# First Things First...

#### This I Believe

"...in your hearts honor Christ the Lord as holy, always being prepared to make a defense to anyone who asks you for a reason for the hope that is in you, yet do it with gentleness and respect."

1 Peter 3:15


Belief exerts a powerful influence on every aspect of life. As Peter says above, there is a hope in everyone who believes in Christ the Lord. Each one of us should be ready, at any time, to make a defense (tell the reason) for that hope. In the series of statements which began in the February 2020 edition of *First Fruits*, I plan to share a summary of what I believe so that you may know me more fully and so you may see the reason for the hope that is in me. I continue the series with this article stating my belief regarding the nature of worship. Next month I will offer my beliefs regarding the style or practice of public and corporate worship.

I believe worship is not a gathering of believers and nonbelievers, meeting at a set time, in an appointed place. Worship is more than a time of praying, singing, Bible reading and Biblically-authentic prophecy. Worship exceeds singing along with a radio/CD/MP3/phone/streaming service, etc. Worship goes beyond attending Christian concerts. Too often, worship is perceived to be a worship service at a church or other reserved venue. True worship is much more than any or all of the aforementioned experiences (and many other unnamed ones).

I believe worship is the totality of one's life lived in a loving relationship with the One, True God. Worship calls out to God in an attitude of humility, thankfulness, adoration and neediness.

"Oh come, let us worship and bow down; let us kneel before the Lord our Maker." (Psalm 95:6) "Humble yourselves before the Lord..." (James 4:10) Why should we come before the Lord in humility? Job 38-41 presents evidence of God's singular strength, power, wisdom and authority. There is no other like Him. He is above all and over all. He created all that exists by the power of His Word. He sustains all that exists by His gracious will. He provides all that is necessary for this life and the life to come. He is God. We come before Him humbly because He deserves worship and honor.

"Give thanks to the Lord, for He is good." (Psalm 136:1) "...in everything give thanks; for this is God's will for you." (1 Thessalonians 5:18) "Thanks be to God for His indescribable gift!" (2 Corinthians 9:15) Should we be thankful to God? If He had done nothing more than provide the way for our salvation, He would deserve our unending thankfulness. Yet, He has done more. For everything mentioned in the preceding paragraph, He deserves our thanks. Luther's Explanation of the First Article of the Apostles' Creed states: "...God has created me and all that exists; that He has given and still preserves to me my body and soul, my eyes and ears, and all my members, my reason and Continued on page 6



all the powers of my soul, together with food and raiment, home and family and all my property; that He daily provides abundantly for all the needs of my life, protects me from all danger, and guards and keeps me from all evil; and that He does this purely out of fatherly and divine goodness and mercy, without any merit or worthiness in me; for all of which I am in duty bound to thank, praise, serve, and obey Him." He also promises the elimination of this fallen and imperfect creation, at a future date known only to Him, and the creation of a New Heaven and a New Earth which shall be the eternal home of all those He redeems. We come before Him in thankfulness because He deserves our thanks.

"Lord, our Lord, how majestic is Your name in all the earth..." "I love You, Lord, my strength." "Sing the praises of the Lord..." "I will extol the Lord at all times..." "Praise the Lord." (Psalms 8:1; 18:1; 30:4; 34:1; 150:1) The reasons for adoration of the Lord can be found from Genesis 1:1-Revelation 22:21! He delivers us from sin, death and the power of the evil one. The reasons for adoration of the Lord can be found in our daily life experiences. He is with us continually: protecting, guiding and teaching. He disciplines and encourages us. Most of all, the reason for adoration of the Lord is that He loves us! We adore Him because He deserves praise and adoration.

"...but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God." (Philippians 4:6) In times of trial or circumstantial crises we readily cry out to the Lord for help, but we seem to forget the advice of the songwriter: "Count your blessings..."<sup>2</sup>. However, when life is good and we face minor (if any) problems, indifference becomes a danger. Hopefully, we are aware of our dependence on the grace and mercy of our Savior. We should worship in prayer daily, hourly, moment-by-moment. "Pray continually..." (1 Thessalonians 5:17) Take your troubles and triumphs, your needs and wants, your family and friends (and even your enemies. Cf. Matthew 5:44), take everything to the Lord in prayer.

I believe the entire life of the Christian is to be a life of worship, continually worshipping God for all His blessings and disciplines.
