My last General Membership Meeting as President was on November 21st and I want to thank all of my Board for all of their work these past two years.



Communications Report:


Betsy Lindegren reported that December will be her last month as Communications Director. Socorro Biglieri will be the new Communications Director starting January 1, 2024.

We need runs for 2024. Please start thinking now about runs that you would like to host.




