Most tourist areas in Israel will take US dollars but it is a good idea to have a few Israeli coins. Their denominations and descriptions are as follows:

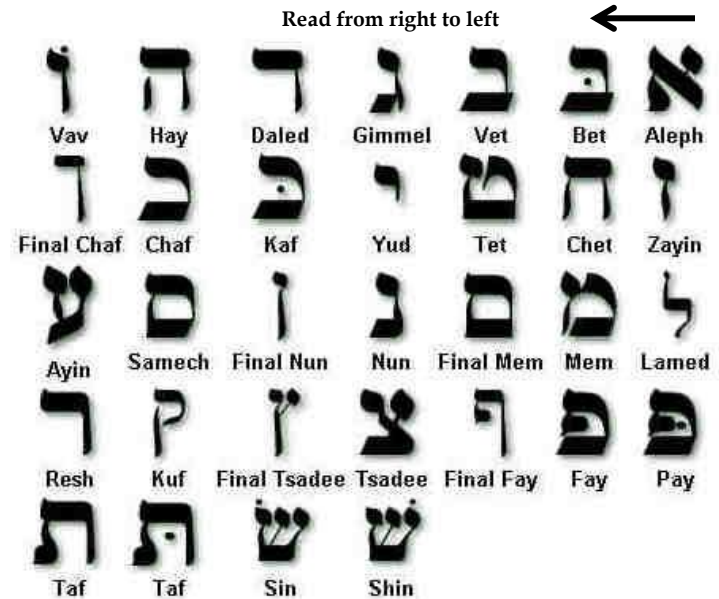
10 shekel coin - silver & copper	*10 on front	palm tree on reverse side

50 agorot - cooper (equals 1/2 shekel)	*1/2 on front	lyre on reverse side
10 agorot- cooper	*10 on front	menorah on reverse side
