We hoped to go into Ukraine this trip. But we will wait a bit longer and help the refugees in Poland.



Pastor Vlad in Kremenchuk continues to go out to 10 villages and hold home church services and take supplies. Two of his daughters, Masha and Liza are working with a team of teens preaching on the streets and helping with relief. They recruited and are mentoring these teams. We will be doing some work with them soon. Pastor Igor in Mykolaiv is still ministering to his church with all the shelling going on. We bought a water filtration system because the city water was shut off. Pastor Yuri is still working in Kramatorsk despite shelling and the Russians trying to surround that area. He holds 3 services a week, 300 in one, 300 in another, and 100 in one more. So far he has had 75 baptisms. We have been sending him and our partners thousands of dollars weekly thanks to you our supporters. Please don't stop now.

We hope to take funds with us to Krakow, along with the very precious word of God!


