1958 TRIVIA



For the first time since its introduction, the '58 Corvette came with factory-installed seat belts.

1958 was the last year of a tachometer which kept track of "cumulative engine revolution counter" a feature which first appeared in the 1953 Corvette. In 1958 the tach was used on 230, 245, and 250 hp cars but not on the 270 and 290 hp cars. The Part number is #1548631 for 1958 models.

Optional engines in 1956 had 9 fin alloy valve covers, 1957 had 7 or 9 fin alloy valve covers, and the 1958 had 7 fin alloy covers on optional engines.

Before 1958, the only acrylic lacquer paint used was on the "Inca Silver" Corvettes.

The drawing for this month is \$40.00 and Lori Kovacevich name was drawn she was not present; the drawing will be \$50.00 next month.



GM to Invest \$439 Million for a New Corvette Paint Shop

If you happen to buy a new Corvette in roughly two years, you can likely thank the previous customers of the seventh-generation Stingray for your improved paint job.

The overwhelming success of the new Corvette, introduced in 2014, no doubt heavily influenced General Motors' announcement today that it will be investing \$439 million at the <u>Bowling Green Assembly Plant</u>, most of which will go to a new Corvette paint shop that will include "substantial technology upgrades," according to GM.

Work will begin this summer and take about two years to finish; in the meantime, normal Corvette production won't be affected.

The big investment by GM adds to the \$135 million GM had already put into the Kentucky facility over the last four years getting ready for the new Stingray and the Performance Build Center.

"With this major technology investment, we can continue to exceed the expectations of sports car buyers for years to come," said North American Manufacturing Manager Arvin Jones. "These types of investments are evidence that the customer is at the center of every decision we make."

UAW Vice President Cindy Estrada said the new paint shop will mirror the efficiencies and technologies of the new body shop, installed with the launch of the Stingray.

"Hardworking UAW members have proudly built vehicles in Bowling Green for more than 30 years," Estrada said, "and we are pleased to be a part of such a significant facility upgrade."

The new 450,000-square-foot paint shop will be nearly half the size of the entire current production facility, GM said, and will result in the retention of 150 jobs.

The paint shop will feature new tooling and robots, and its state-of-the-art environmental and efficiency improvements include:

Dry Scrubber Booth Technology with Limestone Handling System designed to eliminate sludge water and waste

Light-emitting diode, or LED, lighting for process decks for improved visual inspection as well as energy savings

State-of-the-art FANUC robots with Versa-bell 3 electrostatic applicators for an extremely smooth finish and maximum transfer efficiency, saving 25 percent of the paint material used, which also benefits the environment Longer, high-efficiency baking ovens for exceptional paint finish and lower energy use.

Perhaps the best thing about today's announcement, though, is that it means Chevrolet apparently remains highly committed to the Corvette, which hopefully means there will be many more generations of the popular sports car coming in future years.

Corvette Museum Planning Thunderdome Exhibit to Tell the Story of the Sinkhole

The National Corvette Museum continues to make lemonade out of the lemons that literally fell beneath its feet last year.

Museum officials have released details about what they're calling "Thunderdome," a unique multimedia experience that will allow visitors to "live through" the collapse of the Skydome floor that sent eight Corvettes falling into the bowels of the earth in February 2014.



Thunderdome, designed by a Florida company called Creative Arts Unlimited, is actually just one part of an exhibit that will teach visitors about caves, sinkholes, karst landscapes, and the Corvettes damaged or destroyed by the sinkhole inside the museum.

Exact opening date hasn't been set, but Thunderdome may be ready to greet its first guests by this fall.

Thunderdome is under construction now – it's basically a miniature replica of the Skydome and about 15 guests at a time will enjoy a "sensorama" experience of sound and animation producing the sensation of being below the structure's floor when the collapse occurred. It will give visitors the experience of witnessing the collapse, from inside a simulated cave below a simulated Skydome floor.

If you're a little claustrophobic, you can opt out of the Thunderdome experience and enter the museum by a separate entrance, but Thunderdome patrons brave enough will enter through the tunnel that currently connects the Enthusiast Area to the Skydome, which will be modified to look like the many caves below the Kentucky ground.

We were disappointed when the sinkhole had to be permanently closed up because it would have cost too much to leave it open, but we think the Thunderdome is a great compromise that will prove to be very popular with tourists.

And we know how popular seeing the sinkhole proved to be last year, with a record 251,258 visitors passing through.

April 2015 Corvette Sales

Great sales numbers continue for the Chevrolet Corvette!

This morning, GM posted the monthly sales numbers for April 2015. For the month, GM reported 3,469 Corvettes were delivered. This is slightly down from last April's number of 3,514 for a net change of -1.3%.

Despite the slight drop, last month's sales figures rank 3rd on our chart for April sales since 2006.

For the calendar year (January-April), a total of 11,986 have been delivered. This is 2.5% higher than the 11,693 Corvettes delivered in 2014.

In the official release this morning, it was mentioned that the Corvette Z06 is one of the industry's fastest-selling car, with a "days to turn" of only 17 days.

At the National Corvette Museum's Bash, Plant Manager Jeff Lamarche spoke about production of the 2015 Corvette. He said they are running the plant with overtime and are producing 170 Corvettes per day! Through April 22nd, Chevrolet has built a total of 23,171 Corvette Stingrays and 8,206 Corvette Z06s for a total 2015 Model Year production of 31,377. The plant will be making 2015 Corvettes through June 22nd and will roll over to begin retail production of the 2016 Corvette on Monday, June 25th.


