

Parish of the Holy Family Parish Council Meeting

Review and approval of October minutes: Motion made, seconded and all approved the minutes.

Old Business:

Rental of Facilities – A discussion of the cost for rental of the various faculties resulted in the Parish Council recommend that the present cost structure (as provided by Sandy Bleier) continue. This is a daily rate as follows :

St.Helen cafeteria: \$100.00 (includes use of the kitchen)

Holy Ghost Nellis Hall: \$200.00 (includes use of the kitchen)

St. Jude Hall: \$300.00 (does not include use of the kitchen); Additional \$100 to use the kitchen.

We also realize there is an additional charge for insurance that it paid to the diocese and a \$100 security deposit that will be refunded once the hall has been inspected by the staff found to be left as clean as it was when rented.

New Business:

Recruiting new Parish Council members, we have three opening at this time. We will all try to encourage others to join the council. After January 1, 2019 we will place announcements in the bulletin. It was stated that with the correct people the quantity is not critical. Also we will try to encourage younger participants.

Open discussion items:

- A. The financial updates to the parishioners seemed to go over well, no one heard any complaints.
- B. The idea of a presentation on end of life issues is being considered with the goal of letting parishioners know of the opportunity to bequeath a cash gift to the parish.

- C. There will not be a Thursday presentation and soup dinner with the 5 parishes this upcoming lent. Ron is developing a series on spirituality in place of the past programs.
- D. A Taste of Ignatius spirituality program is in the works. This will be no cost to the parish and very inexpensive for the participants (\$5 per session). It will be a 12 week series.
- E. Due to future vacation he requested we move the January meeting to the 7th instead of the 14th.

Father John information:

- A. There will be a project for the Vietnamese children to learn Vietnamese language and customs. This will take place on Sundays from 1 -3 PM. Already 25 middle school age children have signed up for the program.
- B. The Vietnamese New Years party is scheduled for February 10, 2019.
