Ruth 1:16-17 (NKJV)

¹⁶ But Ruth said: "Entreat me not to leave you, *Or to* turn back from following after you; For wherever you go, I will go; And wherever you lodge, I will lodge; Your people *shall be* my people, And your God, my God.

¹⁷ Where you die, I will die, And there will I be buried. The LORD do so to me, and more also, If *anything but* death parts you and me."



How do you deal with hurting people?

- ▣ How do you deal with hurting people?
- ▣ Recognize the hurt for what it is. ...
- ▣ Give up the need to be right. ...
- ▣ Recognize anything you may have done to contribute to the situation. ...
- ▣ **Respond**, don't react. ...

Solutions

- ▣ How do you heal from the hurt?
- ▣ Stop being the victim and blaming others. ...
- ▣ Forgive them — and yourself.
- ▣ Make the decision to let it go.
Things don't disappear on their own.
... Tell someone to *let it go* like Ruth
