#### LEANING ON THE EVERLASTING ARMS

You may have noticed a new feature of our Church sanctuary. There are two wooden railings, neatly positioned near the Pulpit and the lectern used for Scripture readings. The railings lead up the three steps from the main floor to the Altar. They will be a great help to people who would like to grasp or hold a rail when climbing steps.
