help us enter into the mindset of preparing the inn to house the holy, we will also be bringing back the practice of a weekly children's moment.
- 2. This is a great opportunity to invite friends and family to join us as we begin a new church year on December 1st.
- 3. Some of you will be excited to hear that each week we will be singing a Christmas carol during our service, (sometimes with a new verse or two) as it helps us get into the mood of the season.
- 4. Each Sunday of advent there will be some slips of paper for you to write prayers for Hope/Peace/Joy/Love that will be placed in the manger throughout the season. These pieces of paper will be used to line the manger in preparation to celebrate the birth of Christ. We are inviting the 1st Ukrainian Baptist Church in joining us in this practice.
- 5. We have enough copies of a special Advent Devotional "Daring to Connect: Advent as

adventure" by Dawn Darwin Weaks, for each household to have their own, as we can move through the season together in our devotional practices.

- 6. During coffee hour in the month of December those who wish to participate are invited to help prepare luminaries to light our path on Christmas Eve.
- 7. On the evening of December 21st we will hold a Blue Christmas Service, also known as Longest Night service, in the Fireside room at 3 pm. This service is designed to give space to those where this season may be difficult and not the happiest time of the year.

Dyslexia
