Sermon Notes

“Because I Love His Church”

Hebrews 10:19-29

Dr. Harris Malcom, Transitional Pastor

The basic theme of Hebrews is to show that everything we have in Jesus is far better than anything we ever have had before. Because of the sacrifice that Jesus made at Calvary all of the Old Testament sacrifices are now obsolete. We do not have to make animal sacrifices because Jesus has once and for all made one sacrifice for ever for sin and you and I can come right on into the very presence of God.

1. I CHOOSE TO DRAW NEAR

A. That I might walk into the very presence of God.

B. The old way was a dead way.

C. But we have a New and Living Way that says “come on in!”

D. We are also to “draw near with a sincere heart.”

2. I CHOOSE TO HOLD FAST (v. 25)

“...not giving up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but encouraging one another—and all the more as you see the Day approaching.”

A. We are to do so **“without wavering.”**

B. We are to hold fast without doubting **“for He who promised is faithful.”**

3. I CHOOSE TO ENCOURAGE

A. There is personal stimulation **“as we see the day drawing near.”**

B. There is also public celebration **“not forsaking our own assembling together.”**
