

# **In Person Worship Guidelines as of August 2, 2020**

- If you are sick or have health concerns, please stay home and watch online
- Per the Governor's order, masks are required for everyone 3<sup>rd</sup> grade and older. Age 3 to 3<sup>rd</sup> grade are recommended, but not required. Per CDC guidelines, children age 2 and younger should not wear a mask. If you need one, please see a greeter
- Temperature will be taken upon entering, 100.4 or lower is acceptable
- There will be no choir or congregational singing
- Sunday School classes will not meet, only worship at 10:30 AM
- The vans will not run until further notice
- Special Ministries will not meet
- Enter through sanctuary glass doors - these are the only doors that will be unlocked
- Doors will be propped open (no touching necessary)
- The greeters will be stationed 6' away from the doors
- There will not be a bulletin, but all info will be projected on the screens
- Alternating rows of pews will be closed to promote social distancing
- Seats will be marked in 6' sections to promote social distancing between households - if you live in same household, you can sit together
- The ushers will collect the offering by passing in front of you so that you will not need to touch the plate
- The water fountains and water coolers will not be open
- There will be no children's church, extended session or nursery - all children are welcome to attend service with family
- Hand sanitizer will be available in the foyer
- There will be no Sunday or Wednesday evening services until further notice
- You are encouraged to practice safe social distancing before and after the service
