

I. BE DEDICATED TO HIM:

I beseech you therefore, brethren by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service. (Rm. 12:1)

A. This means: Surrender your will to His will.

B. Sacrifice your ways for His ways.

II. BE DEPENDENT ON HIM:

I will be with thee; I will not fail thee nor forsake thee (Josh. 1:5).

A. God will never: Fail - . . .

B. God will never: Forsake - . . .

III. BE DELIGHTED IN HIM:

Delight thyself also in the Lord; and He shall give thee the desires of thine heart (Ps. 37:4).

A. He will: Give you your desires.

B. He will: Cause rejoicing in your soul.

(In whom we have boldness and access with confidence by the faith of Him. Eph. 3:12)

IV. BE DIRECTED BY HIM:

In all thy ways acknowledge Him, and He shall direct thy paths (Prov. 3:6).

A. Acknowledge Him: He will direct you.

B. And the Lord direct your hearts into the love of God, and into the patient waiting for Christ. (2 Thess. 3:5)

V. BE DYNAMIC FOR HIM:

And the Lord said unto the servant, God out into the highways and hedges and compel them to come in, that my house may be filled. (Lk. 14:23).
