I understand that my tuition for the _____ school year at St. Agnes School is \$ _____. When a payment is due, I understand that it is expected on the 1st day of the month. I also understand that a \$25.00 fee will be charged monthly on all accounts past due by 30 (thirty) days. I understand that my tuition must be current at the end of each quarter of the school year or my child(ren) may be excluded from school. I further understand that no records will be released until all financial obligations have been met. So that I may best fit the tuition into my personal budget, I will make my tuition payments in the manner indicated below:

_____ One lump sum payment by August 1st.

_____ Semi-annual payments due August 1st and January 1st.

_____ Monthly payments beginning in June and ending in May of the current school year.

(There is some Tuition Assistance available to qualifying applicants. Please see the Tuition Assistance section of this contract.)

I understand that the tuition is in addition to the non-refundable Registration Fee of \$100 per child, due at the time I register my child(ren).

Families are asked to use Electronic Funds Transfer programs through their banks to establish a regular payment schedule. Please request an ACH Debit Authorization form from the school office.

PARISH SUNDAY CONTRIBUTION

To qualify for Catholic tuition, we ask each family with a child in St. Agnes School to contribute \$10 per child each Sunday to the regular collection.

SERVICE HOURS

St. Agnes families benefit from a relatively low tuition, due in large part to the support of the Parish and the fundraising efforts of the Home and School Association. We depend on the help of our school families to support us through, not only timely tuition payments, but also through volunteerism.

The time you give helps keep tuition costs down, but more importantly affords you the opportunity to build connections with the fellow St. Agnes families. This is the village that will be helping you raise your child/children.

We require each family to give of their time to the major fundraisers, the St. Agnes Premiere, which is held the 3rd Friday in November and the Penny Carnival the first Sunday in March. The Home & School Association will provide information regarding the type of help needed for these events. With the implementation of our own lunch program, it is also necessary for each family to help with serving and clean-up at least 5 times during the year. Other family members (grandparents, aunts/uncles, etc.) or friends can fill in for a family whose work/family schedule makes it impossible for them to help in the middle of the day.

We invite our parents to become involved and connected members of St. Agnes School. It is through your involvement with each other that community is built and strengthened, and this is what makes our school such a great place. Other potential ways to get involved at St. Agnes include:

- Serving as a board member for Advisory Council or the Home-School Association
- Serving on a standing committee – Technology, School L.I.F.E Committee
- Serving as a chair or co-chair for Penny Carnival
- Attending Home-School meetings (last Monday of each month)
- Classroom Volunteer (based on teacher's need)
- Field Trip Driver
- Room Parent (organize 3 class parties during the year)

TUITION ASSISTANCE

In order to consider tuition assistance, the following must occur:

1. Responsible Party/Parties will complete the **Tuition Assistance Application** including the **previous tax year filings**.
2. Responsible Party/Parties will meet with the parish priest and/or the school principal.

Tuition Assistance applications can be obtained at the school office beginning **March 15th**. Completed applications must be returned to the office by: **Friday, May 17th**.

ST. AGNES TUITION COLLECTION POLICY

TUITION COLLECTION

- I. Parents or Guardians must register their student with the school office and present the signed Tuition Contract. No student will be admitted to St. Agnes School until the registration is completed and the Tuition Contract is signed.
- II. If it is not possible for the parents to register during the usual registration period, arrangements must be made for registration during regular school hours prior to the start of school. The tuition contract must be signed at time.
- III. Parents must choose a method of payment of tuition and indicate their choice on the Tuition Contract at the time register.
- IV. Tuition amounts and schedule of payment, as they are agreed to on the Tuition Contract, shall be followed. Any scheduled payment which is over due by thirty (30) days will be considered past-due. The due date for tuition payments is the 1st of each month. A late fee of \$25.00 will be assessed monthly on all past-due accounts, and will be added to the tuition bill. Tuition must be current at the end of each quarter, or the student may be removed from school. If, for some valid reason, you need to deviate from your contract, you must be responsible for contacting the pastor and/or the principal to give reasons why and make contingency arrangements to conform to the existing contract. Otherwise, payment will be considered past-due and your child(ren) may be excluded.
- V. Parents may use Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) programs through their banks to establish a regular payment schedule. A bad check will result in cash being required for all payments.
- VI. No student will be refused admission for inability to pay the full tuition rate, provided the parents make special arrangements with the pastor and/or the principal and abide by the commitment they make on their Tuition Contract. All families will be expected to pay at least a minimum amount as a demonstration of their commitment to the cost of their child's education.
- VII. In order to be eligible for Catholic tuition, the parent or guardian must be a registered and active member of a Catholic Parish. The St. Agnes Family Handbook states..."St. Agnes Parishioners are expected to contribute at least \$10 per week per child for financial support to the parish..."
- VIII. Non-payment of contracted tuition for any quarter of the school year will result in the following action being taken by the Advisory Council:
 1. The student(s) may be removed from school the first day of the following quarter.
 2. Student will not be issued a report card and/or records will not be released until all contacted tuition and other financial obligations to the school are paid in full.
 3. Past-due accounts and the fees they have accrued may be turned over to a collection agency.
