#### Dear Church Fannilly,

We spent the month of January praying, fasting, and seeking the Lord's guidance for the church. During the month of February, we began implementing some changes that we believe will help us be more effective in the mission God has given us. Thank you for being open to change. I've had several conversations and in each one there is a willingness to do whatever it takes to help people become growing followers of Jesus!

Now as we enter March, there are two ministry opportunities that I want to highlight.



New Testament Bible Reading Plan

### 5 MINUTES A DAY

If you're not used to reading the Bible daily, start with this easy to use 5 minutes a day. This reading plan will take you through all 260 chapters of the New Testament, one chapter per day. The Gospels are read throughout the year to weave in the story of Christ all year long.


# 5 DAYS A WEEK

Determine a time and location to spend 5 minutes a day for five days a week. It is best to have a consistent time and a quiet place where you can regularly meet with the Lord. Each week, two days are provided for "Reflection." Use this time to take a break from reading and reflect on what you have been reading.

# (5) WAYS TO DIG DEEPER

Pause in your reading to dig into the Bible. Below are 5 different ways to dig deeper each day. These exercises will encourage meditation. Try a single idea for a week to find what works best for you. Remember to keep a pen and paper ready to capture God's insights.

- 1. Underline or highlight keywords or phrases in the Bible passage. Use a pen or highlighter to mark new discoveries from the text.
- Put it in your own words. Read the passage or verse slowly, then rewrite each phrase or sentence using your own words.
- 3. Ask and answer questions. Questions unlock new discoveries and meanings. Ask questions about the passage using these words: who, what, why, when, where, or how. Jot down your answers to these questions.
- 4. Capture the big idea. God's Word communicates big ideas. Periodically ask: What's the big idea in this sentence, paragraph, or chapter?
- 5. Personalize the meaning. Respond as God speaks to you through the Scriptures. Ask: How could my life be different today as I respond to what I'm reading?

Buildings closed, but our ministerial and support staff, members, and friends of The Hill Baptist Church stepped forward to assure that this church's ministry continued. Through activities such as using Zoom and Facebook platforms, we responded, in both word and action.

This year, financial support to the General Fund operating budget of The Hill Baptist Church is even more vital to carry out the church's work. Whether we gather for worship inside our building, in small group gatherings, or online, we continue to be the body of Christ through our ministries, our witness and our care for one another.
