TRIP TO WHITERIVER ARIZONA - First, I would like to thank ALL who have donated items of hand made baby blankets, clothing, shoes, toys, books and other items to be taken to the Apache tribe in Whiteriver Arizona. You all have been generous with your support and prayers. I have one more request; The Kennel, the “hangout” that Apache Youth ministries uses for social and educational purposes is always in need of paper goods and cleaning supplies. Items like toilet paper, paper towels, Solo cups, plastic cutlery, dish washing detergent, paper napkins, bowls and plates along with bathroom/kitchen cleaning detergents. These items are used a lot. The Kennel is used every afternoon after school for 3 hours for fellowship, tutoring and Bible study. It is also used on Thursday evenings for a weekly event called “The Rising”, a popular teen worship and fellowship experience, hosted by Apache Youth Ministries and The Whitemountain Apache Christian Church. So, like the saying goes, “cleanliness is next to godliness”.

Some of you have asked when I'll be returning to Whiteriver. As of now, it's when the reservation is “open”. The tribe's chairwoman, Gwendena Lee Gatewood, has been doing a masterful job in navigating through the pandemic. Right now, officially, the only things that are open to the public are hiking trails and fishing in the rivers on the reservation. Schools, K - 6 are open, 7 - 12 are still closed. Churches are still restricted to outdoor worship, and travel is restricted. As soon as I hear that the reservation is “open”, I will be making plans for my trip and will let you know of a donation deadline. If you have questions, please give me a call.
