How Important is the Bible?

One of the most amazing things about the Bible is its impact in history through various translations.

For instance, the first authorized translation in history was done in Egypt by Jewish scribes. Known today as the Septuagint, the work was done in Alexandria. Most believe the work was done sometime between 250 and 150 B.C. The Hebrew Old Testament was translated into Greek because there was a large population of Jews in Egypt who wanted to understand their Bible but no longer read Hebrew. This translation became the Bible of the Apostles. Greek was the world's universal language from the time Alexander the Great conquered much of Europe, northern Africa, and the Middle East in 323 B.C. until the fall of the Roman Empire in A.D. 476. Not only was the Septuagint the first known authorized translation in human history; it became the standard Bible of the early Church until late into the 4th century A.D. Thus the whole science of translation was invented and sustained because of the Bible!

As Latin became popular and widely used, the demand for another significant translation arose. There was an Old Latin Version, but it had little impact. In A.D. 383 Jerome was

reaching out to people all over the world. Here are the various ministries:

Eleutheros Books has partnered with a Bible Society named **Bearing**

commissioned to produce what was called the Vulgate translation. Jerome insisted on translating the Old Testament from the original Hebrew, despite the criticism of many of his fellow church leaders who believed in the superiority of the Septuagint. Despite the early opposition, the Vulgate became the Bible of the Middle Ages (over 1,000 years!). In many respects the Vulgate was the basis for the translations we have today in English.

The need arose for a Bible in English, but opposition to this idea was fierce. Romancism dominated the world and wanted the Bible and worship services totally in Latin, even though virtually nobody understood it. The first significant translation into English was done by John Wycliffe (1328-1384). He did his work under great duress. He was forced to stand against the Church of his day because of his Biblically held convictions. One of the main issues was over the authority of the Church versus the authority of the Bible. Many made fun of him and his early work, but his stands for truth and excellent translation produced great results for many years. The Bible was so important to Wycliffe that he was willing to give his life for it! After facing the wrath and questioning of various ecclesiastical bodies, he finally died of apoplexy, but the story does not end there. The Council of Constance (1415) declared him a "stiff necked heretic," and he was banned from the Church. Later, in

1428, the hierarchy had his body exhumed and burned, casting whatever remains there were into the river Swift.

Later, William Tyndale (1494-1536) produced another significant translation in English. He was the first to translate the Hebrew Old Testament and Greek New Testament into English. His work was so excellent that the 54 men who translated the King James Version (1611) virtually copied his renderings 83.7% in the New Testament and 75.7% in the Old Testament. As it was with Wycliffe, so it was with Tyndale: he suffered because of his insistence that the Bible was the sole basis of spiritual authority. After considerable conflict with Church officials, Tyndale was jailed in 1535, spending a year in the Castle of Vilvourde. His life ended when he was strangled to death and cremated in 1536.

Martin Luther (1483-1546) was God's choice to begin the Reformation. He is well-known for taking a strong stand against the Church and posting 95 reasons for doing so on the doors of the church at Wittenburg in 1517; but in reality, his greatest impact came when he translated the Bible into understandable German. As with the others who preceded him, Luther was made to suffer for his unswerving faith. He was imprisoned at the Wartburg Castle (1521-22), but it was there that he began his translation work. The translation was so good

Anonymous: Is a non-profit organization designed to meet the needs of all included in Matthew 25:35-36 beginning with inmates whom have little or no support from the outside society.

that many believe it transformed the German language. His version became the people's book in church, school, and house throughout much of Europe. One particular press, that of Hans Luft of Wittenburg, produced more than 100,000 copies and was read by millions of people from 1534-1574. It was this translation that fueled the fire of the Reformation that changed the spiritual landscape of the entire western world!

These great translators were willing to suffer and even die for their faith!

Today, the Bible has been translated into over 1,300 languages and distributed to over 100,000,000 people worldwide every year!

No other book has such longevity! No other book has been translated so many times! And no translator has been willing to suffer as these men of God did!

This is another way of understanding just how important the Bible really is!
