## I. Jesus – Unlimited Power (vs 18)

### A. Absolute power

1. Greek word pas ALL, not part, not some, not occasionally
2. Complete – unrestricted – unrestrained

### B. Universal Power – in heaven and on earth

Power over all things

#### 1. Natural

“Even the wind and waves obey Him”

#### 2. Supernatural – the unseen world

“Even the unclean Spirits are subjected to Him”

- a. Angelic – could have called 10,000 at Calvary
- b. Demonic – cast out
- c. Devil himself (John 12:31, Daniel 7:13-14)
- d. Saving power
- e. Over death itself

### C. He consigns a portion of that power to His people – the Church (Acts 1:8)

## II. Jesus Unchanging Game Plan

Lou Holtz “The coach has a plan, he knows what needs to be done. He communicates the plan to his players. Success or failure rides on how well they execute the game plan”

### A. Make disciples “He that wins souls is wise”
