Plan and Prayer of Salvation

Do you know where you will spend eternity after you depart this earthly life? The Bible makes it clear that it will be only one of two places, heaven or hell.

- Whoever believes in the Son has eternal life, but whoever rejects the Son will not see life, for God's wrath remains on them, John 3:36 NIV.
- We die only once, and then we are judged, Hebrews 9:27 CEV.

The Bible also makes it clear that in order to enter heaven, you must be saved. Furthermore, it states that salvation is only possible by receiving Jesus as your personal Lord and Savior.

- Jesus is the only one who can save people. His name is the only power in the world that has been given to save anyone. We must be saved through him, Acts 4:12 ERV.

He was buried, and that He rose again the third day according to the scriptures, 1 Cor 15:4 KJV).
- Fourth, invite Jesus to come into your life, to be your Lord and Savior by praying a prayer of salvation (everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved, Acts 2:21 NIV). Pray this prayer of salvation:
 - O Dear God, I know that I am a sinner and I am unable to save myself. I repent of my sin and with the aid of your Holy Spirit, I turn away from my sin. I believe the Lord Jesus died on the Cross for my sins, rose from the dead, and is alive forevermore. I ask you to come into my heart and save me, cleanse me from all unrighteousness, and help me to live for you. I receive you as my Lord and Savior. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Beloved, I believe that if you sincerely prayed that prayer, you have been saved! The Bible says, "If you declare with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved" Romans 10:9 NIV. I encourage you to pray and read the Bible every day to help you grow in your faith. Don't worry, if you think that you do not know how to pray; you do not have to use big, impressive words.
