Matthew 25:31-46

The Bible speaks of three judgements which are distinct and separate

1. The “Bema” Seat of Christ (I Corinthians 3:10-15)
 - A. Believers only
 - B. After rapture of the church
 - C. Judgement of Christian’s faithfulness
2. The Sheep and Goats (Matthew 25:31-46)
 - A. Those alive at the end of the tribulation
 - B. Who will enter Christ’s millennial kingdom
 - C. Judgement of saved and lost
3. The Great White Throne at the End of Time (Revelation 20:11-15)
 - A. Unbelievers only
 - B. End of Christ 1000 year reign
 - C. Judgement of lostness

Matthew 25:31-40 The Sheep and Goats

Single Truths

- I. There are Only Two Kinds of People
 - A. Sheep – saved
 - B. Goats – lost
 - C. Division is based solely on relationship with God the Father through Christ the Son
 - D. God will make a division based on person’s acceptance or rejection of Jesus as Lord
- II. A Person’s Actions Demonstrate His Spiritual Status
 - A. Saved people live according to Christ’s standard (Galatians 6:9-10)
 - B. Obedience and service denotes repentance and obedience
 - C. Becomes very nature to be Christlike (When did we see you?)
- III. God’s Judgement is
 1. Just
 2. Fair
 3. Final
