"And my God will supply every need of yours, according to his riches in Christ Jesus."


Philippians 4:19

The traditional festive greeting relays: "Merry Christmas and Happy New Year is wonderful! However, I have always appreciated the Spanish language greeting of "Feliz Navidad, prospero Ano y Felizidad." Particularly, the well-wish of "a prosperous and happy year."

Paul's expression for future wellbeing and prosperity to the Philippian congregants conveyed a blessing from God for their "every need." Ponder for a moment: if you knew with absolute certainty that every need of your life would be guaranteed, what emotions would arise in your heart and mind? Would you feel confident or secure, ecstatic or relieved? Would you rejoice? Perhaps, all these and more? What would have to happen for you to have that absolute certainty? A winning Mega-lottery ticket? A successful business or career? A loving soulmate to be with you throughout your life? An assurance that when this life ends that you would live in everlasting love, peace and joy? This last security is the only one that is Scripturally promised, and it is the only one that has any permanence. God's blessing does involve many material and relational assurances, but people often fail to realize that the hope of eternal life is the only permanent need that exists. Every blessing for the earthly life is enjoyable and pleasant. Every blessing for everlasting life is perfect and endures eternally. Knowing the difference between temporal and eternal blessing impacts how people view life (or it should). While earthly blessings and prosperity are nice, heavenly blessings are AWESOME because they come from an Awesome God! He knows the needs of every individual better than the individual knows themselves. Of course, one of the weaknesses of human beings is the propensity to translate "want" into "need." The promise of God is that every NEED will be met.

Thus, my prayer for you is that throughout the coming year God will meet ALL your needs according to his riches in Christ Jesus! He has prepared eternal blessing for you through the sacrifice of his Son, our Savior. I pray also that you will give him thanks in everything, knowing that "for those who love God all things work together for good, for those who are called according to his purpose" (Romans 8:28). "Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of lights, with whom there is no variation or shadow, due to change" (James 1:17). This is true even when we do not understand how the experiences of life are helping us. We too often see the lack of material blessing as a problem instead of as a blessing. Trust the Lord our God knows and provides all your true NEEDS.






