Shepherd's Purse is home from Ireland/Estonia.

We made it! I have to say this was a tough trip but rewarding. Trip #25 included: 7 flights, 7 taxis, 4 trains, and miles of walking. Jet lag at home gleefully ran its course.

This could be my grand finale trip and yet - so many great things happened.

- We met up with refugees in the streets of Killarney, Ireland and encouraged and prayed with them.
- We met up with a wonderful pastor there, Michael and Ninfa Robson who are doing a great work in their church. He even allowed us time to share our work on Sunday.
- Our team had an afternoon of street evangelism in the city

park downtown Tallin, Estonia.

- We prayed at the border of russia in Narva, Estonia. This city is 95% russians.
- We met with refugees in Sallamae, Estonia. We shared stories of escape from some of the most hard hit cities in Ukraine, shared refreshments, and worshiped and prayed and hugged together.
- We had a big meeting with refugees one day and handed out almost \$1,000 worth of groceries at the end. We shared in worship, testimonies, prayer and encouragement. Broke our hearts.
- That day many that came were not Christians and our hosts felt the Holy Spirit moved because the next day many of them showed up for church. And again, more worship, preaching, prayer and fellowship.
