PRESIDENT'S EXHAUST



December 4th Sanger's Christmas Tree City Toyland Parade

Editor's Note: COF was proud to include members of the Central Valley Corvettes as part of our run to this annual event.

The Sanger District Chamber of Commerce serves the City of Sanger and surrounding Community inside the 185 square mile area of Sanger Unified School District. Sanger is the Nation's Christmas Tree City and known for its Leadership Role coordinating the Annual Trek to the Nation's Christmas Tree, the General Grant Tree in Kings Canyon National Park

The General Grant Tree is also the only living National Shrine dedicated to Veterans who died as dedicated by Admiral Nimitz, representing President Eisenhower in 1956.

This year was the 96th Trek to the Nation's Christmas Tree held December 12th. The Sanger Chamber also coordinates the Sanger Nation's Christmas Tree City Toyland Parade held each December. 2021 was a special year since the Parade was not held in 2020 due to Covid restrictions. Therefore in 2021, the Chamber held its Annual Awards Banquet in July, honoring two years of outstanding Community Leaders.

These honorees are not only recognized at the Awards Banquet, but also are the core of dignitaries "Paraded in front of their Community" at the Toyland Parade in December. This year (2021) the estimated attendees exceeded 10,000; over all prior years, with entries at another record.

Our next adventure is just around the corner,

February 12, 2022: Ice Breaker Run: Hosted by Louis Biglieri:

The run will start at the Chevron station on Ave 7 so plan on being there around 8-8:15am and we'll leave by 8:30. Our first stop will be at Casa De Fruta for a break. Then we'll continue to San Juan Bautista and have lunch at 11 am at Jardines de San Juan. They asked that we arrive about 10 minutes before 11 so they can put tables together for our group. When we leave the restaurant will continue on 156 west to 1 south towards Ragged Point and stop where we will spread Sherry Dosher ashes and then after that will continue to the San Simeon Lodge where we will check in.

I have made arraignments with the San Simeon Lodge for the night of February 12th. We must book the rooms by December 1, 2021 in order to receive the discounter rate. Dinner will be at the restaurant at the San Simeon Beach Bar and Grill (let me know if you plan on dinner at the lodge so I can make the reservation's) or you can go other restaurants on the north side of town. After dinner we can join in with Karaoke with Elvis in the bar.

Sunday morning the restaurant will be open for breakfast and after you can either head back home or maybe Hearst Castle will be open for morning tours. <u>May 18-21, 2022</u>: The Phlepsens are hosting this event. Stay at the Santa Maria Inn, buffet dinner the first night. 20 rooms have been allocated. Visit Los Olivos and wineries. The pre-paid items should be the buffet dinner and picnic lunch. Sign up at meetings or call Gary at 999-2957

Gary has blocked 20 rooms at the Santa Maria Inn. Rates are \$104 for Wednesday/Thursday and \$144 for Friday. Their number is 805-928-7777... Tell them you are with the Corvettes of Fresno group. **The deadline for room reservations will be Jan 1st, 2022.** Depart Fresno 5/18-time TBD. Drive to Morro Bay and maybe have lunch at the Bayside Café, then drive to Nipomo and tour the Luffa farm. Drive to Santa Maria and stay at the Santa Maria Inn with tri tip buffet dinner that night. Next day drive to Lompoc. The flower fields should be in full bloom buy then, they grow a lot of commercial flowers for seed, and we will have picnic outside of Lompoc. That afternoon we will tour the "Purisima Concepcion" Mission. This is a Mission that it was rebuilt and it looks like when it was originally built. The next morning, we will drive to the wine country and have lunch at a little biker's bar, or go to Solvang. Next day either go home or stay longer on your own. So far 13 people have signed up.

Looks like we need some day runs Let Randy know if you want to help put one on 😳






